No one can snatch away his Desert Fruits.

Seeing the army of skeletons, these people all shut their mouths.

As for what they will say after leaving the dungeon, Lin Moyu doesn't care much about it.

"There's something wrong with the wind. It's a bit cold."

"It's coming from Lin Moyu's skill."

Lin Moyu started using his skill.

Bone Armor appeared on him repeatedly.

At level 1, Bone Armor consumed only 10 points of spirit force.

After reaching level 2, the consumption increased to 20 points.

The Desert Fruits are really amazing.

In fact, they are known as godly object for grinding skills.

The skeletal army is no joke, not to mention that Lin Moyu is the party's captain.

If they are kicked out of the dungeon, they will be left empty-handed.

Lin Moyu ignored them. If anyone wants to take his fruits, they can come and try.

Without having to consider the consumption, Lin Moyu ground Bone Armor at a rapid pace. It only took half an hour to cultivate the skill to level 21.

[Bone Armor (level 21): summons an armor of bones that provides 2,100 points of physical defense for five minutes; the skill can also be used on others]

At level 21, Bone Armor can provide 2,100 points of physical defense.

Even without his talent's amplification, the skill is already quite powerful.

For Mages of the same level, their physique attribute is in the 300s.

Including equipment, their physique will range between 400 and 500.

Bone Armor, however, can provide 2,100 points of defense.

It's not only more powerful than a Mage's protective shield, but can even be applied to others.

If the talent's 30-fold amplification is added into the mix, that will amount to 63,000 points of physical defense.

Lin Moyu feels that even if he stood still and let the Tyrant attack him, the Tyrant wouldn't be able to break his defense.

He feels that even without the skeletons, so long as he was given enough spirit force, he could face the Tyrant head-on.

After all, Soul Blaze packs quite the punch.

After he was done with Bone Armor, Lin Moyu started grinding Slowing Curse.

A crimson light rose and enveloped the yellow sand.

The curse descended with a buzzing sound, as if noise from hell.

As the skill's level rose, the red light became more intense and covered a wider range.

Later on, when Slowing Curse was unleashed, it was as if the world was shrouded in the curse.

[Slowing Curse (level 21): curses enemies within a range of 105 meters and reduces their speed by 105%; lasts for one minute.]

Coupled with his talent's amplification, the reduction of speed reached 3,150%. That's a 31-fold drop in speed.

At this time, Slowing Curse is enough to make most enemies seem like they're in slow motion.

Moreover, the range reached 3,150 meters.

Even on a large battlefield, this range is enough to cover a lesser half of the battlefield.

Such a party can fully handle different unexpected situations.

The Sakura person's complexion changed greatly. He is familiar with the Knight and his party.

The Sakura person promptly showed a fake smile, "It was a joke, just a joke."

The Knight snorted coldly, "Keep your head on straight. For a trifling Sakura person to provoke us Shenxia people, you must be tired of living."

[Dragonkind Assassin (hell rank elite monster)]

[Level: 32]

[Strength: 10,000]

[Agility: 10,000]

[Spirit: 2,000]

[Physique: 5,000]

These attributes are really extreme.

Both strength and agility have reached 10,000 points, spirit is pitifully low -- 2,000 points -- and physique is only 5,000 points.

With these extreme attributes, combined with the skills Stealth and Fatal Blow, they can instantly erupt with astonishing combat power.

As a result, despite how tough they are, the Skeletal Warriors were severely wounded by a single blow.

Furthermore, when they launch their skill while in stealth mode, the stealth mode won't be interrupted.

These monsters are extremely powerful.

Unfortunately, Lin Moyu discovered them.

The skill Stealth was interrupted when they were attacked.

Now that they were exposed, their advantage evaporated.

Their weak physique has become a fatal flaw.

Under the attacks of the Skeletal Warriors and Skeletal Mages, three Dragonkind Assassins were killed in an instant.

[Killed level 32 Dragonkind Assassin, EXP +640,000]

[Obtained Dragonkind heart]

Lin Moyu felt a slight sense of joy in his heart, "It turns out that Dragonkind hearts are dropped by the Dragonkind Assassins."

Mages drop horns, Archers drop blood essence, while Assassins drop hearts.

Now only the source of Dragonkind cores remains a mystery.

Lin Moyu looked into the depths of the fortress.

The fortress is shrouded in darkness and silence.

[Level: 33]

[Agility: 13,000]

[Spirit: 10,000]

[Physique: 15,000]

[Skills: AOE Knockback, AOE Stun, Enhance Resistance]

All four attributes exceed 10,000 points.

Nevertheless, it looks like its attributes are not as high as the Skeletal Warrior's.

However, it is a boss and possesses formidable health.

Coupled with its 15,000 points of physique, it has astonishing defense, making it very difficult to kill it.

AOE Knockback and AOE Stun, both skills are control skills, making Lin Moyu feel an even greater headache.

In the hell rank dungeon, the Skeletal Warriors have suffered enough from control skills.

Lin Moyu quickly retreated, distancing himself from the guardian by at least 500 meters. Red light shone in his palm.

The stone statue shattered completely, and the guardian faced upwards and roared, announcing its arrival.

At this time, a huge red net fell from the sky.

Along with a loud buzzing sound, a red chain pattern appeared on the guardian's head.

The boss's attack power isn't all that. Its control skills, however, are quite annoying.

It looks like its skill has no cooldown period.

In fact, its skill has a cooldown period, but it's very short.

The Outpost Guardian can keep the enemy perpetually in the stun state.

The Bone Armor was really formidable, equivalent to 64,000 points of physical defense. It could withstand abnormal statuses and ignore control skills.

After 30 seconds, the Skeletal Warriors snapped out of it.

Lin Moyu willed and collected them into the summon space.

Subsequently, the Skeletal Warriors appeared next to the guardian. They swung their blades right of the bat.

The Outpost Guardian was furious and activated its skill AOE Stun again.

At the moment it unleashed its skills, Lin Moyu collected the Skeletal Warriors.

His Bone Armor effortlessly blocked the shockwaves.

Lin Moyu's Bone Armor made it so the Outpost Guardian can't do anything to him.

With its weak intelligence, it can't possibly understand why this unassuming guy in front of it can ignore its control skills.

Lin Moyu took the reins of the fight's rhythm.

He released the Skeletal Warriors and retrieved them time and again, as well as recast Bone Armor.

At the same time, he unleashed Soul Blaze repeatedly, while the person himself acted as a meat shield to attract the opponent's firepower.

Lin Moyu's performance had become increasingly more proficient and efficient.

This battle was quite suitable to develop his battle sense.

He no longer had to entirely rely on the Skeletal Warriors, but could be more self-reliant.

He understood that he was both a Summoner and a Mage, that he couldn't always fight as a Summoner.

After a full 15 minutes, the guardian reluctantly collapsed in front of Lin Moyu.

[Killed Outpost Guardian, EXP +3,300,000]

[Obtained gold rank weapon: Hell Outpost Dagger]

[Obtained gold rank protective equipment: Hell Outpost Shield]

[Obtained gold rank accessory: Hell Outpost Bracelet]

[Obtained Dragonkind core x2]

[Obtained awakening certificate]

[Obtained title: Dragonkind Slayer]

[Hell Outpost Dagger (a part of the outpost set): gold rank weapon, all attributes +500, increases the power of Assassin-type skills by 50%, usable after level 30]

[Hell Outpost Shield (a part of the outpost set): gold rank protective equipment, all attributes +300, increases the resistance to control-type skills by 50%, reduces control time by 50%, usable after level 30]

[Hell Outpost Bracelet (a part of the outpost set): gold rank accessory, all attributes +200, increases the restoration of spirit force by 30%, usable after level 30]

[Dragonkind core: an extremely rare material that can be used to make various items]

[Awakening certificate: an item necessary to undergo the second awakening; may only drop in hell rank dungeons (soul bound, untradable)]

[Dragonkind Slayer: all attributes +500, reduces the consumption of all skills by 50% (this title can be obtained by soloing the hell rank Dragonkind Frontline Outpost)]

Light appeared on Lin Moyu's body, indicating that he leveled up.

After soloing the hell rank dungeon, which nearly took 10 hours, Lin Moyu leveled up again.

Less than a day of arriving at Dimensional Battlefield, he raised his level from level 22 to level 23. This speed is incredibly fast.

Lin Moyu didn't pay attention to his level up at this time, but instead looked at the items he obtained.

Despite his always calm demeanor, he was quite shocked at this moment.

He has seen Dragonkind dungeon weapons -- namely ordinary outpost weapons and nightmare outpost weapons -- in the First Fortress's trade office.

They all came from Dragonkind Frontline Outpost. However, the former came from the normal rank dungeon, while the latter came from nightmare rank dungeon.

Although both are gold rank weapons, yet their attributes differ greatly. The price also differs greatly.

Ordinary outpost weapons are equivalent to the worst gold rank weapons and only cost around 300,000 gold coins., and they have no military merit requirement.

Nightmare outpost weapons are basically equivalent to top gold rank weapons and are priced between 1.5 to 2 million gold coins, and only five-star privates are eligible to purchase them.

As for the hell outpost weapons, their attributes exceeded those of gold rank weapons and reached the level of platinum rank weapons.

The same it also true for other equipment.

Being able to use weapons and equipment with attributes equivalent to platinum rank at level 30 can greatly increase combat power.

As for the price, Lin Moyu has never seen hell outpost equipment in the trade office.

The hell rank dungeon was too difficult to raid. Coupled with the fact that each party is restricted to a few people, there naturally weren't many hell rank equipment around.

These equipment were generally digested within the party. As such, very few were taken out for trade.

Dragonkind core is one of the items from Bai Yiyuan's list.

Lin Moyu finally learned that this item is dropped by the boss. It was no wonder he only has to procure five unites.

At this time, Lin Moyu has already completed a portion of Bai Yiyuan's mission.

After raiding the hell rank dungeon once, he obtained 8 Dragonkind horns, 4 Dragonkind blood essences, 4 Dragonkind hearts, and 2 Dragonkind cores.

He has completed more than one-third of the mission.

With just two more raids, he should be able to meet Bai Yiyuan's requirements.

Subsequently, there was the awakening certificate.

Lin Moyu unexpectedly obtained the certificate necessary to undergo the second awakening.

Regarding the second awakening, he only knows that it is very difficult to achieve, and that an awakening certificate is required.

Lin Moyu didn't expect to be able to get it so soon.

The awakening certificate can't be traded and must be obtained by the person themselves.

When they reach level 40, many class users will be stuck, unable to undergo the second awakening.

Lastly, there was the title.

Going solo in a dungeon can you earn a title, this was quite unexpected.

Titles are very difficult to obtain, but their impact is quite significant.

To be able to obtain a title, it is really remarkable.

The key point is that titles are unique.

The same title can only be obtained by one person.

At least, before Lin Moyu drops dead, others won't be able to obtain this title.

This suggests that he might be the first person in the entire world to solo the hell rank Dragonkind Frontline Outpost.

It makes sense. Except for Lin Moyu, no one else would be able to deal with these abnormal control-type skills.

Dragonkind Slayer: raises all attributes by 500, reduces the consumption of skills by 50%.

The title has great effects.

The 50% reduction of the consumption of skills is of special interest. It means that Lin Moyu can be more at ease when using Soul Blaze and Corpse Explosion.

Even when he needs to replenish the numbers of Skeletal Warriors and Skeletal Mages, it'll be much easier to accomplish it.

He impatiently activated the title, and then checked his attributes.

As his level rises, the level of his skills will rise as well.

The hidden feature of the class Necromancer is that, so long as the level of the skills is the same as his level, the skills will level up along with his level.

This saves Lin Moyu a lot of time, which he would otherwise have to spend on grinding his skills.

After they advanced to level 23, the four attributes of the Skeletal Warriors reached 16,500 points, while the spirit attribute of Skeletal Mages reached 33,000 points.
