[Equipment: Goblin King's Magic Book, Robe of Knowledge]

[Summon space: 120/200, Skeletal Warriors (120)]

[Talents: Comprehensive Amplification (level 3, unique)]

[Passive skills: Damage Transfer]

[Active skills: Soul Blaze (level 20), Summon Skeletal Warrior (level 20), Corpse Explosion (level 2), Slowing Curse (level 1)]

[Comprehensive Amplification (level 3): enhances the effects of all skills by 30 times.]

[Damage Transfer: all damage taken by the host will be borne by the summons.]

[Soul Blaze (level 20): deals damage to target's soul; its power depends on your spirit force and the skill's level.]

[Summon Skeletal Warrior (level 20): summons a Silver Skeletal Warrior.]

[Corpse Explosion (level 2), detonate a corpse and deal 15% of the corpse's health as damage to enemies within a radius of two meters.]

[Slowing Curse (level 1): curses enemies within a range of five meters and reduces their speed by 5%; lasts for one minute.]

Chapter 83: Killing A Boss Almost In An Instant

83 - Killing A Boss Almost In An Instant

Godly talent: Comprehensive Amplification.

It is his most important ability.

The talent Comprehensive Amplification reached level 3.

The amplification rate has increased from 20 to 30 times.

The upgrade is quite significant.

The power of Soul Blaze has increased greatly.

It was a powerful single target skill to begin with.

After a 30-fold amplification, its offensive power has become terrifying.

Soul Blaze is a very powerful tool for interrupting the skills of bosses.

And there is still the very important skill Corpse Explosion.

Corpse Explosion is still level 2. But after the amplification, its range has reached 60 meters.

A range of 60 meters is already quite considerable.

And the damage has reached 450% of the corpse's health.

If a monster is detonated nearby, no other monster of similar type will be able to withstand it.

The skill Slowing Curse also benefits from his talent's level up; its range has reached 150 meters, and the deceleration effect has reached 150%.

Furthermore, the duration has reached 30 minutes.

Finally, Lin Moyu opened the attribute panel of the Skeletal Warriors.

After the skill has reached level 20, the Skeletal Warriors have been upgraded from bronze rank to silver rank.

There must be a significant increase in their attributes.

At level 19, after being amplified, the four attributes of the Skeletal Warriors have reached 6,200 points.

Their actual attributes were at 310 points, which is neither high nor low. In fact, it is similar to ordinary wild monsters of the same level.

With sufficient Skeletal Warriors, even without the talent's amplification, it will still be easy to fight monsters in the wild.

At most, the hunting speed will decrease.

But now...

The Skeletal Warriors standing in front of him are silver white.

Compared to when they were bronze rank, they are a bit taller and emit a silver white luster.

Their bones have become smoother.

The large blades in their hands have become sharper, as if carefully forged equipment, without any signs of wear.

All these changes are telling Lin Moyu that he has become stronger.

[Silver Skeletal Warrior]

[Strength: 12,000]

[Agility: 12,000]

[Spirit: 12,000]

[Physique: 12,000]

[Skill: Berserk Strike (level 2)]

[Berserk Strike (level 2): deals 300% of the skill user's strength as damage; cooldown period of 10 minutes.]

When Lin Moyu saw these attributes, his whole body felt a little numb.

He was shocked once again.

12,000 points in the four attributes.

This has reached five figures.

The basic attributes are at 400 points, which is not very high.

The most amazing thing is his talent.

"Silver Skeletal Warrior, how much spirit force does it cost to summon one..."

Lin Moyu came up with a question.

The level increased and attributes became stronger, but what about the consumption?

He tried to summon one.

A significant drop in spirit force occurred in an instant, from 1,320 to 820.

His eyebrows stirred involuntarily.

"A consumption of 500 points of spirit force, that's quite a lot."

"It seems I need to get some equipment to raise my spirit force."

At present, he can only summon two skeletons at a time. It will take ages to fill the summon space.

Since he has reached level 20, he can use silver rank equipment now.

Lin Moyu decided to go to the trade office to see if he can buy suitable silver rank equipment.

At the same time, he is also going to purchase a bunch of elementary skill scrolls.

After a significant increase in their attributes, the Silver Skeletal Warriors slashed apart the spider web in two to three strokes.

Then they rushed in headfirst.

Faced with the Skeletal Warriors charging toward it, the Spider King assumed a combat posture.

This time, Lin Moyu didn't take action. He wants to see how powerful the Silver Skeletal Warriors are.

Skill: Spit Web!

A huge net emerged.

At first, Lin Moyu felt that the Skeletal Warriors would be caught in it again.

But then several Skeletal Warriors suddenly jumped up and swung their large blades.

Accompanied by faint noise, the sound of the spider web being cut rose.

The Skeletal Warriors passed through the spider web without stopping and continued to charge toward the Spider King.

"They have become self-aware."

"It seems that becoming self-aware has increased their combat power."

They now adapt according to the situation, instead of just hacking away as before.

If this is the case for silver rank, then what about gold rank and platinum rank? Will the Skeletal Warriors become like real Warriors, like class users.

After reaching silver rank, the Skeletal Warriors have undergone a complete transformation.

Not only have their attributes increased greatly, but they have also gained combat awareness.

In the blink of an eye, the Skeletal Warriors have reached the Spider King's legs.

The silver white blades of some Skeletal Warriors emitted red light, and they slashed at the Spider King's legs.

Skill: Berserk Strike!

12,000 points of strength, plus a 300% attack bonus.

This skill deserves to contain the word berserk in its name.

Red light illuminated the cavern.

As if they were vegetables, the Spider King's legs were neatly chopped off.

Accompanied by shrieks, the Spider King fell to the ground.

At this time, some other Skeletal Warriors activated their skill.

Large blades fell on the Spider King.

[Killed Spider King, EXP +190,000]

[Obtained a silver rank weapon, Spider Stave]

[Obtained an elementary core]

[Spider Dagger: silver rank, spirit +40, physique +40, increases the power of magic skills by 8%, usable after level 20]

Upon seeing the notification, Lin Moyu was taken aback.

Is this it?

With the Skeletal Warriors activating their skill, the battle took less than 10 seconds.

A magnificent dungeon boss died just like that?

Faced with Silver Skeletal Warriors, whose four attributes have reached 12,000 points, the Spider King couldn't even summon its subordinates.

That was really fast.

When he checked his EXP, Lin Moyu was at a loss for words.

He obtained 190,000 EXP, yet his EXP only increased by 0.2%.

After level 20, the leveling speed has slowed down by several times.

In general, in order to go from level 20 to level 30, it can take one year if it's fast or three years if it's slow.

One of the requirements for entering Chuangshen Institute is level 30.

Individuals who can reach level 30 in a short period of time are very impressive characters.

While people like his sister, who entered Chuangshen Institute just a few months after entering the academy, are few and far between.

Lin Moyu didn't linger in Dungeon Hall and directly used the Teleportation Stone to return to the dormitory.

Next he left the dormitory and headed for the trade office.

The imperial trade office and the academic trade office are located one next to the other.

Although the two look a bit different, but there is an overarching style that connects them.

They are collectively referred to as trade center by the students.

Lin Moyu first went to the academic trade office, where a large number of items are sold that can only be redeemed with points.

The biggest difference between it and the imperial trade office is that you can't directly sell items to the academic trade office.

Lin Moyu found several missions, mostly material retrieval missions.

He handed over some materials he obtained and obtained 150 points.

This is one of the ways many students earn points.

Then he went to the imperial trade office and sold all the remaining items.

Lin Moyu didn't bother with consignment sale. After all, the price difference isn't that big, and he is too lazy to study the prices.

Instead, it's better to use that time and effort to do dungeon raid a couple more times.

Compared to bronze rank equipment, silver rank equipment is more valuable.

He sold several pieces of silver rank equipment, several pieces of bronze rank equipment, and some miscellaneous materials for a total of 430,000 gold coins.

His total assets reached 610,000 gold coins and 135,000 points.

After setting two records, his points not only not decreased, but they even increased.

Lin Moyu searched the imperial trade office but couldn't find the equipment he needed.

In the end, he spent 600,000 gold coins and bought 6 elementary skill scrolls.

"Six scrolls... this might not be enough."

To be on the safe side, he went to the academic trade office once again.

There are also elementary skill scrolls for sale in the academic trade office, priced at 800 points per scroll.

According to the exchange ratio of 1 point for 100 gold coins, 800 points can only be exchanged for 80,000 gold coins, which isn't enough to buy a skill scroll in the imperial trade office.

This can highlight the stronger purchasing power and higher value of points.

This is not only true for skill scrolls, the same is also true for other equipment and items.

After a moment of thought, Lin Moyu bought 10 elementary skill scrolls, using 8,000 points.

"16 scroll should be enough."

After buying the skill scrolls, he started looking at other items.

Some equipments and items here are not available in the imperial trade office.

For example, Lin Moyu saw a silver rank weapon.

This weapon is called Spirit Sword, and it doesn't originate from a dungeon, but was forged by a Blacksmith class user called Zhang Tie.

Blacksmith is a support-type class, and it can enable you to forge weapons and armor that class users require.

[Spirit Sword: silver rank, spirit +400, usable after level 20]

[Maker: Zhang Tie]

[Introduction: a part of a three-piece spirit set]

There is no skill buff, only a spirit bonus of 400 points.

Compared to a top silver rank stave that provides a spirit force boost of 200 point and increases the power of magic-type skills by 15%, the Spirit Sword is less practical.

Most Mages won't choose to use it.

The Spirit Sword seems a bit unconventional among silver rank weapons.

Only a special Mage-type support like Prophet that requires a lot of spirit force to cast skills would choose such an unconventional weapon.

Lin Moyu is interested in its boost of spirit force.

He currently has 125 Skeletal Warriors and one Skeletal Mage, and there are still 74 vacant slots in the summon space.

Since there are still some Desert Fruits left, Lin Moyu plans to fill these slots.

He ate a Desert Fruit and then summoned five Skeletal Warriors, bringing the number of Skeletal Warriors to 130.

Then he began to furiously summon Skeletal Mages.

Fire-type... wind-type... lightning-type...

Skeletal Mages of different types appeared next to Lin Moyu one after another.

No matter the type, the attributes of the Skeletal Mages are the same. The difference lies in their skill.

Fire Skeletal Mage: [Skill: Flame Burst]

[Flame Burst: deals fire elemental damage to the target; attack power depends on spirit force]

Ice Skeletal Mage: [Skill: Frozen Tempest]

[Frozen Tempest: forms an ice storm within its range and deals ice elemental damage to the target; its power depends on spirit force]

Wind Skeletal Mage: [Skill: Cyclone Storm]

[Cyclone Storm: forms a tornado within its range and deals wind elemental damage to the target; attack power depends on spirit force]

Lightning Skeletal Mage: [Skill: Thunderstruck]

[Thunderstruck: deals lightning elemental damage to the target; attack power depends on spirit force]

The skill of the fire- and lightning-type Skeletal Mages are single target attacks, while the skill of the ice- and wind-type Skeletal Mages are AOE attacks.

Compared to Skeletal Warriors, their silver frames are a bit shorter, but the soul fire in theirs heads is more vigorous.

Elemental particles rolled and flowed in their hands, showcasing tremendous power.

Lin Moyu thinks that his Skeletal Mages are capable of instantly killing Mage class users of the same level.

By the time the Desert Fruits were all consumed, the summon space was filled at last.

130 Skeletal Warriors and 70 Skeletal Mages, a total of 200 skeletons, formed a skeletal army.

With the skeletal army, Lin Moyu believes that dungeons of the same level can be swept with ease.

Not to mention nightmare rank dungeons, even hell rank dungeons pose no problem.

Just like Tyrant Desert, a large-scale dungeon that requires a party of 40 people to be cleared, he can sweep it with ease.

The skeletal army is much more powerful than a party composed of 40 people.

"When I come next time, I'll train another skill."

In addition to Summon Skeletal Mage, Lin Moyu still has Bone Armor and Slowing Curse to train.

So long as he has a bountiful supply of spirit force, these two skills will pose no difficult.

Corpse Explosion, however, is an exception. After all, there aren't that many corpses.

When monsters in a dungeon are killed, their corpses will disappear soon after.

Furthermore, he can't overuse the skill. He still needs to leave some spirit force in case there's an emergency.

It took about four hours to train the skill.

Since he entered the dungeon, over 8 hours have passed already.

The strength, agility, and spirit of the Four Queen Ant's Personal Guards are all average.

Only their physique is rather high.

Coupled with their skill, they are basically meat shield incarnate.

With them around, the safety of the queen ant can be greatly upgraded.

The queen ant is the most important individual in the entire ant colony, so there is no room for error.

Other parties have a headache when they see the four personal guards.

They need to find a way to kill them one by one.

As for Lin Moyu, their presence made things easier.

By the time he used Detection, the Skeletal Warriors have already rushed out.

The Queen Ant's Personal Guards have also rushed forward.

The wings of the queen ant vibrated, and she suddenly let out a sharp cry.

Skill: Sonic Wave Attack.

The Skeletal Warriors also paid attention to the sky as they advanced.

Under a round of concentrated fire, several Lionman Warriors collapsed to the ground.

Skill: Corpse Explosion!

Following a loud blast, the vicinity was cleared.

[Killed level 28 Desert Lionman Warrior, EXP +390,000]

[Obtained Lionman leather x5]

Within a range of 60 meters, no Lionman Warrior was able to survive.

EXP soared like a rocket.

Lionman Warriors continued to pour out of the military camp, but they couldn't stop Lin Moyu's advance.
