①: Fairy Rabbit, ②: Thorny Flower Rabbit, ③: Budding Flower Rabbit

(Excessive fear, severe stress reaction, and moderate gastrointestinal injury.)

The appearance of this data immediately excited two lines of thought in Fang Mu.

Firstly, this Aromatherapy Rabbit is a perfect match with the Red Jade Mountain Tea.

However, if a Junior Creator were to take a look, they would absolutely be able to recognize the uniqueness of the Aromatherapy Rabbit.

His first Guardian Beast must be an Elemental Beast.

Making this decision, on one hand, is because Fang Mu is very sure he has the ability to become a Creator.
