Chapter 1171: Prism Blessing!

A Heaven Calamity Ghost Series Beast truly lived up to its name. The Hair-Eating Ice Crone had evolved to the Golden Stage One Legendary Quality, gaining a new skill and two exclusive attributes, further perfecting the Hair-Eating Ice Crone's combat system.

Even without relying on other Guardian Beasts, the Hair-Eating Ice Crone alone could still hold its ground.

Among Jiang Tuo's several Guardian Beasts, the Hair-Eating Ice Crone was the most suitable to serve as a core Guardian Beast.

The role of the Hair-Eating Ice Crone was very similar to that of Zhang Yue's Forest Thorns, encompassing offense, defense, and control.

Although the Hair-Eating Ice Crone did not have the ability to heal other Guardian Beasts or Jiang Tuo, it could heal itself using the exclusive attribute [Ice Woman's Rejuvenation], placing itself in an amplified state.

In this rejuvenation state, the rate of energy depletion, injury recovery, and ice hair attack speed within the Hair-Eating Ice Crone would all significantly increase.

This allowed Jiang Tuo to masterfully control the Hair-Eating Ice Crone in battles, enabling it to hold the scene effectively.

The Hair-Eating Ice Crone's Gold Level Skill [Hair-tip Drill] was currently its most potent offensive tactic.
The hair tips condensed into drill heads, rotating at high speed to strike the target.
This could not only breach the target's defense but also infiltrate the target with chillness, keeping them continuously in a frozen state.
For those targets with weak resistance to ice attributes, the continuous freezing effect would render them immobile.
For those with strong resistance to ice attributes, it would still make their movements sluggish.
When the Hair-Eating Ice Crone attacked targets with the skill [Hair-tip Drill], it also effectively controlled the field for Jiang Tuo's other Guardian Beasts.
The exclusive attribute [Three Combs of Ice Hair] could be considered both a burst ability and a control ability.
The Hair-Eating Ice Crone's attacks kept applying the freezing effect on the target.
Once the freezing effect accumulated three layers, the chill inside their body would explode.

Elemental explosion was not overwhelmingly damaging, but for those Guardian Beasts relying on elemental combat, it was akin to a nightmare.
Ice Blast could disrupt the resonance between that Guardian Beast and other Elemental Beasts, preventing them from using any element-related skills and exclusive attributes.
Before even exploring Jiang Tuo's other two Ice Ghosts, Fang Mu couldn't help but marvel at his own past decisions having indeed created such a formidable monster!
If there were no Vicious Beasts and contaminants beforehand, and if Jiang Tuo's Ice Ghosts were at the same level as his own Guardian Beasts.
Fang Mu wouldn't dare guarantee that he could defeat Jiang Tuo.
Because as Jiang Tuo's Beast Master star level increased, through his Destiny Guardian Beast Bingxiao, he could control even more Ice Ghosts.
Fang Mu using his controlled Undead Creatures to combat the Ice Ghosts held no advantage.
However, with Fang Mu's ability to contract contaminants and Vicious Beasts, defeating Jiang Tuo wouldn't be difficult.

Fang Mu never valued the offensive power of Guardian Beasts in contracts but rather their functionality
In terms of talents, Fang Mu's Yan Yubanruo was stronger than all of Jiang Tuo's Ice Ghosts!
Yan Yubanruo governed control over Dead Creatures through [Golem Paper Control], relying not just on its potential but also on the vast potential of dead creatures.
And the resources provided subsequently to these dead creatures.
All of these continuously raised the potential limit of Yan Yubanruo.
"Xiao Tuo, your Hair-Eating Ice Crone is well-cultivated; its quality has now increased to Epic Quality."
"From now on, whenever your Beast Master star level increases, you may freely upgrade the class of these Ice Ghosts!"
Upon hearing this, Jiang Tuo's eyes twinkled as he spoke to Fang Mu.
"Brother Mu, I owe all of my growth today to your nurturing!"

"If you hadn't healed my Destiny Guardian Beast and provided me with all these top-tier ice property Heaven Calamity Ghost Series Beasts and unlimited resources from top Grandmaster Creators for my use,"
"How could I have possibly developed to this point!?"
Although Jiang Tuo had endured hardships from a young age, he was never one to sell himself short.
On the contrary, there was pride in his heart.
Jiang Tuo's grandfather, Jiang Weng, was a genuine Forging Spirit Grandmaster.
Though not as esteemed as a Grandmaster Creator, a Forging Spirit Grandmaster was still highly regarded wherever they went, receiving ample respect.
However, Jiang Tuo was well aware that his grandfather could not provide him with such resources.
Jiang Tuo had sought medical treatment with Jiang Weng everywhere since he was young.
Despite his young years, his mental age had long reached that of an individual in their mid-to-late twenties.

Upon hearing this, Fang Mu reached out and ruffled the back of Jiang Tuo's head.
"Xiao Tuo, you shouldn't say such things in the future."

Jiang Tuo mulled over Fang Mu's words, "Reliant on each other, teammates who can entrust their backs to one another."
These words deeply moved Jiang Tuo and made him, who had never been part of a team, appreciate the significance of teamwork even more.
While pondering, Jiang Tuo summoned his Ice Mirror Cat again.
[Beast Name]: Ice Mirror Cat
[Beast Species]: Mirror Ghost Kind/Beast Ghost Kind
[Beast Level]: Gold (1/10)
[Beast Element]: Ice Type
[Beast Potential]: Platinum Tier
[Beast Quality]: Legendary Quality

Skill:
[Fallen Broken Ice Mirror]: Creates a series of highly defensive ice mirrors through the combination of ghost energy and ice element energy. Its twin tails can seal other targets or energy attacks within the ice mirrors. When an ice mirror breaks, there is the option to either banish the contents within or release them.
[Ice Mirror Swap]: When there are multiple ice mirrors present on the field, it can make designated ice mirrors swap places. Each time an ice mirror is swapped, a new ice mirror will appear on the field.
[Broken Mirror Conduction]: When an ice mirror breaks, it can autonomously choose whether to conduct the damage it has sustained to the target sealed within the ice mirror. If damage conduction is chosen, the ice mirror will amplify the damage to some extent.
Exclusive Traits:
[Regeneration Mirror]: Damaged ice mirrors can absorb ice element energy from the surrounding environment to repair themselves, and this self-repair does not consume the Ice Mirror Cat's own energy.
[Reinforced Ice Mirror]: Enhances the sturdiness of all the ice mirrors it creates, bolstering their external damage-taking ability as well as their capacity to protect the contents within.

[Prism Blessing]: Before any ice mirror created by it shatters, any fatal blow it receives will be transferred to the ice mirror instead, preventing it from entering a near-death state. Each shattered ice mirror increases its malice, thus increasing its speed of creating new ice mirrors.
Compared to the offensive-oriented Ice Ghost like the Hair-Eating Ice Crone, the Ice Mirror Cat's role is clearly that of a functional Ice Ghost.
The Ice Mirror Cat's abilities are quite similar to the Ice Kid in the Reverse Mirror, both using mirrors as their weapon.
Unlike the Ice Kid in the Reverse Mirror, which can only have one ice mirror at a time, the Ice Mirror Cat can create multiple ice mirrors simultaneously.
It cleverly uses the ice mirrors to store enemy Guardian Beasts or opponents' elemental attacks, sealing them within the mirrors.
It can cleverly swap the positions of ice mirrors to strike at the enemy or assist its own side.
The Ice Mirror Cat's newly acquired skill [Broken Mirror Conduction] has it proactively absorb attacks when it has sealed an enemy Guardian Beast.
The external attacks will not only be conducted onto the Guardian Beast sealed inside the ice mirrors, but the ice mirror itself can also amplify the conducted attacks.

An enemy Guardian Beast sealed within an ice mirror cannot sense what is happening outside the ice mirror before breaking free.
Therefore, they are completely incapable of preemptively defending against attacks endured by the ice mirror.
The Ice Mirror Cat moves extremely fast.
If the Ice Mirror Cat can catch the right moment and control the opponent's assassin-type Guardian Beast,
even if Jiang Tuo's side is at a disadvantage, it could very well turn the tide of the battle.
The exclusive trait [Reinforced Ice Mirror] obtained upon advancing to Epic Quality enhances both the internal and external toughness of the ice mirrors created by the Ice Mirror Cat.
It significantly increases the role that the Ice Mirror Cat can play in battle.
The control, defense, and offensive capabilities of the ice mirror had all received significant enhancements.
Upon ascending to Legendary Quality, the exclusive trait, [Prism Blessing], greatly enhanced the self-preservation ability of the Ice Mirror Cat.

This allowed the functional Guardian Beast, Ice Mirror Cat, to avoid being instantly killed by enemies targeting it in battle.
The ice mirror would help the Ice Mirror Cat to bear the damage.
This enabled the exclusive trait [Prism Blessing] to work in conjunction with the skill [Broken Mirror Conduction], producing unexpected effects.
Although this would accelerate the rate at which the ice mirrors deteriorated, the Ice Mirror Cat could increase the rate at which ice mirrors condensed based on the resentment generated from each layer of broken ice mirror, by virtue of [Prism Blessing].
In sustained battles, the Ice Mirror Cat's endurance capabilities were improved.
Jiang Tuo's Destiny Guardian Beast, Bingxiao, could replenish energy for these Ice Ghosts, enough to support the Ice Mirror Cat in constantly creating ice mirrors.
According to Jiang Tuo, normally it takes about thirty seconds for the Ice Mirror Cat to create an ice mirror.
With the exclusive trait [Prism Blessing], after breaking ten ice mirrors, the Ice Mirror Cat would likely be able to reduce the ice mirror creation time to less than ten seconds.

The endless ice mirrors on the battlefield would become a nightmare for the enemy.
Jiang Weng had consistently communicated with Fang Mu.
Apart from helping Fang Mu collect materials for creating Ghost Devices, Jiang Weng had been researching the crafting process for Diamond-grade Spirit Boxes.
Three Spirit Forging Masters and eleven Advanced Spirit Forgers had recently joined under Jiang Weng.
Spirit Forgers below Advanced level did not possess the capability to craft Diamond-grade Spirit Boxes, so Jiang Tuo did not even consider them.
All of these fourteen Spirit Forgers had been controlled using the Soul Parasite Ant progeny from the newly-born Bond Ants by Jiang Tuo.
Jiang Tuo had stockpiled many Diamond-grade Spirit Boxes of various shapes, ready to flood the market with them at any time to exchange for a vast amount of resources for Fang Mu.
More than Fang Mu's mentorship to him, Jiang Weng was grateful for Fang Mu's training of Jiang Tuo.

Initially, Jiang Weng was quite happy about Fang Mu's promises, but he did not take them to heart seriously.
Jiang Weng simply hoped Fang Mu could help Jiang Tuo successfully merge with his Destiny Guardian Beast and become a Beast Master.
To avoid any more suffering due to the inability to merge with his Destiny Guardian Beast.
As long as Fang Mu could achieve that, Jiang Weng was willing to honor his promise.
Jiang Weng had known in advance that Fang Mu was a disciple of a Grandmaster Creator.
Even as a Grandmaster Creator's disciple, one shouldn't be able to control such an immense amount of resources.
Yet, Fang Mu did as he said, providing Jiang Tuo with ample resources, allowing him to truly contract several Catastrophe-Level Ice Ghosts and providing them with the highest quality resources.
At first, Jiang Weng didn't quite believe it when Jiang Tuo spoke of it.
It was only after bringing Jiang Tuo back with him and investigating his Guardian Beasts.

That Jiang Weng had no doubts in his mind.
This was also the reason why Jiang Weng had been working so diligently for Fang Mu during this period!
Even going as far as to use his own connections.
Otherwise, how would it be possible to gather three Spirit Forging Masters and eleven Advanced Spirit Forgers in just over a month?
Especially since these Spirit Forging Masters and Advanced Spirit Forgers were all willing to be controlled by the Soul Parasite Ants and to offer their absolute loyalty.
Among all the Ice Ghosts Jiang Tuo had, Jiang Weng's favorite was the Ice Mirror Cat.
In Jiang Weng's opinion, the skills of the Ice Mirror Cat could maximize a Beast Master's capabilities in battle.
With its strong practicality, if an experienced Beast Master were to manipulate it to assist other Guardian Beasts, there was a high chance of defeating stronger opponents across ranks!
This was very different from Fang Mu's preferences.

Fang Mu consistently valued Zhanbing Guhuo more than the Ice Mirror Cat.
At this moment, Jiang Tuo had already summoned Zhanbing Guhuo.

Zhanbing Guhuo was originally clad in very little clothing, wearing an extremely short skirt and covered with a layer of frost veil.
But now, Zhanbing Guhuo was shrouded in a pristine, snowy cloak.
The snowy cloak concealed Zhanbing Guhuo's body, only leaving her head exposed.
The longsword in Zhanbing Guhuo's hand was also hidden within the snowy cloak.
The snowflakes on the cloak refracted the light in the environment, causing Zhanbing Guhuo to appear in a semi-invisible state.
Most importantly, Fang Mu, relying on his spiritual power to sense, felt as if Zhanbing Guhuo had vanished from sight.
Fang Mu inwardly remarked that Zhanbing Guhuo must have gained a method to hide herself.

Otherwise, even if something couldn't be seen with the eyes, it should be detectable with spiritual power!

[Beast Species]: Cut Ghost Family/Bird Ghost Kind
[Beast Level]: Gold Stage (1/10)
[Beast Element]: Ice Type
[Beast Potential]: Platinum Tier

Skills:

[Frost Shadow Hunt]: Can move stealthily in an ice attribute environment, triggering multiple segments of damage with every sword slash, with the first segment inflicting a cutting effect. The wounds of enemy units will transform into Ice Elemental Energy, assimilating into oneself and bestowing an Instant Slash State.
[Frost Star Feather Mark]: Adds a mark to the target, which, once under the effect of the mark, will take double damage from attacks originating from oneself! Each time the double damage effect is triggered, there's a certain probability that the Frost Star Feather Mark will spread to others.
[Clone Blade Slash]: Uses ice and snow energy to split one's own body according to the target, creating a physical ice clone to slash at the target, inflicting equal amounts of damage as the original body, albeit with a twenty percent increase in energy consumption.
Exclusive Traits:
[Frost Snow Added]: Uses the Ice Elemental Energy from the surrounding environment to enhance oneself. After sealing the Ice Elemental Energy tainted by ghostly aura from around the environment, the strength can be enhanced based on the intensity of the Ice Elemental Energy, falling into a weakened state after each seal (the more Ice Elemental Energy absorbed, the longer the weakened state will last!).

[Ice Frost Attack Soul]: When inflicting damage on the target's physical body through ice and snow energy, the target's spiritual power and soul power will suffer the same attack effects. When the spirit

[Void Ice Feather]: The Void Ice Feathers grown on the body can enhance the stealth effect in the environment, simultaneously shielding against exploration through spiritual power and soul power.

and soul are beset by the invasion of Ice Frost Attack Soul, they will fall into a prolonged state of sluggishness.
After probing Zhanbing Guhuo's data, Fang Mu noted that her combat capability had become much more comprehensive than before.
Under normal circumstances, assassin-type Guardian Beasts typically target a single opponent.
But with the skill [Clone Blade Slash], Zhanbing Guhuo could now attack a group of targets by creating clones.
This method of group attack did require a twenty percent increase in energy consumption.
While the consumption was greater, this skill was definitely worth it.
Jiang Tuo, arranged by Fang Mu to represent the Infinite Tower against the young generation of other forces, would inevitably face opponents who have contracted insect Beast Masters.
Those who have contracted insect Guardian Beasts preferred to employ an overwhelming swarm strategy.

It was difficult to match against opponents using the overwhelming swarm strategy on the Battle Network, as training insect Guardian Beasts to that level was incredibly challenging and required substantial resources.
However, the young elites of major forces don't need to worry about the consumption of resources when training Guardian Beasts.
Jiang Tuo had always lacked means to counter multiple targets, relying only on the Hair-Eating Ice Crone and its ice hair's wide-range attacks for group combat.
However, the skills of the Hair-Eating Ice Crone were designed for single targets, making them relatively weaker against groups.
Now, Zhanbing Guhuo's Gold Level skill [Clone Blade Slash] compensated for Jiang Tuo's shortcomings in this area.
The new exclusive trait [Void Ice Feather] of Zhanbing Guhuo was the main reason it could shield itself from Fang Mu's spiritual power probes.
With the exclusive trait [Void Ice Feather], Zhanbing Guhuo could not only increase its stealth in the environment and block spiritual power probes.
But it could also shield against probes from the Soul Level.

Making Zhanbing Guhuo a presence that's nearly impossible to detect by peers of the same rank on the battlefield.
The Legendary Quality exclusive traits [Ice Frost Attack Soul] and [Void Ice Feather] were essentially equivalent.
While [Void Ice Feather] shielded against spiritual and soul power probes, [Ice Frost Attack Soul] inflicted the same damage to the target's spirit and soul as it did to the physical body using ice and snow energy.
The erosion by frost made the target's spirit and soul sluggish.
This made it difficult for the target to react promptly to subsequent attacks.
Fang Mu had always considered his Stealthy Hidden One to be exceptionally powerful, but judging by the current situation, if a comparison had to be made, Jiang Tuo's Zhanbing Guhuo would still come out on top!
After all, the Stealthy Hidden One could not launch an attack on the spirit and soul of the target.
One should know that Fang Mu's Stealthy Hidden One itself was a premium Undead Creature that was not easily found in the extensive Ancient Battlefield.  Chapter 1174: The Performance Match that Captivates the Masses!_2

The Stealthy Hidden One reached Fang Mu's hands, who then provided it with the highest quality nurturing.
However, when it came down to comparison, it still couldn't match the Zhanbing Guhuo.
It seemed that among the various ice attribute Heaven Calamity Ghost Series Beasts, the presence of Zhanbing Guhuo remained exceptionally outstanding.
After observing Jiang Tuo's three Ice Ghosts, Fang Mu patted him on the shoulder and began to speak.
"Xiao Tuo, your Ice Ghosts have grown exceptionally well."
"Just continue nurturing these Ice Ghosts in the current manner, don't worry about the consumption of resources."
With that, Fang Mu took out the remains of four bird creatures from his Purple Ice Crystal Ring.
These four bird creatures were acquired from Ning Hongshu and were highly compatible with the Bird Armor Puppet's unique feature "Bird Binding Performance."
These four bird-type controlled creatures were called Sword-shield Starbirds.

After maturing, Sword-shield Starbirds could choose to grow their upper beak bone into either a sword formation or a shield formation.
The sword formation Sword-shield Starbirds had a very strong attack power, and their beaks had a Shattered Shield and Cutting effect.
The shield formation Sword-shield Starbirds excelled in defense, with beaks capable of isolating elemental damage and weakening elemental resonance.
To isolate elemental damage was to resist the harm inflicted by elemental abilities.
Reducing elemental resonance meant that in the environment where the shield formation Sword-shield Starbirds resided, it was difficult for targets covered by the Sword-shield Starbirds' spiritual power to manipulate surrounding elements.
It kept elements from being as obedient as before, preventing them from being freely controlled by elemental creatures.
Dead shield formation Sword-shield Starbirds lacked spiritual power.
However, once they became derivatives of the Bird Armor Puppet, the Bird Armor Puppet could stimulate the effects of the shield formation Sword-shield Starbird skulls through spiritual power!

Wang Mi and Xu Fengnian also recommended various bird-type controlled creatures to Fang Mu, but after review, Fang Mu felt the Sword-shield Starbirds were the best choice!
At that time, Ning Hongshu had only four Sword-shield Starbird carcasses, but she assured Fang Mu.
She guaranteed that she could provide more than ten Sword-shield Starbird carcasses for Fang Mu in the future.
These Sword-shield Starbird carcasses were more than enough for Hu Tao to use.

But Fang Mu and Hu Tao had only called forth this single Half-Elf, could they be planning to use this one Half-Elf to defeat both of the terror bears and that massive kangaroo?
