[Beast Species]: Walk Zombie Genus/Nightmare Zombie Species

[Beast Level]: Diamond Level (1/10)
[Beast Element]: Undying
[Beast Potential]: Diamond
[Beast Quality]: Legendary
Skills:
[Land Contamination]: Inject the Corpse Qi from inside his body into the ground beneath his feet, transforming the environment with the Corpse Qi, allowing undead creatures to be healed on the contaminated ground and the living to be affected by the Corpse Qi.
[Death Ground Worm]: Uses the contaminated death ground to produce silkworms, which, when they nibble on the living, can paralyze the bodies and intensify the pain.
[Worm Death Mark]: When the worms come into contact with the living, without attacking, they can directly merge into the target's body, creating a death mark, which will spontaneously condense the Dead Qi into the living's body, eroding the Life Energy within.
[Body Poison Covering Ground]: Activate Corpse Qi to transform into a special poison, which when used on undead creatures makes their attacks also carry the poison effect, without harming the undead. When used on living beings, it will cause their bodies to deteriorate greatly and nourish the Dead Qi.
[Wither Deadland]: Causes the death ground emanating from oneself to have withering properties, increasing the speed at which Dead Qi infects the living, accelerating the decay of flesh under the influence of Dead Qi. Once the living enter a withering state, the effectiveness of healing is greatly reduced.
Exclusive Traits:

[Death Ground Nightmare]: Nightmare Qi overlays the land corrupted by his own Corpse Qi, using the qi to obscure the vision of the living, and when the living probe the environment with spiritual power, the Nightmare Qi will contaminate the living's spiritual power.

[Split Body Expanding Territory]: When the area of transformed death ground reaches its current limit, he can split his body to let the separated body move and contaminate more land, increasing the area of the death ground.

[Death Ground Shaping Armor]: The energy of the death ground can be used to shape armor on selected undead creatures, significantly enhancing the defense of the dead and can shed the armor to remove certain types of control.

Evolutionary Path:

① Wraith Emperor Witch, ② Giant Bone Zombie King, ③ Nine-Armed Poisonous Zombie.

Upon investigation, what first caught Fang Mu's attention was not the new skills the Undead King from the Nether Realm acquired upon advancing to Diamond rank, but his three new Evolutionary Paths.

The Wraith Emperor Witch path indicated that the Undead King from the Nether Realm could possibly awaken one of the five supreme Bloodlines of Dead Creatures.

To become one of the five supreme Bloodlines of the Dead Creatures, the Emperor Witch!

The bloodline nobility of the Emperor Witch among Dead Creatures is like the revered status of the Barrier Sparrow among Bird Beast Species.

The Emperor Witch itself is proficient in attacking enemies with the energy of the Dead Qi.

Once the Undead King from the Nether Realm evolves into a Wraith Emperor Witch, all of his skills and exclusive traits will be greatly enhanced due to the bloodline's blessing.

Chapter 1313: Secret Void Spirit!

Compared to the evolutionary path of the Wraith Emperor Witch, the other two evolutionary paths seemed insignificant.

The paths of the Giant Bone Zombie King and the Nine-Armed Poisonous Zombie weren't even considered by Fang Mu.

From the perspective of bloodline, the Wraith Emperor Witch had become the top-tier existence among all of Fang Mu's dead creatures, but if it really came to preference, Fang Mu still favored the Ritual Cemetery Three Treasures more.

The bloodline advancement of the Ritual Cemetery Three Treasures could easily achieve an effect where one plus one plus one was greater than four, bearing infinite possibilities.

However, this was merely Fang Mu's own preference. Yan Yubanruo clearly favored the Wraith Emperor Witch, who had the potential to ascend to a Witch King.

[Beast Element]: Undying
[Beast Potential]: Diamond
[Beast Quality]: Legendary
Skills:
[Prayers of Light]: Absorb the surrounding light and convert this light into its own strength, enhancing itself with the light as much as its body can endure.
[Amulet Light Shock]: Upon hitting the target, burst forth the light-augmented power instantaneously, dealing an excessive blow to the target (the power enhanced by the light element will diminish, but it will not enter a weakened state).
[Blessing of Darkness]: When surrounded by Dark Element Energy, it will protect itself, enhancing its defense. If necessary, it can absorb the pervasive dark elements around to heal its injuries, and its Soul Flame will not extinguish as long as the dark elements persist.
[Dark Flame Devours]: Convert dark elements into flames, scorching the targeted area. As long as the dark elements persist, the scorching of the Dark Flame will not cease, and the energy lost by the target will replenish the energy consumed by itself.
[Light and Dark Brilliance]: When one type of elemental energy within it is enhanced, it will spur an excessive accommodation of the other type, balancing the elements so that even if the energy surpasses its bodily limits, it can still smoothly accommodate it within and utilize this elemental energy in battle.
Exclusive Traits:

[Cruel Nature]: Upon contact with the blood of the living, its ferocity will be greatly aroused, entering a hunting state, enhancing the damage inflicted on the injured and absorbing the life energy of specified injured individuals, transforming it into Dead Qi that it can manipulate.

[Super Sensitive Body]: The joints of the body are extremely responsive, allowing for unexpected postures to be used in combat that effectively strike the target.

[Evasive Wicked Mouth]: Absorbing light and dark dual-element energy through an evil mouth grown at the back of the brain, using this dual-element energy to strengthen oneself, and thus inducing a bizarre mutation. (Each mutation takes place in an unpredictable direction. Until the energy is fully released, it will not attack its own, but cannot control its slaughter of surrounding life.)

Evolutionary Path:

①: Keeper of Light and Darkness, ②: Devourer of Darkness, ③: Light Worshipper Keeper.

When Fang Mu saw the Diamond Level Skills [Light and Dark Brilliance] of the Light Worshipper Devouring Darkness, he hesitated, subconsciously feeling that the Diamond Level Skills [Light and Dark Brilliance] were not powerful.

However, when Fang Mu rethought the other skills and exclusive traits of Light Worshipper Devouring Darkness, he no longer thought so.

in one strike, it can absorb the ferocious energy on the target. If the target is not killed in one strike, the ferocious energy will disperse, and he will immediately enter a hidden state.

[Instant Shadow Slash]: Consumes double the energy inside the body to continuously launch three strikes at the target, each strike being stronger than the last. On the third strike, he can decide the outcome of the Curse Bone Coin's flip.

[Bone Double]: When attacking other targets, if the target is affected by the bone effect and enters a bone state, he can swap places with the unit in the bone state to sustain damage in his place when under intense attack.

[Escaping Void Splitting Slash]: Attacks with extreme speed. After causing damage to the target, he can vanish into the void to prevent counterattacks from the target, and the attack before entering the void has a defense-breaking effect.

Exclusive characteristics:

[Evil Spirit Mark]: By infusing ferocious energy, marks are placed on the living, and after each attack, he can choose a mark for teleportation.

[Barrier Breaking Sense]: Can effectively judge the weak points of the target's defenses during an attack and then prioritize attacking these weak spots.

[Curse Bone Coin]: Each time an attack is made on the opponent, the Curse Bone Coin will flip randomly.

- ① Heads: Enhances his own charging abilities.
- ② Tails: Has a chance to apply a bone effect to the target. If the target already has a bone effect, it will expand the bone effect's impact on the target.

Evolutionary Path:

① Secret Void Spirit, ② Bone Wing Evil Spirit, ③ Dream Slicing Evil Spirit.
