The presence of the Fusion Tyrant was astonishing, standing there like a giant at fourteen meters tall.

[Beast Name]: Barrier Phoenix [Beast Species]: Long-Winged/ Sturdy Winged [Beast Level]: Platinum (1/10) [Beast Element]: Metal [Beast Potential]: Diamond [Beast Quality]: Legendary

[City Wing]: Reinforces the wings to be as sturdy as city walls, significantly enhancing their hardness. The wings can deflect most physical damages when used to block attacks, and store energy from elemental attacks when impacted by them.

Skills:

[Firm Protection]: When shielding a designated target from damage, it can create a barrier on the target using its own energy. The barrier redirects the damage received by the target to itself, thereby enhancing its combat spirit, which can resist mental and spiritual trauma.

[Unload Wall]: Applies an Unload Wall command to an enemy target. The target under this command will have its defense reduced, and once it reaches a low, the Armor Break effect will spontaneously transform into a Spell Break effect.

[Burning Feather Lock]: Burns its own feathers to sublimate its tough feathers, removing negative effects on allied units. Once the feathers sublimate to a certain extent, they form feather locks, which when wrapped around a target nullify one of their unique traits, causing equal numbers of their traits to become ineffective as long as it does not use its unique traits.

Exclusive traits:

[Thorn Feather Crown]: Reduces damage sustained by half when guarding other targets. The more targets it protects, the less damage it endures, and it also receives slight healing when the guarded targets are healed.

[Suffering Siphon]: Absorbs and converts the damage suffered by itself or protected targets into vitality, healing itself based on the severity. Excess life energy is stored in the wings.

[Barrier Enhancement]: All defensive effects grow stronger with progression. Upon receiving an attack that could break the shield, it forms a barrier that blocks a single instance of damage not exceeding its own threshold after the shield detonation.

**Evolutionary Path:** 

1: Barrier Golden Phoenix, 2: Guarding Nation Arrow Phoenix, 3: Barrier Dragon Crane.

Upon examination, the Barrier Silver Phoenix had indeed evolved into a Barrier Phoenix, just as Fang Mu had anticipated!

Seeing the name Barrier Phoenix put Fang Mu's mind completely at ease.

Hu Tao's Iron Winged Green Pigeon evolving into a Barrier Phoenix confirmed Fang Mu's earlier thoughts were now fully realized.

As long as there are no major unexpected developments in its evolution, the Barrier Phoenix will continue to evolve along its current bloodline.

Evolving into a Barrier Golden Phoenix will not be possible when it advances to the Diamond rank due to its current bloodline status.

An attempt would only be made upon reaching a higher sequential stage.

Fang Mu would not consider either the Guarding Nation Arrow Phoenix or Barrier Dragon Crane among the three evolutionary paths, especially the Barrier Dragon Crane.

The Barrier Dragon Crane might potentially have a stronger combat capability than the Barrier Golden Phoenix, as it contains the strong bloodlines of Barrier Sparrow, Dragon race, and Crane Species.

While the Barrier Sparrow and Crane Species bloodlines could possibly fuse, the inclusion of the Dragon race bloodline makes fusion almost impossible!

If bloodline conflicts occur, it might lead to a collapse during rank progression and could potentially result in the death of the beast.

In the developmental process of Guardian Beasts during the Seventh Era, Creators often crossed various beasts to cultivate high-quality Guardian Beasts.

The offspring from these crossbred beasts often carried dual bloodlines and exhibited formidable power at lower tiers.

However, these beasts usually died from bloodline collisions during bloodline transformation upon training them to a sequential tier.

After frequent tragedies, Creators ceased such research!

The Barrier Dragon Crane belongs to beasts with abnormal bloodlines.

After observing the evolutionary path of the Barrier Phoenix, Fang Mu focused on the new skills it acquired upon ascending to the Platinum tier.

[Burning Feather Lock] is extensively described under the Eye of Omniscience as essentially a supporttype skill that removes negative statuses of allies.

Besides assisting allies, the sublimated feathers formed into feather locks can also control the unique traits of enemy targets.

This makes the enemy unit's exclusive traits lose their effectiveness!

Chapter 1329: Puppet Performance Theater! Fang Mu had seen skills that could seal the environmental elemental energy around and interfere with the energy circulation within a target. He had also seen skills that limited the effectiveness of a Beastmaster's Runes.

It was rare to come across abilities that could directly restrict an opponent's unique characteristics.

The Barrier Phoenix, with the skill [Burning Feather Lock], could assist its own side while choosing the most strategically valuable enemy Guardian Beast to restrict one of its exclusive characteristics.

It was very likely that because of the loss of this one exclusive characteristic, the strategic significance of the enemy's Guardian Beast would be greatly reduced.

The Barrier Phoenix, with its skill [Burning Feather Lock], could not only control one exclusive characteristic of an enemy Guardian Beast. If the Barrier Phoenix gave up the use of its own exclusive characteristic, it could restrict the same number of exclusive characteristics of the enemy Guardian Beast.

Before a Guardian Beast reached Legendary Quality, it only had three exclusive characteristics. Such a restriction was like an unexpected strike that directly crippled the enemy's Guardian Beast.

The three exclusive characteristics of the Barrier Phoenix were extremely effective and held significant strategic value.

It seemed that the Barrier Phoenix's sacrifice of its own exclusive characteristics to restrict those of the enemy's Guardian Beast was a poor deal, but it was not necessarily the case.

Firstly, the Barrier Phoenix could choose to restrict those Guardian Beasts with higher strategic value than its own, and secondly, the Barrier Phoenix's restriction was often part of a strategy to target and eliminate a specific enemy.

Once the targeted enemy unit restricted by the Barrier Phoenix was eliminated, the skill [Burning Feather Lock] would release its restriction on itself, allowing it to continue using its exclusive characteristics in combat.

Watching this, Fang Mu couldn't help but utter several sounds of admiration.

"Ah Tao, the new skill acquired by your Barrier Phoenix upon advancing to the Platinum Tier is enough to make you the core of the battlefield."

"Your Barrier Phoenix, especially in battles where the enemy Guardian Beasts are stronger than ours, will always have a higher strategic value than other Guardian Beasts!"

Fang Mu never gave empty praises without reason. He really believed in the strength of the Barrier Phoenix to speak so highly of it!

Fang Mu's Destiny Beast, Fool's Shadow, possessed the Innate Divine Skill [Eye of Omniscience]. Fang Mu's understanding of Guardian Beast information was even higher than that of Hu Tao, the Barrier Phoenix's Contractor herself.

Hu Tao was still somewhat confused and didn't understand the meaning behind Fang Mu's words.

Hu Tao was a talented young girl with excellent strategic vision, and Fang Mu had always been directing He Deen to explore Hu Tao's strategic potential.

As a Defensive Beastmaster, strategic insight was more important than pure combat skills.

Once Hu Tao understood the new skill acquired by the Barrier Phoenix, she instantly realized why Fang Mu would say such words.

Jiang Tuo, looking at the imposing Barrier Phoenix, stepped forward and said to Hu Tao.

"Sister Taozi, congratulations on your Guardian Beast's successful Bloodline Transformation and advancement in tier!"

For a Beastmaster, advancing in tiers might be easy, but a real Bloodline Transformation was an extremely difficult achievement.

He himself had contracted Four Ice Ghosts, which evolved along their inherent bloodlines without needing to consider Bloodline Transformation like ordinary Guardian Beasts!

Jiang Tuo's Ice Ghosts just required cultivating with excellent Supplies. With enough resources, raising them would be much easier than raising ordinary Guardian Beasts!

After cultivating the Barrier Phoenix, Fang Mu didn't waste time and immediately turned his attention to the Retrace Sparrow Demon.

As a Fairy Type Beast Control, the Retrace Sparrow Demon's intelligence was extremely high.

While Fang Mu was cultivating the Barrier Phoenix, the Retrace Sparrow Demon had already been eagerly waiting for Fang Mu's upcoming cultivation.

The Retrace Sparrow Demon, Hu Tao's Guardian Beast, had been cultivated by Fang Mu from the moment it gained Spiritual Intelligence and was exceptionally close to him.

Knowing that Fang Mu would be using resources to cultivate it, the Retrace Sparrow Demon affectionately pecked Fang Mu's cheek twice.

Seeing this, Hu Tao couldn't help but laugh.

"Ah Mu, this little guy is really close to you!"

"If others saw this, they'd definitely think that this Retrace Sparrow Demon is your Guardian Beast!"

Hu Tao was jesting, but she was very pleased to see her Guardian Beast so close to Fang Mu.

However, the Retrace Sparrow Demon, misinterpreting Hu Tao's words as jealousy, quickly flapped its wings and flew to Hu Tao's side, cuddling her neck and acting coquettishly.

It made both Fang Mu and Jiang Tuo somewhat want to contract a Fairy Type Beast Control for battle!

Jiang Tuo's Four Ice Ghosts and Fang Mu's contracted Sea Flame Twins were much larger than the Retrace Sparrow Demon and didn't suit such affectionate gestures as the Retrace Sparrow Demon did.

The Retrace Sparrow Demon was always absorbing various metals, accumulating Metal Attribute for itself.

Aside from absorbing various Metal Spiritual Materials, the Retrace Sparrow Demon also fed on various Spirit-type Spirit Materials.

It particularly liked the pollen produced by the Essence Wisteria Flower Pistil.

During a trade with the Green magician, one of the Eight Evil Seed, Fang Mu obtained a Fungi called Fairy Mushroom from the Green magician.

The spores produced by the Fairy Mushroom were extremely beneficial for Fairy Type Beasts, maximizing the potential for the advancement of their Beast Bloodline.

If the high-ranking members of Ancient Genesis hadn't all contracted contaminants and none had contracted a Fairy,

Fang Mu believed it would have been impossible for Ancient Genesis to trade such high-level Supplies with him.

The Fairy Mushroom could absolutely be considered a foundational supply in Fang Mu's possession.

Chapter 1330: Ever since Fang Mu obtained the Fairy Mushroom, he had been continuously cultivating it.

The growth of the Fairy Mushroom required the watering with a variety of toxins, which the rain brought down by the Sea Flame Twins contained.

With the watering from the Sea Flame Twins, the originally extremely difficult-to-cultivate Fairy Mushroom grew rapidly, sprouting layer upon layer of mycelium.

The cap of the Fairy Mushroom boasted dazzling colors.

It is said that the brighter the color of a mushroom, the more toxic it is, but though the Fairy Mushroom fed on various toxins, it did not contain any poison itself.

Fang Mu had previously tested this with the Flower Spirit of the Blood Exhausted Other Shore.

advancing to the Platinum Tier was nearly an impossible feat.

Being able to become a four-winged fairy upon stepping into the Sequence was already fortunate for

the Backtracking Sparrow Demon.

Many fairies contracted by powerful beings had reached Sequence Seven or even Sequence Six and

remained two-winged.

During the rank advancement of the Backtracking Sparrow Demon while consuming the Fairy

Mushroom, Fang Mu fed it some Blood Aged Wine.

The essential foundation certainly needed to be well established!

As the energy and spiritual fluctuations on the Backtracking Sparrow Demon increased, it clearly

succeeded in ascending its rank.


Fang Mu used the Eye of Omniscience to inspect the rank-advanced Backtracking Sparrow Demon.

[Reverse Retrospection]: Applies retrospection on enemies, whereby all buffs and healing states acquired by the enemy during the process of reverse retrospection will be transferred to our side after the retrogression.
Exclusive Traits:
[Instrumentalization]: Transforms itself into a special weapon for the Contractor to use.
[Backtracking Assassination]: Absorbs damage sustained by the retrospection target during the process, then delivers the damage as a mental shock to a designated target, colliding with the target's spiritual power.



it not only keeps the enemy's Mystic Beast in a dying state but also allows the massive amount of healing and support energy poured out by the opponent to be used by our own units.

Hu Tao, with her exceptional strategic insight, knew the effectiveness of this new skill acquired by the Backtracking Sparrow Demon the moment she learned about it.

Although this ability won't significantly improve her individual combat capability, it can produce miraculous effects in a team setting.

And with that, Hu Tao was completely satisfied!

This way, Hu Tao, when teaming up with Fang Mu and Jiang Tuo, wouldn't just be their adjunct and could fully demonstrate her value in battle!

Long before Fang Mu helped Hu Tao cultivate the Barrier Phoenix and Backtracking Sparrow Demon, he had already instructed Hu Tao to allow her Destiny Guardian Beast, the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi, to absorb Blood Aged Wine, to stimulate the metal energy accumulated in its body over time.

If the Barrier Phoenix, which consumes about fifteen clumps of Nazhen Firm Silver daily, is considered a small rice bucket, then the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi, which devours more than six types of Metal Spiritual Material every day, can definitely be called a big rice bucket!

The daily consumption of Metal Spiritual Materials by the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi costs at least fifty million Dragon Rising Coins.

Cyan Stone Business Association controlled over ten Subterranean Dimensional Rifts of Destruction Level and above, using Space Spiritual Material and special spatial formations to stabilize these rifts.

Cyan Stone Business Association has been continuously and steadily providing Fang Mu with various Metal Spiritual Materials.

If these materials were to be bought on the open market, Fang Mu would need to liquidate his resources first.

The purchase of such a large volume of Metal Spiritual Materials would inevitably draw the outside world's attention.

The cultivation scheme Fang Mu set for the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi was something even those Grandmaster Creators wouldn't dare to set lightly, as for them it is impossible to invest most of their resources in just one Guardian Beast.

Even if this Guardian Beast could bring huge returns, it's still not as cost-effective as distributing resources among multiple Guardian Beasts!

Hu Tao had always felt anxious about the cultivation path Fang Mu had laid out for the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi.

The resources consumed by the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi and the Barrier Phoenix every day were more than what Hu Tao's parents could earn in their entire lives.

If it weren't for Fang Mu's insistence, Hu Tao would have already proposed to halt this method of cultivation!

From the current situation, it can be said that none of the resources invested have been wasted.

The Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi had successfully upgraded to Legendary Quality, gaining a new exclusive trait, [Puppet Performance Theater].

[Puppet Performance Theater]: Unleashes the metal energy contained within itself, setting up a theater composed of metal energy within a certain range. Each target present in the theater will have an Inferior Puppet Body appear beside them, and these bodies will grow stronger with the amount of time spent in the theater.

The Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi's Skill [Performative Decapitation Dance] and Innate Divine Ability [Reversal Puppet Veil] both apply to these Inferior Puppet Bodies.

Inferior Puppet Bodies are a major tactic used by the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi, capable of employing its defensive type skills.

However, relying solely on the Innate Divine Ability [Reversal Puppet Veil] to cultivate Inferior Puppet Bodies would hardly keep up with the demand.

And the exclusive trait [Puppet Performance Theater] obtained by the Bird Armor Puppet Xi Xi upon its upgrade to Legendary Quality perfectly resolves the issue of an insufficient number of Inferior Puppet Bodies.

In the theater, these Inferior Puppet Bodies that accompany our own units are essentially defensive dummies with multiple effects.

Moreover, these defensive dummies can continually be strengthened in the field, and each strengthening will inevitably bring a significant increase in their Defense Capability.

If used against enemies, the Inferior Puppet Bodies could also serve as a control tactic to restrict the opponents.

Should the enemy not understand the attacking mechanism of Inferior Puppet Bodies and attempt to forcefully attack them to release the target inside, they might trigger the disassembly mechanism of the Inferior Puppet Body.

They are very likely to dismember the target trapped inside during the Inferior Puppet Body's disintegration process.
