[Beast Species]: ???

[Beast Level]: Silver Stage (1/10)

[Beast Element]: ???

[Beast Potential]: ???

[Beast Quality]: Legendary

Skill:

[Blood Vintage]: Places its own blood into the vessel of abundance. After fermentation within the vessel, the blood gains the power to guide the evolution of life. The degree of evolution depends on the amount of blood consumed.

[Blood Monarch Descendants]: Uses its own blood as a medium to condense a blood core. When this blood core is bestowed upon a being of the same bloodline, that being becomes a Blood Monarch Descendant.

Exclusive Traits:

[Ash-Dyed End]: When subjected to a life-threatening attack, a judgment is made. If the damage the attacker has suffered in their lifetime is greater than Fang Mu's, the judgment fails.

If the attacker has suffered less damage in their lifetime, the judgment succeeds, nullifying the attack and redirecting all damage Fang Mu has ever suffered to the attacker.

[Creation of Blood and Life]: Allows the contractor's blood to fuse with the essence blood of multiple lifeforms, acquiring traits from their bloodlines. Using Blood Vintage as the medium and life energy or other special energy as fuel, it can create a new organism. The creature's rank and quality can be improved using the energy-enriched blood as a resource. (Contracting requires only one-tenth of the usual spiritual power for a Guardian Beast.)

[Holy Land of the Self]: By dripping three drops of [Contract Blood] into Blood of Abundance, the energy from these drops forms a Holy Land Area. If Fang Mu's soul dissipates upon death, it will return to the Holy Land and be nurtured back to life using the energy within the land.

Innate Divine Skill:

[Contract Blood]: Injecting a significant amount of Blood Vintage and one's heartblood into Blood of Abundance. When the Blood Vintage and heartblood meet the criteria, a drop of Contract Blood is brewed. Contract Blood can replace spiritual power to establish contracts with lifeforms and cause them to ascend to higher realms.

Seeing the exclusive trait [Holy Land of the Self] gained from the legendary quality advancement of Blood of Abundance, Fang Mu found himself in a daze.

Fang Mu meticulously analyzed his own strengths, and determined that his greatest current weakness was the lack of life-saving mechanisms.

When real threats arose, aside from relying on his strength and the protection of others, Fang Mu could only depend on the judgment of [Ash-Dyed End] to survive.

One must understand that after [Ash-Dyed End] is triggered, it incurs a significant cooldown period.

During this cooldown, [Ash-Dyed End] would no longer be able to assist Fang Mu!

Skills:

[Snake Explosion]: Coils around the target and explosively channels all internal power, concentrating it to crush the target's body.

[Coagulating Venom]: Its venom induces blood coagulation in the target, rapidly spreading throughout the target's body via blood circulation. The venom also possesses the ability to restrain the energy within the target's body.

[Firm Earth Armor]: Harnesses energy from the earth to form a layer of spiked armor over its body during combat, enhancing physical strength.

Exclusive Traits:

[Sun and Moon Swallow]: In the absence of ambient energy, it can absorb celestial energies to sustain itself. When ambient energy is abundant, it can use celestial energies to accelerate digestion of accumulated energy.

Physical Traits:

[Absorb]: During battle, if injured, it can consume parts of its own body to heal wounds. During this process, its body generates a layer of high-temperature pressure with exceptional cutting power.

While Fang Mu was examining the Jia Ran Ancient Snake, the juvenile serpent had already coiled itself protectively around Fang Mu.

It then lowered its head, signaling Fang Mu to step onto the relatively smooth top of its head.

[Elemental Burst]: In combat scenarios, unleash bursts of the three inherent elemental energies based on the situation. Each elemental burst not only enhances oneself but also inflicts severe damage on enemies. Elemental bursts can interact and complement each other to amplify their effects.

[Cloud Ascending Dive]: Ascend to a high altitude, within the cloud layers, and lock onto a target to launch a rapid descent attack, delivering powerful piercing damage to the target.

Exclusive Trait:

[Crane Phoenix Cry]: Through its unique call, it can attract a large group of avian beasts to gather around. Birds with weaker bloodlines than itself will perceive it as their Dominator. (Excessive slaughter of avian creatures will temporarily influence other birds' perception of it.)

Physical Property:

[Reverse Feather Stimulation]: Reverse all its feathers to generate immense propulsion, greatly enhancing its mobility. During the reverse feather stage, it consumes an enormous amount of energy while simultaneously healing its injuries continuously.

Under Fang Mu's investigation, it became apparent that extensive use of Covenant Blood Essence, along with ample Pure Spiritual Qi and Element Potions on the Two-headed Crane Phoenix, had caused its bloodline to leap forward, evolving it into a Three-Headed Crane Phoenix!

With three elemental attributes and an additional head, the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix's offensive capabilities had become unprecedented.

It could be said that the potential of the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix far exceeded that of the Two-headed Crane Phoenix!

For instance, a Metal Elemental Burst delivers piercing damage while significantly enhancing its defensive capabilities.

Fire Elemental Burst inflicts a burning effect on the target and puts the Phoenix into a berserk state, augmenting its physical power.

The Wind Elemental Burst restricts the opponent's movements while placing the Phoenix in an agile state, improving its speed and attack frequency.

Gold Element and Fire Wind are two types of elements that rarely interact, but the synergy between Fire Wind dual attributes can greatly enhance the burning effect on the target.

The Bronze Grade Skill and Silver Grade Skill of the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix are comprehensive abilities that utilize three types of Elemental Energy.

The Gold Grade Skill [Cloud Ascending Dive] represents the strongest application of its physical power.

This greatly raises the power ceiling of the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix.

it becomes highly susceptible to injury during the assault.

Moreover, performing [Cloud Ascending Dive] exhausts a significant amount of its internal energy!

The Three-Headed Crane Phoenix having such a cross-level attack ability brings great delight to Fang Mu.

These birds attracted by the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix will regard the Two-Headed Crane Phoenix as their Dominator, granting the Crane Phoenix some degree of influence over their actions.

These birds and beasts under the management of the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix serve as the best source of food.

Though active attacks by the Three-Headed Crane Phoenix on these creatures it has summoned would alter their perception of it,

thus limiting the effect of the exclusive attribute [Crane Phoenix Song].
