There is no need for substantial one-time investment.

If one has the business acumen and chooses supplies that can make money in resale, even if their capital is not ample, a cash flow break is generally unlikely to occur.

But the Contemplation Hall is a different beast.

To establish a Contemplation Hall, it requires the capital to be invested all at once, purchasing large quantities of copper-stage and silver-stage Guardian Beasts of various series.

Then you must select Beast Masters with sufficient talent and sign contracts with them.

Let these Beast Masters enter a pact with specific Guardian Beasts.

And help these Beast Masters nurture their pact Guardian Beasts in the future.

As long as the Contemplation Hall pays their salaries monthly, these Beast Masters must continue working for the Contemplation Hall throughout their careers.

If there is a compelling reason to leave, they need to compensate the Contemplation Hall two to three times its investment, according to the contract.

The operation mode of the Contemplation Hall is to have a number of same-attribute Guardian Beasts together, simulating the magnificent natural environment through continuous release of skills.

Therefore, to simulate one kind of natural scene, it requires dozens or even hundreds of same-kind same-attribute Guardian Beasts to cooperate.

There are many types of natural scene for different attributes.

For example, the fire attribute can simulate volcanic eruptions and flowing lava.

Water attribute can simulate tsunamis, waterfalls, floods, and even the water pressure in the deep sea.

The simulation of the same attribute but different types of scenes can be split into dozens if detailed.

It's very likely that even for the same waterfall, different types of Water system beasts would produce different effects when simulating it.

This means that to establish a small-scale Contemplation Hall, at least three thousand or so Beast Masters need to be employed.

Bearing the responsibility of nurturing at least nine thousand Guardian Beasts.

This is why the saying that a small-scale Contemplation Hall needs a

30-billion-Dragon Rising Coin investment is a very conservative estimate!

Of course, some forces determined to open Contemplation Halls stubbornly choose to save costs by directly purchasing tamed wild Guardian Beasts.

Among various Beast Master professions, there is a type that enters a pact with Spirit Series or Soul Series Guardian Beasts and often takes on the role of a Beast Tamer.

Their main responsibility is to tame high-rank Guardian Beasts captured out in the wild.

Beast Tamers guide high-rank Guardian Beasts principally through psychic control and mental suggestion.

This taming method is usually quite reliable, but accidents always happen.

Once a tamed wild Guardian Beast gets startled or stimulated, its violent tendencies could possibly be aroused.

Those Contemplation Halls set up with tamed high-rank wild Guardian Beasts often run into accidents.

This has put many customers who came to the Contemplation Halls to comprehend mysterious patterns in danger.

As early as eight years ago, the Dragon Rising Federation clearly enacted laws forbidding Contemplation Halls that used tamed wild Guardian Beasts from operating.

A large number of Contemplation Halls were forced to stop business for rectification, which in turn elevated the price to open a Contemplation Hall!

Fang Yuan and Fang Qin seriously looked towards Fang Mu, and found that Fang Mu was utterly serious and had no intention of joking at all.
