[Barking Beast]: A roar that can intimidate all nearby targets. If the target manifests any fear, that feeling would be amplified, lowering their fighting will.

[Dog Condensation]: The act of fixing a gaze on a target, locking onto their position. Each stare from an eye inflicts a curse on the target, throwing them into a state of chaos.

[Inferno]: Every time damage is sustained, the heat of the Hellhound's dark flame increases from its original foundation. When the dark flame reaches a certain degree, a Dark Puppet is generated, possessing the ability to take a lethal blow.

[Dark Cavalry]: A combination of soul power and dark power creates a Dark Soldier on the back, which can deal double damage in battle but at the cost of consuming triple the energy.

Exclusive Traits:

[Hell Synergy]: Every Hellhound that has a bloodline connection with the subject can enhance each other's power and evolution speed with mental bonding.

[Rapid Regeneration]: As long as the body has enough dark energy and life energy, it can quickly repair any damage.

Evolutionary Path:

: Hellfire Cerberus, : Hell Bone Dog, : Evil Hellhound Successor.

The more Fang Mu looked into the three Hellfire Cerberus creatures contracted by Yin Nanzhen, the more satisfied he became.

The Bronze Grade Skill, the [Dark Bite], is a long-range offensive attack, allowing the Hellfire Cerberus to launch a violent attack on the target from afar.

The stacked bleeding effect during the bite process gives the Hellfire Cerberus a great advantage in battles against creatures of similar strength.

The Silver Grade Skill [Barking Beast] doesn't have much effect against enemies of equal power, but it's extremely useful against weaker opponents.

This skill is particularly popular when exploring and clearing Dimensional Rifts in the wild.

The Gold Grade Skill [Dog Condensation] is a typical Dark Curse capability.

Targets struck by this confusion will indiscriminately launch attacks, making it a powerful offensive move.

Conventional means can't remove a dark curse; only curse removal skills or unique traits can do the job.

Skills like [Dark Bite], [Barking Beast], and [Dog Condensation] are all emitted from the heads of Hellfire Cerberus.

Once all three heads of the Hellfire Cerberus grow out, the lethality and combat power of [Dark Bite], [Barking Beast], and [Dog Condensation] will greatly increase.

Especially [Dog Condensation].

A single Hellfire Cerberus has six eyes, meaning they can stack up to six curses at once.

With six layers of curses, a weak-willed Guardian Beast would have difficulty being controlled by the Beast Master.

As it happens, all three of Yin Nanzhen's Hellfire Cerberus have this [Dog Condensation] skill.

An 18-layer curse applied to a single target would reduce even a powerful Guardian Beast to a state of indiscriminate attacking.

The synergy of three similar beasts is a highly advanced form of combat.

It translates directly into a threefold effect.

Unlike some Guardian Beast synergies, where the total damage only increases by 20%-30%.

The Platinum Grade Skill [Inferno], is awkward for Hellfire Cerberus.

Given Yin Nanzhen's nurture style, the Hellfire Cerberus hardly has the opportunity to condense a Dark Puppet.

To condense a Dark Puppet from the heat generated by being attacked is challenging when the flame intensity is already low.

Unless several healing beast tamers assist, it would be beaten to death several times over before achieving this!

But once it absorbs the Dark Element Potion with a purity of 90%, and takes a high-purity Dark Element Potion daily, the heat of Hellfire Cerberus's dark flame can quickly level up.

The Dark Puppet's ability to bear damage on behalf of the Hellfire Cerberus is equivalent to giving Hellfire Cerberus an extra life.

The Diamond Level Skill [Dark Cavalry] allows the Hellfire Cerberus to condense a Dark Soldier from its back through soul power and dark energy.

This reminds Fang Mu subconsciously of the knight class.

For instance, Fang Qin and others could apply for dragon knight certification after squadron level.

However, where knights are usually Beast Masters riding their beasts, the Hellfire Cerberus rides on itself.

Although the attack from the Dark Soldier on its back consumes triple the energy, it deals double the damage, making it a profitable trade!

The exclusive trait [Rapid Regeneration] can be paired with the skill [Inferno].

This ensures that the Hellfire Cerberus isn't incapacitated by enemy attacks in battle, preventing them from losing their ability to move and attack.

The other two Hellfire Cerberus's exclusive traits either enhance attack or strengthen control effects in combat.

Even if some of the exclusive traits aren't considered excellent, none of them are a drawback either.

Fang Mu suddenly felt that having Yin Nanzhen as a driver was somewhat misusing talents.

As for the evolution direction, Fang Mu had long decided to make the Hellfire Cerberus walk the path of multiple heads.

The Hell Bone Dog, for example, specializes in the temperature of the Hellfire, vaporizing its flesh leaving only bones remaining, turning it into a half-undead.

If considered solely from a battle perspective, the Hell Bone Dog is stronger than the Hellfire Cerberus, which can fight two opponents at once.

But once transformed into a half-undead, the aura of the deceased on it may affect Yin Nanzhen.

In the future, Fang Mu needs to provide Yin Nanzhen with Light Element Elixirs and bear the cost of cultivating the three Guardian Beasts under his contract.
