She had been serving as Fang Mu's guard for a long time, but She Wan always felt like she was in a state of unemployment.

She was far less helpful than Lu Xiaoyin, who was able to contribute regularly.

That's why She Wan cherishes every opportunity to demonstrate her usefulness.

"My lord, let me tell you about the forging process of ghost devices and their difference from spiritual instruments."
"The spiritual instruments are forged of various spiritual materials and beast souls."
"Spiritual instruments, from the bronze to diamond level, are like handy tools; they can be manipulated freely with spiritual power and there is not much to explain."
"Sequential spiritual instruments can be inherited only within direct descendent of a bloodline because they are bound by a marrow pact."
"The protective behavior of the sequential spiritual instrument is the autonomy of the beast spirit within, which has enough spiritual intelligence to maintain its autonomy."
"Ghost devices are forged from the corpses of ghost system beasts and the soul power of the beast master."
"Upon contracting with a ghost system beast, the beast master's soul will no longer be afraid of ghost flames."
"By manipulating the ghost device with their soul, the beast master can achieve perfect compatibility."
"This kind of compatibility cannot be offered by sequential spiritual instrument."
"All newly forged ghost devices are of the bronze spiritual instrument level, and they need to be continuously fortified with resources."
"The usage of a ghost device does not bear the restrictions spiritual instruments do."
"If a one-point star beast master somehow acquires a ghost device and elevates it to the sequential level,"

"then this one-point star beast master can immediately use the sequential level ghost device against enemies." "Sequential spiritual instruments come in various forms, whereas all ghost devices are weapons." "They need to be manipulated through the beast master's physical constitution." "Thus, before reaching the five-point star level, where there's a qualitative improvement in physical strength, using a ghost device against enemies can potentially expose the user to targeting." She Wan's explanation made the concept of ghost devices crystal clear for Fang Mu. Indeed, for the ordinary one to four-point star beast masters, their physical abilities are relatively weak, so going front line to fight with weapons, the enemy's beast could pull them in for targeted attacks. But once a beast master achieves five-point star or six-polar star level, there is a significant enhancement to their physical abilities. Wielding a ghost device in battle can not only ensure safety but can also deliver a heavy blow to the enemy at the crucial moment. Due to the Royal beast blood abundance in Fang Mu's Destiny Guardian Beast, he has amazing strength. In the speed test, Fang Mu realized that as long as he was in the blood red fog, his speed was not any less impressive than his strength. With a ghost device in his possession and continuously nurturing it with resources,

Fang Mu could essentially become a humanoid beast master in battles.

Compared to She Wan's Heart-Seizing Charm Claw, a purely offensive ghost device, Fang Mu would prefer a ghost device that prioritizes defense over offense.

All of Fang Mu's guardian beasts were cultivated with the best resources. Against enemies, the best tactic for Fang Mu was to hunker down and make the most of his beasts' capabilities.

Fang Mu remembered that Shui Miao of Starwheel was a Forging Spirit Grandmaster, so he could customize his ghost device.

Sequential spiritual instruments have no effect if not used after being bound by contract.

As long as one has enough resources, it wouldn't be a problem to bind 10 or even 20 sequential spiritual instruments at one time.

However, once a ghost device is bound, it cannot be replaced, so the selection of a ghost device should be as cautious as the selection of a ghost system beast.

Ghost devices have to be forged from the corpses of ghost system beasts. The more intact the ghost system beast corpse, the better the effect of the ghost device creation.

Fang Mu was aware of the Tomb Hunting Corpses' appearance and attacking style as an undead beast.



It can fully take on the job of a frontline tank.

The Giant Brutal Butcher has many evolution paths, unlike the Elemental Beasts that determine the path of evolution in the beginning.

The Giant Brutal Butcher is not an undead Guardian Beast that is easy to evolve.

You can wait until the Giant Brutal Butcher has been promoted to the Gold Stage and obtained its exclusive attribute before selecting the best evolution route based on this exclusive attribute.

Not only was Fang Mu very interested in the Giant Brutal Butcher, but Yan Yubanruo also chose the Giant Brutal Butcher after seeing it.

He reserved a White Paper Man with the Skill [Golem Paper Control] for the Giant Brutal Butcher.

Just when Fang Mu was about to secure the Giant Brutal Butcher before anyone else could snatch it away, the man who brought him into the tent had already brought out three Tomb Hunting Corpses.

Chapter 306 - Epoch Relic!_1

Three iron cages, each two meters in length, width, and height, appeared in front of Fang Mu.

What kind of amazing exclusive trait is Bones of the Same Cold!
The Undead Species Beasts are not well-liked by Beast Masters, apart from the daily need to consume Life Elixirs to remove the Dead Qi erosion on themselves.
Another important reason is that compared to other Beast Elements, the Undead Species Beasts don't have any advantage over their peers apart from being hard to kill.
Unlike the traditional Dark-element Beast, which has a strong advantage against the Elemental Beasts.
