The Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother, invoking her Exclusive Trait "Cruel Maternity," urgently needed nutrients.
The body of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon was the best source of nutrients for the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother!
The expectant mother, the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother, leaped, clinging onto the hind leg of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon.
She began chewing at the spot that had just been torn apart by the Swift Rend Claw.
Mass amounts of flesh was swallowed by the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother, and due to the effects of the skills "Cruel Maternity" and "Flesh Newborn," one after another, Grave Sacrifice Children were being born by the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.
This spectacle caused the atmosphere in Cai Boshen's livestream to reach a new climax.
"Aspect of Rain": Holy shit, this is terrifying! What the hell is this? This Corpse Hunter in a wedding dress can actually give birth during battle! I'm definitely going to have nightmares tonight!
Despite his complaints, the more the Aspect of Rain watched, the more thrilling it became.

Seeing a Beast Master who had contracted an Undead Species Guardian Beast fight like this was not something you saw every day.
"Nothing at AII": Can anyone tell me what rank these born Corpse Hunters are? The hind leg of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon is almost eaten up. Why can't it struggle free from the control of the Giant Brutal Butcher? Isn't the Giant Brutal Butcher supposed to be just a Silver Stage Guardian Beast? But the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon is Platinum Stage!
"Nothing at AII" expressed the sentiments of many spectators, but no one could give a clear answer.
The spectators were planning to pay attention to the Skin Peeling House after the event, as Yan Luo would definitely be a topic of discussion there.
Many spectators thought that there were more mysteries surrounding Yan Luo compared to Jianmu.
Fear was spreading in Cai Boshen's livestream, and many timid spectators had already left.
They planned to watch the recorded fight later with a friend, as watching it alone was too horrifying!
This spectacle also gave Cai Boshen a chilling feeling.

Cai Boshen had never been fond of watching horror movies since he was young, he was extremely afraid of eerie and creepy scenes.
The sight of the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother voraciously devouring the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon while giving birth, genuinely terrified Cai Boshen.
As a Platinum Stage Legendary Quality Guardian Beast, the flesh and blood of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon, after being contaminated by dead qi, was an excellent source of energy for the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.
At the instance when the seventh Grave Sacrifice Child was born, one of them evolved into the Grave Sacrifice Nanny.
After being born, the Grave Sacrifice Nanny grabbed a Grave Sacrifice Child and crushed it, absorbing it into its body as its first sacrifice.
However, this sort of sacrifice was just beginning.
The Grave Sacrifice Nanny continued to sacrifice Grave Sacrifice Children endlessly, only stopping after sacrificing four, hence completing the utilization of its Exclusive Trait "Brutal Paternity."
With the continuous sacrifices, the Grave Sacrifice Child's Exclusive Trait "Twisted Filial Piety" accumulated grudges up to ten layers.

Each time it was killed, it gained one layer of grudge, and each time it was sacrificed, it piled up three layers of grudge, making sacrifice the best way to stack grudges.
The Grave Sacrifice Children could then use their Exclusive Trait "Twisted Filial Piety" to sacrifice to the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother and the Grave Sacrifice Nanny at any time.
However, Fang Mu didn't allow the Grave Sacrifice Children to do so at the moment.
"Twisted Filial Piety" would induce the Grave Sacrifice Children to mutate and become new undead.
Under such circumstances, the more Grave Sacrifice Children there were, the better!
If the previous sight of the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother devouring the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon was already bone-chilling, then the use of the Grave Sacrifice Nanny's Exclusive Trait "Brutal Paternity," was downright horrifying, savage and ghastly.
These three Corpse Hunters seemed like a family of three, but the relationship between them was too terrifying and eerie!
At this time, although the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon was being controlled by the Hook Heart Grub Infant and being devoured by the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother, and its actions were also being restricted by the Giant Brutal Butcher.

However, the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon was still resisting vigorously.
Whilst the Hook Heart Grub Infant and Giant Brutal Butcher were restricting the dragon, the dragon was also restricting the Pair.
If either party were to falter, the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon could potentially break free.
Thankfully, the Grave Sacrifice Children were able to boost the Giant Brutal Butcher and the Hook Heart Grub Infant constantly using their Exclusive Trait "Corpse Spirit Fire Seed."
Otherwise, the Giant Brutal Butcher, who had been using his Exclusive Trait [Life Sacrifice Restraint] continuously, would probably have collapsed now!
The following battle was between the Ritual Cemetery Three Treasures and the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus.
Before the Ritual Cemetery Three Treasures showed clear signs of defeat, Fang Mu wouldn't summon new Undead Species Guardian Beasts.
Fang Mu's real ace cards were the Dead Territory Zombie, evolved from the Rotting Nightmare Stiffness, and the Stealthy Hidden One.

He hadn't used these two Undead Species Guardian Beasts yet.
Because Fang Mu wanted to explore the limits of the Ritual Cemetery Three Treasures through this battle.
Moreover, he wanted to estimate just how strong the enemy he could defeat using Yan Luo's identity based on this.
Fang Mu didn't know much about Cai Boshen, as in the last battle he had instantly killed him.
However, that didn't prevent Fang Mu from acknowledging Cai Boshen's strength.
Cai Boshen's two Sub-Dragons were both eligible to evolve into Master Dragons, with the combination of wind and earth attributes for defense, control, and offense.
It was clear that Cai Boshen had put a lot of thought into the selection of his Guardian Beasts.
Though Cai Boshen wasn't considered Fang Mu's opponent, there's no denying that Cai Boshen was an excellent touchstone.  Chapter 792 The Unveiled Third One! _2
Right now, Fang Mu wanted to use Cai Boshen as a touchstone to test his own strength.

If he could defeat Cai Boshen, Fang Mu's identity as Yan Luo would have the qualifications to enter the Golden Rank, and even charge into the higher ranks!
Cai Boshen's Battle Network profile showed that he was a certified main team member of the club.
Cai Boshen was pretty unfortunate to have been matched up with him twice in a row!
Fang Mu had been using the power of the Ritual Cemetery Three Treasures.
After a brief bout of negative emotions, Cai Boshen forcibly subdued the fear in his heart.
He commanded the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus to launch a combination of [Wind Slash], [Wind Roar Stab], and [Tornado Positioning] towards the noticeably enhanced Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.
[Tornado Positioning] controlled and pulled, [Wind Slash] attacked openly, and [Wind Roar Stab] ambushed secretly.
This set of skills always made Cai Boshen invincible.
Last time he used this three-hit combo, the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus didn't use its exclusive skill [Wind Gather].

But in the face of the current unfavorable situation, Cai Boshen had ordered the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus to use [Wind Gather].
Massive amounts of wind elemental energy converged towards the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus, turning into its stored energy.
Right now, the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus was like a magic machine gun.
But this time, the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus didn't manage to rip apart the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother as it wanted.
Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother's exclusive skill [Brutal Paternity] could increase its defense capability by sacrificing Ritual Cemetery Children.
The four Ritual Cemetery Children were sacrificed and merged into the body of the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.
Under the control of [Tornado Positioning], both [Wind Slash] and [Wind Roar Stab] struck the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.
[Wind Slash] scored a cut on the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother's body, and [Wind Roar Stab] plunged into its body, but it wasn't enough to penetrate completely.

The Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother launched the skill [Spine Lock], shooting its spinal cord like a whip at the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus after pulling it out of its body.
If it were a regular Silver Stage Guardian Beast attack, Cai Boshen would not have ordered the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus to dodged.
But Yan Luo's Silver Stage Guardian Beasts were too extraordinary.
The Corpse Hunter had clearly been killed by the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus, but when it was reborn by the Mother Corpse Hunter and sacrificed the other Corpse Hunter units, its strength clearly increased compared to before.
Otherwise, it wouldn't have been able to withstand the offensive launched by the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus after using [Wind Gather].
Cai Boshen commanded the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus to use the exclusive skill [Hardened Scales] to reinforce the hardness of its scales.
When it takes close-range physical damage, it can rebound the damage by vibrating its scales.
This was an exclusive skill that Cai Boshen had always taken pride in, it was a divine skill against other melee Guardian Beasts.

With this exclusive skill, the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus had won significant battles for Cai Boshen.
Cai Boshen didn't know that Fang Mu had already seen through the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus's abilities.
Fang Mu had let the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother pounce at the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus in order for it to launch four attacks boosted by the Ritual Cemetery Children.
Put simply, the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother was there to die.
Fang Mu needed to use the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother to probe just how strong the defensive strength of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus was.
If the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus' defense was too extraordinary, to the point that even the amplified Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother couldn't break it.
Then Fang Mu would have to send out the Stealthy Hidden One.
If Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother could break the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus's defense, Fang Mu would let the Ritual Cemetery Children use their exclusive skill [Twisted Filial piety], refining away the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother and the Grave Sacrifice Mother.

And collectively enhancing the copied Ritual Cemetery Children units.
These collectively altered Ritual Cemetery Children would then launch an attack on the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus.
[Spine Lock] caught the left wing of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus.
The Mist Wind Arthurdactylus flapped its wings forcefully, launching a [Wind Slash] at Spine Lock at the same time.
The Spine Lock was immediately shattered.
But Spine Lock wasn't a one-time control effect. After the Spine Lock was broken, the Dead Qi within it would form new chains to bind the target again.
Taking advantage of the second bind, the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother landed on the wing of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus.
In that instant, it launched two [Swift Rend Claw] strikes.
For every Ritual Cemetery Child sacrificed, it could only enhance one attack of the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.

On the Dragon's wings of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus, there was only a layer of bone membrane without any scales.
This bone membrane was directly torn open in two large gashes by the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother.

Then, they left the last enhanced opportunity for attack to its unique feature, [Sacrifice Armoured Gesture].
However, this time the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother did not use [Sacrifice Armoured Gesture] to resist the attack, but instead sacrificed itself to self-detonate through the effect of [Sacrifice Armoured Gesture].

A violent explosion sounded on the wing of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus, which had only taken one hit.
Not only was the bone membrane blown open into a large hole, but the rigid bone supporting the membrane was also broken off.
Once the rigid bone was blown off, this pterodactyl lost the ability to glide across the sky.
The attack by the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother on the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus was interpreted by many in the live stream room as Fang Mu Yama showing off after gaining the advantage.
Guiding his own Guardian Beast to its death.
However, the four attacks by the Grave Sacrifice Pregnant Mother took place in a flash, directly undermining the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus' air superiority perfectly.
The Undead Species of Guardian Beasts under Fang Mu Yama obviously did not have the ability to fly.
The Mist Wind Arthurdactylus, which could fly in the air and attack the ground, could cause a great deal of trouble to these Guardian Beasts of Fang Mu Yama.

It was clear that Cai Boshen understood this.
In the previous battles, Cai Boshen frequently took advantage of the aerial superiority of Mist Wind Arthurdactylus to attack the enemy.
This time, Cai Boshen did not do so. Firstly, because he underestimated Fang Mu Yama's strength at the beginning.
Secondly, he was dazed by Fang Mu Yama's sharp and clear combat style.
Fang Mu Yama first controlled the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus, then broke Mist Wind Arthurdactylus' air superiority.
This clear combat goal suggests that Fang Mu Yama has most likely undergone targeted training.
If Fang Mu knew what others were thinking, he would surely scratch his head awkwardly.
Truth be told, Fang Mu does not have much combat experience.
Fang Mu's current combat experience only came from a few battles on the Battle Network under his two identities.

Everyone has a time when they're young. Fang Mu, in his previous life, had a phase where he was particularly fond of a strategic game.
His high school grades were even affected due to his obsession with this game.
Later, in order to be admitted to his desired college, Fang Mu forcibly quit playing the game.
However, the years of playing strategic games allowed Fang Mu to accumulate many theoretical combat skills.
Nowadays, Fang Mu applied those theoretical skills in actual combat, which made his combat style seem very seasoned.
Cai Boshen never thought that Fang Mu Yama's Guardian Beast would be so weird.
At the cost of sacrificing itself and self-detonating, it broke the wing bone of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus.
Now, the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus could only play its position on the ground against Fang Mu's Undead Species Guardian Beasts.

While Cai Boshen was somewhat resentful in his heart, he wasn't too panicked.
Thanks to the exclusive feature [Hardened Scales], the close combat Ability of the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus was not much weaker than that of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon.
It's just a pity that he now cannot control the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon.
Otherwise, under the application of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon's exclusive features [Tyrant Fury] and [Absorb Earth], the use of the skill [Ground Shaking Wave] could instantly kill all of Fang Mu's Undead Species Guardian Beasts.
This battle has indeed taught Cai Boshen a lesson regardless of the type of enemy, it is important to take the upper hand from the beginning.
Cai Boshen was left with a lump in his throat that he could neither swallow nor spit out.
Cai Boshen could foresee what situation he would face on the Battle Network if after losing to Jianmu, he lost to Fang Mu Yama again.
Upon thinking of this, Cai Boshen decided to take a gamble, and simply revealed his third Guardian Beast, which he had never shown before.

It was precisely with this Guardian Beast that Cai Boshen was able to complete the advancement of the Broken Rock Tyrant Dragon and the Mist Wind Arthurdactylus.

Initially, Cai Boshen had a tough time signing a contract with this Guardian Beast.
These hardships still cause a shudder within Cai Boshen's spirit whenever he recalls them.
Cai Boshen closed his eyes, his originally black pupils turning silver-green under his eyelids.
With a sudden flicker, Cai Boshen opened his eyes looking at Fang Mu.
The Spirit Mayfly, a unique kind of Guardian Beast, can parasitize within the spiritual power of the contractor.
It enhances the contractor's spiritual power.
During battles, if the Spirit Mayfly is summoned, it can bind the target's spiritual power.
Forcing the Beast Master to momentarily lose control over their Guardian Beast.

This unique Guardian Beast, Spirit Mayfly, is proudly advertised as a family inherited Guardian Beast by the Cyan Stone Business Association.
But in fact, the Spirit Mayfly was discovered on an ancient battlefield by the Cyan Stone Business Association, and only six of them were found.
Cai Boshen is the most outstanding direct descendant of the younger generation in the Cyan Stone Business Association, with his father being the patriarch of the family.
So, he was able to sign a contract with a Spirit Mayfly as soon as he became a Beast Master.
The Cyan Stone Business Association also has several other excellent direct descendants.
However, because Cai Boshen contracted the Spirit Mayfly, none of the direct descendants from the Cyan Stone Business Association can rival Cai Boshen in terms of status.
Cai Boshen has hardly ever summoned the Spirit Mayfly in public.
Cai Boshen decided to do so now because he wanted to use this opportunity to keep his dream of becoming a star alive.
Otherwise, if he were to lose to Yan Luo, a One-point Stars Beast Master again, he would certainly lose face to continue live broadcasting on the Battle Network.

Let alone live broadcasting on the Battle Network, he might even lose face to continue being the main team member in the Soul Rain Club.
Cai Boshen certainly does not want to be greeted by a chorus of boos as soon as he enters the competition field in the future.
His Spirit Mayfly is also at the Platinum level.
Although its quality does not measure up to Legendary Quality and is only of Epic Quality.
Still, controlling Yan Luo's spiritual power must be a piece of cake!
After all, no matter how much spiritual power a One-point Stars Beast Master has, how much more can it be?
But very soon, Cai Boshen realized he was wrong.
The Spirit Mayfly flew out of Cai Boshen's pupils and went straight into Yan Luo's spiritual power.

Cai Boshen initially thought that the Spirit Mayfly should be able to lock Yan Luo's spiritual power quite easily.
However, through his senses, Cai Boshen perceived that the Spirit Mayfly was situated in a shadowy space.
A hidden shadow fiercely rushed towards the Spirit Mayfly.
Then the Spirit Mayfly was enclosed by a transparent bubble, and Cai Boshen lost control over it.
As if his contract with the Spirit Mayfly never existed.
But the Spirit Mayfly wasn't dead because Cai Boshen's spiritual power wasn't wounded.
But because Cai Boshen lost connection with the Spirit Mayfly, his spiritual power started to weaken.

Skills:
[Mental Reserve]: It increases its own spiritual power as its rank continues to increase, keeping its spiritual power at a full state.
[Spiritual Nourishment]: It nourishes its own spiritual power, enhancing the rate of increase mental power, and has a faint promoting effect on the spiritual power combined with the external and itself.
[Spirit Chain]: It enters the target's spirit, locking the enemy's spiritual power with its own.
[Mental Exile]: When the spiritual power captured by the Spirit Mayfly is weaker than it, it can sacrifice a portion of its own spirit power and exile the target's mental power out of the target's body.
Exclusive Traits:
[Mayfly Leaping]: When targeting a group of spiritual power, it could directly enter into the target's spiritual power for instantaneous inter-spirit transmission.

[Accelerated Recovery]: When spiritual power is consumed, the more it is consumed, the faster the spiritual power will recover, until the spiritual power is full.
Evolutionary Path:
①: Spirit Mayfly·Storage, ②: Spirit Mayfly·Sword, ③: Spirit Mayfly·Explosion.
When Fang Mu matched up against Cai Boshen under the guise of Jianmu, he was curious about how this Biprong Star Tamer could have contracted a Platinum-level Guardian Beast.
And Cai Boshen contracted two of them at once.
This is much more demanding on the spiritual power than contracting a single Platinum-level Guardian Beast!
After the duel, Fang Mu specifically asked She Wan whether she knew about the Cyan Stone Business Association situation.

As a noble lady from the Lu Dushe clan, She Wan had a certain understanding of the major forces within the Dragon Rising Federation.
When Fang Mu mentioned the Cyan Stone Business Association, She Wan subconsciously thought that he was probably enquiring about their unique Guardian Beasts passed down through the generations.

She Wan did indeed study the Cyan Stone Business Association's unique Guardian Beasts and knew some insider information.
However, as the inheritors, the Cyan Stone Business Association never showcased them to outsiders.
She Wan's knowledge was quite superficial.
When She Wan mentioned these Guardian Beasts, Fang Mu became very interested in the Guardian Beasts inherited by the Cyan Stone Business Association.
If it weren't for Fang Mu's urgency to travel to the Panfeng Federation, he would have liked to trade with the Cyan Stone Business Association.
He wondered if the Cyan Stone Business Association would part with one of these unique Guardian Beasts.
Fang Mu felt it was absolutely necessary for himself to contract a beast that could allow his other Guardian Beasts to ascend in rank.
In that way, his combat abilities could make a qualitative leap.

What Fang Mu possessed most were resources of a Grandmaster Creator.
For other forces, resources of a Grandmaster Creator were extremely valuable.
In these circumstances, Fang Mu believed he could intrigue the Cyan Stone Business Association.
Hearing from others is fundamentally different from seeing for yourself.
When She Wan previously brought up Spirit Mayfly, Fang Mu was just interested in it.
Now, however, Fang Mu considered Spirit Mayfly as a must-have.
The usefulness of Spirit Mayfly was not just to allow one's Guardian Beasts to advance to another level.
The reason why Spirit Mayfly could allow a contracted Guardian Beast to ascend in rank was due to its copper-grade skill [Pure Reserve].
In addition to enabling Guardian Beasts to advance in rank, Spirit Mayfly could also, with its silver-grade skill [Spiritual Nourishment], promote the increase of the contractor's spiritual power.

In Fang Mu's eyes, this ability is no less valuable than the ability of Spirit Mayfly to allow Guardian Beasts to ascend in rank.
After all, increasing the spiritual power of a Beast Master is fundamental in commanding Guardian Beasts.
The golden-grade skills [Spirit Chain] and [Mental Exile] both have the ability to limit the enemy's spiritual power.
Both skills could be perfectly combined with each other.
Once the target's spiritual power is exiled from their body, the target would become a living corpse, losing the connection with their Guardian Beasts.
Without the control of a Beast Master, Guardian Beasts would fall into a temporarily confused state.
The strength they could display would drastically reduce compared to their original foundations.
The exclusive characteristic [Bug Hop] of Spirit Mayfly made it difficult for other targets to defend or evade when the Spirit Mayfly attacked their spiritual power.

When Fang Mu exited the Battle Network, the barrage in Cai Boshen's live broadcast room was even more intense than during the fight.
[Xuxiao Ren]: Cai Boshen, I advise you to quit the internet! Don't show your face again! Claiming to be the ceiling of a Biprong Star Tamer, then losing to two One-point Star Beast Masters in a row, I would be too ashamed to continue live streaming if I were you!
[Hope it's Better Than Yesterday]: I think there's no need to criticize Cai. His strength is self-evident; it's just that Yan Luo's strength is too strong! Anyone who encounters Yan Luo is likely to end up in the same situation.
[The Pigeon Doesn't Pigeon]: Indeed, Yan Luo is very strong and seems to have a lot of combat experience! But I didn't really understand how Cai Boshen lost.
Apart from a small portion of audience criticizing Cai Boshen, most viewers shifted their attention to Yan Luo.
It was clear that Yan Luo was a rising star.

Upon hearing Pang Hu's words, Ji Wanliu remained calm and prepared to listen to the opinions of others.
A white-haired old man with a beard that had grown down to his chest chuckled and said.
"It's rare for Pang Hu to advocate taking on tasks like he is now. It's indeed easier if the Beastmaster Alliance handles this."
"If those forces still do not let their members duel on the Battle Network and attract our attention after receiving the news."
"Even if we unearth them, these forces might not want to let their members represent the Dragon Rising Federation in the battle."
"So it will be more reliable to chose from the Battle Network!"
"The Purple Que School Palace and the Dragon Guard Sacred Hall can assist the Beastmaster Alliance."

"We at the Purple Que School Palace will do our utmost!"

"I share the same thoughts with Elder Su, Elder Pang, if there's anything you need help with, feel free to tell me!"


Upon hearing this, Ji Wanliu nodded and said.

"Our Creator's Guild will provide resources for the thirty Beast Masters selected from each age group in the preliminaries."
"We'll help the selected members improve their abilities in a short period."

Following Sect Master Xiao Xiang, the one in charge of the Dracoid Research Institute, Shuoyang Grandmaster, had his word.

"I have always believed that the younger generation is a federation's future, and Old Ji's decision is very good; it's indeed necessary for our Dragon Rising Federation to select the Dragon-Teng envoy!"
"Choosing the Dragon-Teng envoy could greatly stimulate the enthusiasm of the younger generation."
"Allowing Dragon Rising Federation to strive for as many Grandmaster Creator resources as possible from the Contract Garden during the competition in the East Competition District, and even the four major competition districts."
Just as the words of Ninth Sacrifice came to a halt, Pang Hu frowned and said,
"I have no objections to the selection of a Federal envoy, after all, it's an idea recorded in the ancient books from five or six epochs ago."
"The ancient books record the importance of a Federal envoy to a federation, but they don't record any selection criteria for the Federal envoy."
"To lead the young, power alone is not enough."
"Morality, character, and a sense of justice are also measurement standards!"

"The Dragon-Teng envoy chosen by our Dragon Rising Federation cannot be wicked or deceitful."
"So, power ranking alone should not be the determinant in the selection of a Federal envoy!"
Pang Hu's words made many people present start to ponder deeply.
Ji Wanliu was very satisfied with this situation.
Whatever he proposed could be guaranteed without any error through everyone's discussion.
As the administrator of the Purple Que School Palace, Su Bar was well aware that the outcome of a duel between young Beast Masters was often influenced by many random factors.
In order to ensure the absolute power of the Federal envoy, each age group should have two Federal envoys.
The Dragon Rising Federation could indeed appoint some additional Federal envoys.
However, if too many Federal envoys were appointed, it would defeat the original purpose of having a Federal envoy.

A federation should have role models, but there shouldn't be too many.
Otherwise, the younger generation would focus on which Alliance envoy is stronger, just like celebrity chasers, and overlook the positive role that Federal envoys represent.

"Since the main reason for our Dragon Rising Federation to select the Dragon-Teng envoy is due to the Contract Garden's decision to divide the competition districts, we must have a Dragon-Teng envoy in each age group."
"To truly represent each age group as a commander-in-chief!"
"I propose selecting two Dragon-Teng envoys for each age group, ranked as the Chief envoy and the Deputy envoy based on their strength."
"The Chief envoy is responsible for managing the affairs of the Dragon-Teng envoy, and the Deputy envoy has the power to assist and supervise the Chief envoy."
"The selection of the Dragon-Teng envoy should not be rushed, we can first release the news."

"It's not too late to confirm the Dragon-Teng envoy after the selection in the whole East Competition District is finished!"
"In addition, the Dragon-Teng envoy should be reselected every two to three years, when the resources are allocated by the Contract Garden."
"On the one hand, it's to select better quality strong individuals, on the other hand, with age, the Dragon-Teng envoy will inevitably exceed the age limitation of each segment."
"Choosing once before each competition in the four major competition districts held by the Contract Garden is the most appropriate."
The suggestions made by Su Bar were very detailed. Before the others could carefully consider, it's inappropriate for them to immediately respond to Su Bar's suggestions.
Ji Wanliu didn't intend to make the decision immediately either, so he addressed the others,
"Everyone, please consider this matter as an important topic, we'll decide on it at the next Royal Court meeting."

Shuoyang and Xiaoxiang are both Grandmaster Creators. They have the most authority and interaction within the Dragon Rising Federation.
In the past, all decisions made by Ji Wanliu were discussed privately with the Grandmasters Shuoyang and Xiaoxiang.
Now, Ji Wanliu has finally stopped consulting them on every matter as he used to do.
Both Shuoyang and Xiaoxiang believe that selecting a Federation envoy is a good thing for the Dragon Rising Federation, not a bad one.
Both strongly support this decision.
After exchanging glances with Master Shuoyang, Xiaoxiang said,
"The chosen Dragon-Teng Envoys will be personally trained by me."
"I will provide them with Grandmaster Creator resources to further enhance their abilities."
"These resources will not be accounted as contributions from the Creator's Guild to the Dragon Rising Federation, but rather as my personal gifts to these Dragon-Teng Envoys!"

Even before Xiaoxiang had finished speaking, Master Shuoyang responded,
"According to Elder Su, there will be a total of six Federation envoys."
"The resources required by these six individuals would indeed be a substantial investment!"
"I cannot let Master Xiaoxiang bear the cost of these resources alone."
"I will provide resources for the three regular Federation envoys!"
"The resources I provide will not be counted as contributions from the Dracoid Research Institute to the Dragon Rising Federation."
"The future of the Dragon Rising Federation requires collective effort from our eight departments!"
Both Shuoyang and Xiaoxiang are born and raised Federation citizens.
They have been silently contributing to the Dragon Rising Federation over the years.

Otherwise, with their statuses as Grandmaster Creators, they could have easily taken up positions in the Ten-thousand Nations Federation.
Seeking a higher position in the Ten-thousand Nations Federation is much more comfortable than staying within a single federation.

After all, as people who produce scarce resources, they aspire to receive the best treatment.
Some small federations are unable to offer the kind of treatment that a Grandmaster Creator needs.
After sending a message to Fang Yuan, Fang Mu is unaware of the changes in the Main World caused by the decision made in the Contract Garden.
What occupies Fang Mu's mind is a unique Spirit Series Guardian Beast called the Spirit Mayfly that belongs to the Qing Shi Business Association.
