[Beast Name]: Xi Hui Reflective Crane

[Beast Species]: Feather Crane/Subspecies Reflecting Sun Crane

[Beast Level]: Gold (5/10)

[Beast Attribute]: Fire

[Beast Potential]: Platinum

[Beast Quality]: Epic

Skills:

[Hui Condensation]: Using firelight as the emblem, condense the emblem to illuminate the space.

[Fire Mark]: Applies a mark on a fire attribute target, targets with the Fire Mark accelerate the recovery of spent Fire Elemental Energy inside their bodies, and similarly, their own energy consumption is also restored.

[Fire Bath Condensing Injury]: When targets with the Fire Mark sustain lethal injuries, the Fire Mark transforms into a Fire Bath Mark, consuming the target's internal Fire Elemental Energy to heal the injuries.

Exclusive Traits:

[Sun-shining Universally]: Under the illumination of firelight, creatures of fire attributes will have their attributes enhanced, while non-fire attribute creatures will temporarily adopt fire attribute characteristics, with attacks carrying fire attribute scorching effects.

[Twin Fire Tactics]: Targets enhanced by themselves can choose to doubly consume their own energy during an attack to deliver an additional elemental strike against the target. Besides the scorching effect, there is also a certain chance to trigger an explosive flame effect.

Evolutionary Path:

(After merging, each bloodline enhancement of the Guardian Beast expands its energy capacity but it cannot evolve or mutate again.)

Upon discovering this, Fang Mu couldn't help but gape.

The Copper Stage Xi Hui Reflective Crane had already been treated as a war machine by Fang Mu.

The Xi Hui Reflective Crane, formed by merging three Emblem Burning Cranes, had shown its potential as a decisive heavy weapon at that time.

And now, the Xi Hui Reflective Crane could well and truly be called a decisive heavy weapon!

Two new skills and one new exclusive attribute, both possessing the ability to amplify fire element Guardian Beasts!

The Silver Grade Skill [Flame Mark] could not only sustain the designated target but also speed up the recovery of fire elemental energy within itself.

This amounted to an enhancement in the sustained combat ability of fire attribute Guardian Beasts.

Even high-burst-type fire attribute Guardian Beasts could now continue to combat!

In a team composed of fire attribute Guardian Beasts, the effect of [Flame Mark] would be infinitely magnified.

If a medium-level combat team composed of fire attribute Guardian Beasts acquired a Guardian Beast with a skill similar to [Flame Mark], that team would be directly elevated to a high-level combat team.

It might even possibly become a top-level combat team!

However, Xi Hui Reflective Crane possessed not just the skill [Flame Mark]; the Gold Level Skill [Bathing Fire Consolidate Injury] endowed it with healing capabilities.

Allowing fire attribute Guardian Beasts to heal themselves by consuming their own fire elemental energy.

This somewhat resembled the effect in the games Fang Mu used to play in his past life, where magic points were used to recover Qi and blood.

[Flame Mark] itself had the effect of accelerating the recovery of fire elemental energy of the target, creating a perfect synergy between the two skills.

This allowed the generally defensively weak fire attribute Guardian Beasts to not fear being ambushed by the enemy's Guardian Beasts and losing combat capabilities.

Xi Hui Reflective Crane was referred to as a keystone Guardian Beast primarily because of the exclusive attribute [Sun-shining Universally].

[Sun-shining Universally] not only enhanced fire attribute Guardian Beasts but also amplified non-fire attribute Guardian Beasts.

Allowing non-fire attribute Guardian Beasts' attacks to carry fire elements, the attacks carried a burning effect, significantly enhancing the offensive capability of non-fire attribute Guardian Beasts.

This allowed all Guardian Beasts to be amplified by Xi Hui Reflective Crane, no longer limited just to the fire attribute Ones.

A Guardian Beast with a biased attribute was not qualified to be called a keystone heavy weapon.

The exclusive attribute [Beacon Fire Dual Techniques] obtained upon upgrading to Epic Quality was another enhancement of the attack effects of Guardian Beasts amplified by Xi Hui Reflective Crane.

Whenever a target amplified by Xi Hui Reflective Crane launched an attack on the enemy, it could carry out an additional elemental strike.

More importantly, aside from the burning effect, the elemental strike also had a certain chance of triggering a flame explosion.

The explosion was a more potent flame characteristic than burning, capable of blasting through the armor of high-defense targets directly.

This made the attacks' burning effects even more lethal.

While Fang Mu gaped in astonishment watching the Xi Hui Reflective Crane, Yi Han's face also mirrored such an expression.

Besides being shocked, there was some complexity on Yi Han's face.
