*[Race]: Green Silkworm*

*[Evolution Route]: Goddess of Light Butterfly*

*[Skill Requirement]: Worm Silk skill above expert proficiency*

*[Evolutionary Materials]: Uncooked Heart of Light aged one to three years (one), mature Sun Petal (ten), Firefly Nucleus (three), Luminous Fungus (50 grams), Sunlight Rock Powder (large amount), mature Light Containing Grass (large amount)*

*[Evolution Method]: After the Green Silkworm's growth level reaches Level 9, it needs a 9:1 ratio of Sunlight Rock Powder to soak the Light Containing Grass as its main food. The food soaking time is 1 hour. Feed until the Green Silkworm's growth level reaches Level 10.*
