DNA Strengthening (Allows the gaining of the Strength, Intelligence, and Dexterity attribute points)

-Analysis (Gives the host information about his surroundings, plants, creatures, and ores.)

-Brain Information Injector (It allows the injection of information directly to the brain. Based on touch)

-Device Manipulation (Allows the Host to manipulate electrical and mana-driven devices. Based on touch)

[Host's Powers]

-PLANT GROWING: Eo2E-RANKED (Allows the host to make Plants Grow Faster)

-SHARPENING: Eσ2D-RANKED (Makes Everything sharper according to the quantity of mana imbued into the item or body part.)

-POISONOUS MANA QUILLS: Eσ2E-RANKED (Create Mana Venomous spikes from the user's back. The amount of toxicity and the spike's length depends on the mana used.)

-VENOMOUS MANA DARTS: Eσ2E-RANKED (This ability enables the user to create and project mana darts infused with potent toxins. The effectiveness and lethality of these darts are directly proportional to the amount of mana channeled into their creation.)

-SHAPESHIFTING: Eo1A-RANKED (This skill allows the user to transform their physical form into that of other creatures. The prerequisite for each transformation is the prior absorption of its specific DNA, unlocking the ability to assume its form.)

-BONE MANIPULATION: Eσ1E-RANKED (This power grants the user the capacity to control and change their skeletal structure. It includes the ability to enhance the density, size, and form of the bones, as well as to sharpen them for defensive or offensive purposes.)

-MANA EXOKELETON: $E\sigma 1E$ -RANKED (This power grants the user the ability to create a mana exoskeleton. The exoskeleton protects the body from harm, but its resistance to external stimuli depends on the quantity of mana used.)

-ASTRAL WOLF BITE: Eσ1D-RANKED (Allows the user to turn his mana into a massive Leylarhad's mana head. Taking material form it can attack opponents or being used for other purposes. Notice: It won't last long. Mana consumption is very high.)

-Kyokar hand-to-hand style (BEGINNER) (A military fighting style developed in Frant)

-Whispering Willow Sword Technique (BEGINNER) (A sword fighting style developed in Khunelerp by a renowned fighter.)

Upon reviewing his status, Erik first acknowledged that the power he had gained from the Leylarhad was classified as D-ranked. This classification aligned with the known fact that Leylarhads often possessed D-ranked brain crystals.

He also deduced the reason behind the wolf-like head's inaction. The power required a specific target for the astral projection to activate and act, something he couldn't clearly know with no prior information.

Erik's attention then shifted to his experience points. He noted he had accumulated 1932 out of 3540 points. He needed a lot of experience to level up again. The encounter with the Leylarhad cub, despite its danger, had proven to be beneficial, as he gained two levels and a new brain crystal power.

More neural links did indeed contribute to enhanced strength and speed, but relying on one's body wasn't the right thing to do for humans. Thaids excelled in physical combat, an advantage humans could not replicate.

Their basic difference in stats was too much. Humans needed to wield their brain crystal powers adeptly to fight thaids on an equal footing.

The human approach to combat emphasized the importance of techniques, strategies, tactics, and skills. Those with the ability to manifest mana weapons focused on honing their usage.

This method was central to human combat styles, contrasting with the innate physical dominance of thaids.

Erik acknowledged that as a species, humans were less powerful than thaids, both in physical strength and mana. The key distinction between humans and these wild creatures lay in human intellect, which had led to the development of neural links and the adept utilization of powers.
