



[Lifting Weights]

Type: Etc.

Weight : 5 kg

Prerequisite: 5 STR

Details: Use to build up muscles and strengthen it. (can only increase STR, VIT and Endurance up to 5)

There are different size and weights in the rows. He take the smallest one and do some lifting with it and after ten minutes he heard a system notification.

SYSTEM: Your body is strengthen through repeated training. +1 STR, +1 VIT, +1Endurance

When he saw it he smiled and continue lifting but thirty more minutes later that smile is wiped out his face because his stamina has been drained.

Base on his estimate every minute of lifting consumes five stamina and his stamina and it is fully drained after forty minutes. He then fully recovered his stamina after six minutes of rest.

It is almost the the same as the previous one. Then he look at the other dumbbells and see that five of them are almost similar, so if his estimation is correct then he can get the maximum +25 in less than ten hours or ten hours at most.

While lifting a sudden thought sink in his head. Then he do some squats while lifting the dumbbells, after ten minutes of squatting a system notification rings in his ears.

SYSTEM : Your body becomes flexible because of repeated training. +1DEX

When he see that he formed a satisfying smile. This time he do some jogging while lifting after ten more minutes another notification rang on his ears but this time his AGI is the one that increases. So he continue lifting while doing some squats and jogging in the mix.

Shin didn't get bore of the repeated movement, since back when he is in the 'Black Serpent Mafia' camp he do a similar regime.

While he is thinking his sight accidentally land on Library across the Training Ground. Then he suddenly remembers his Master's words the first time they have met. "A real training method trains both the body and mind." after that a sudden thought enters his mind.

'There is nothing to lose if I give it a try, since I have a lot of time to spare.' said Shin to himself before walking towards the Library.

The ratio of Real world Time and In game Time is 1:3 so he still a lot of time before dinner time.

The moment Shin enters the Library, the NPC Old woman librarian greeted him " Hello young man, how can this humble library can help you?"

'No quest initiated? Well I guess I'm being greedy?' said Shin in his heart before saying to the old lady "I wish to increase my knowledge, can you give me your guidance senior?"

"Hmm. What a polite young man. This is my first time seeing an 'Otherworldly Individual' treating me like this. Well if you want to broaden your horizon then you should read some books, the more books you read the smarter you become." Said the Old lady librarian.

In this world the NPCs called themselves as the 'Natives', they are the true residents of the world. While they addressed the players as 'Otherworldly Individual' they are summoned in this world by gods and goddesses to become it's savior against the evil forces.

'Huh? Arthur is right the NPC of this world really acts like a real person, so it is better to treat them as one.' muttered Shin quietly before bowing to the Old lady librarian while saying " Thank you for your guidance senior. "

Shin walks towards one of the shelves and pick a book to read, it only have two sentences in it and after reading it a familiar sound rings on his ears.

"How the hell am I going to finish that number of books? Especially in seven days." said Shin while scratching his head. But moments later he stops when he said the keywords of the quest. "Wait, 'Seven Days'? Of course seven days is not enough finish that numbers of book. So why did the System put the seven days limit?"

After a few more hours of reading he logout of the game to eat dinner with the other members of the family then after that he go back to his room to continue reading the books in the game.

But a true soldier do not only have strength and knowledge, they also need some skills so go to that training dummy and figure out your own." He give Shin a wooden sword while pointing at the training dummies in front of him.

The moment Shin heard what Trainer Paul, his eyes turned bright because of the sudden enlightenment he then said to himself "So that's how is it. So that is the last piece of the puzzle."

Shin heard from Arthur that you can create your own 'Self Created Skill' in this game. There are two ways of creating it.

First is by combining different kind of skills in the game . You can combine any kind of skills you what as long as in complement the other skill/s or as long as you can execute it properly.

That kind of skill is called 'Combined Skill' and a combined skill can be replicate by other players as long as they know the right skill combination and know how to execute it properly. And a 'Combined Skill' do not share a cool down time with the original skill/s that have been used in the combination.

And the other way is creating a skill starting from the scratch.

It is even more challenging to do this one because you need to properly execute the skill a hundred of times perfectly or even more, just to create this skill. What is more the skill that have been created needs to be accepted by the system for it to be recognize as a new skill.

The skill that is created this way is called 'Personalized Skill'.

A 'Personalized Skill' can't be replicate by others since it have been created yourself, unless you teach that skill to other person.

And the final part of Shin's quest is for him to create a 'Self Created Skill'. Or more likely a 'Personalized Skill'.

Then Shin look at his other rewards. An unremarkable scroll, A sword in sheath, and A purple book. The scroll is a recommendation letter for the Village Chief.

The sword is ordinary looking but have a decent stats and an Iron rarity. The items in this game are divided in 8 different ranks such as Iron, Bronze, Silver, Gold, Platinum, Black Mithril, Obsidian and Stellar and it is ranked from weakest to strongest respectively.

The first five ranks are the items that can be dropped from monsters and NPCs, or a reward from a quest. While the last three ranks are the items that can only be get by crafting items using specific materials.

There are also some items that are lower that Iron rank and they are the so called trash items.

There are five skill ranks Basic, Rare, Epic, Legendary and Myth. And the color of its skill books are White, Yellow, Orange, Red and Black respectively.

The higher the rank, the stronger the skill and harder to execute. So even if you have a powerful skill and you don't know how to execute it, it is meaningless because you can't learn it or use it.

Aside from Common Skills, Special Skill and 'Self Created Skill', there is another skill that can be learned. It is called 'Legacy Skill', this skill can be learned from Special NPCs or inherit from Hero NPCs.

Most of the Legacy Skills are learned by the Players that have 'Special Classes' but it doesn't mean they are only one that can learn that skill. As long as someone is recognized by the NPC and know how to use the skill then they can also learn that skill.

The only difference of Special Skill and Legacy Skill is that A Special Skill book can be dropped by monsters while the later is not other than that Legacy Skills are stronger, it can even rival a Myth Skill if used properly.

Shin form a very satisfied smile as he check his rewards. Then after that go to the Village Chief's house.

When he get there, he got doubtful because there are no Players visiting the Village Chief. From what he know about the game, The Village Chief should be the most visit place in a Beginner's Village.

Even though he is suspicious he still walks towards it, and the moment he stands at House entrance a group of Players is passing by, when Shin see who they are he frown because they are the same group that saw in the Training Grounds.

The group of Players also notice Shin and they also remember him.

"Hey look isn't it the Newbie that we saw three days ago? He he is still 'level 0' even though it's already been three days?" one of the said.

The middle aged man in the group walks towards Shin and said "Kid don't tell me you are still doing that 'Scam Quest'? We told you that you are just wasting your time there. How about come with us we will help you gain a few Levels?"

Shin look at the middle age man and see that he is not hiding his in information.

*(For more information about the Level-up procedures please look at Author's thought below.)

"A Human can have a 10 'Undistributed Stats' every level. Even though a Human don't have any Multiplier on their main stats they still get 5 more 'Undistributed Stats' than the other races."

"Since I have a lot of bonus stats from the training I should not spend any 'Undistributed Stats' for now and save it for emergency purposes." said Shin while he is criticizing his last battle. A 'Multiplier of Stats' is a bonus on main stats that other race gain in every level. For example if a human can have 5 points in their every stats for every level they gain then an Elf can have 5 points in every stats and +3 more in AGI and INT in every level.

After that he gather the boar's skin and tusk, and pick up the loots. He got a little unlucky this time because the boar only drop a few pieces of bronze coin.

Then he look for his next target. He do the same approach, he wait for the boar to charge at him before a diagonal step while doing a draw attack and then continue attacking while paying attention to his stamina.

Few hours later. A boar is Charging at Shin at great speed, when the boar is near him he do the same diagonal step while drawing the sword from his waist but this time it is done with an extreme speed and precise timing.

Then a system notification ring on his ears but he ignore it and follow his attack with his typical combo. After he kills the boar he then take a look at the system notification.

System: Congratulations you have created a new skill please give a name for your skill.

'So it is really easier to create a skill in combat, sometimes it is good to listen to Arthur about the game. I wonder what level he is or how good is he?.' said Shin to himself before naming his new skill. "Let's call it 'Quick Draw'"

System: Congratulations you have created a Rare skill 'Quick Draw' you have been granted 10 Fame as bonus.

And the dropped rates of weapons and armors are very low, that's why he didn't find any weapons that have been drop.

But I also want reach Level 10 earlier so that I can have my class change." said Shin while leaving his spot to find the cave but before he get too far away, he heard a large and heavy steps coming from his back.

He turned around and look what is it. And what he see is a golden boar three times larger than a Wild Boar. He then activate Scouting to see it stats.

Well I can easily kill this guy if I use my Undistributed Stats but I have decided that I'm only going to use it once I've done my class change." said Shin while looking at the Golden Boar cautiously.

When the 'Golden Boar' see Shin's action, it get enrage because it thinks Shin is provoking him. It scratch it's front foot before using 'Charge' just like the other boars.

Shin smirks when see this happens. "What a predictable guy". When the 'Golden Boar' is almost in front of him he use 'Quick Draw'.

When the 'Triple Slash' hits, a large chunk of the boar's HP is gone. Then it release a loud roar while raising it's front feet.

When Shin saw that he hurriedly use a 'Destructive Slash'

The Golden Boar's movement pauses for a second before continuing to Stamp it's front feet.

Even though Shin failed to cancel the 'Stamp' he still managed to get away from it's effective range using his own 'Charge'.

While Shin is busy dealing with the 'Golden Boar', a party of five Players is moving towards his direction.

" Boss, this is the direction where I hear that roar. I'm sure it is from the 'Golden Boar'." said by an Elf from the group while playing with his dagger.

"Let's hurry up, we can't let other guy steal that boss from us." a middle age Lionkin Beastman command to the others.

If Shin is here he will recognize them because these players are the group of players that mock him when he is accepting the 'Training Quest'.

When they arrive at the site, what they see startled them.

"Look that guy is fighting that Boss solo." said a Human guy of the group.

"Boss isn't that guy that we saw in the Village? How come he is already Level 7? What's more fight a Boss solo". said the Elf when he recognize Shin.

" Could it be he got lucky manage to find a powerful weapon?". said by a WolfKin

"Look that guy sword is shinning with blue light maybe he really have rare weapon, from the looks of it it should be at least a Bronze rank weapon because those are the only items that have that kind of effects" said by the Human once he saw Shin's attack.

"Yeah, and look at those kind of damage the 'Golden Boar' has at least 300 defense because of it's 'Hard Skin Skill' but he still able to deal a lot of damage, especially that drawing skill it deals more than 2000 damage it should be the additional skill of that weapon.

But contrary to these guys expectations, the real reason why Shin's sword is shinning is because of his 'Equalizer Skill'. His sword is coated with blue light because some of his Magic Attack is being converted to Physical Attack.

While his 'Quick Draw' is a 'Personalized Rare Skill' which is a lot more stronger than basic skills. Even though it is a possibility they disregard it because they don't believe, that Shin can create an 'OP Skill' like that. "That's enough chit-chatting, spread out and surround that kid. At the same time the Boss Health reaches 20%, Then the Elf charge at Shin's back with extreme speed and use a CC(Crowd Control) Skill.

But when Shin felt the killing intent coming from Elf's dagger, he instinctively move his body sideways barely dodging the attack. After that he turn around and use a 'Destructive Slash' on Elf. Followed by a notification ring on his ears.

System: You've attacked another Player. Classified as an act of self-defense so you will not get a 'Sin Points'.

The Elf got startled at what happened, what's more he can't even move because of the two seconds stun. Then the 'Golden Boar' ram at him resulting to send him flying.

At the same time Shin uses 'Charge' at Dan who is standing not far from him.

When the Human and WolfKin Players are almost at Shin, they want use their offensive skills but Shin is faster, he use 'Quick Draw' on the Human guy followed by a Triple Slash to the WolfKin and a normal attack

They followed the footsteps of their Boss. The last guy stops his tracks when he see his comrades died tragically. He look at the Elf guy that is sent flying by the Boar and when he see the Elf is already running away, he want to run away too but Shin is already attacking him.

He circled on a tree trying to block the Boar's path, but the Boar is in 'Berserk State' so tree got blasted when the Boar rammed at it. When the Boar speed is slowed down by the tree, Shin continued to circled around on the other trees waiting for his skills cool down.

Roar!!!!!

After few more minutes of battle the Golden Boar taked it last breath resulting for Shin to level-up once again.

And then Shin's eyes shines when he see the Golden Boar's drops.
