Just as the Holland family gaped at Nathan in shock, a Maybach and two Mercedes-Benz suddenly showed up outside.


The head of the Lillard family, Klay, came to visit them with his youngest son, Keller and a few of his subordinates.





Nathan really is a man of his word! He really asked the Lillard family to kneel down and apologize!


The Lillard family was shocked at first, but they subsequently burst into laughter.

Klay intentionally stared at Nathan for a little while longer before answering, "I don't know which lowlife made you, and I don't really care as well!"


Keller and the six subordinates chuckled furiously when they heard that.

That was why Klay was confident that Nathan wouldn't even dare to lay a finger on him because he thought that with the power he had, he could easily destroy Nathan and the Holland family.


Unfortunately for him, he didn't know who the man in front of him was!

Besides that, he was sent flying as he collapsed heavily on the ground.


The mocking laughter from the Lillard family died away in an instant.


Klay waved his hand at the muscular bodyguards.

Klay and Keller widened their eyes in awe as they witnessed the speed of Colin and the Elite Eight.


Both the father and son thought of the same thing. Nathan's people are so much faster!


Before Nathan could speak, Colin roared in anger. "How dare you threaten our master!"

Colin then slammed Keller's head on the table once again just as Nathan ordered.


The table crumbled. When Colin raised Keller's head again, his face was covered with wood chips from the table. Keller's previous arrogance was now nowhere to be seen.

Klay wouldn't dare to challenge Nathan in




the current situation. All he could think of was to find a way to take Nathan down with help from the rest of his family at a later time.

The words embarrassed Klay so much that he wanted to kill Nathan right away.


The humiliation Klay got from Nathan had amounted to more than all he'd gotten in his life.

Even though these men dressed in different styles, they all had one thing in common. They were all holding a katana in their hands.


A rich looking man in fur coat came down with a woman in his arm.

After Keller had broken up with Candice, he immediately got engaged to Linda Langer, Joe's younger sister.


Joe was like the saving grace for the Lillards as they begged, "Mr. Langer! You're here just in time! Please help us!"

Joe's hand, which was reaching for Klay, froze in mid-air and he turned to look at Nathan,


"Are you that eager to meet your maker? You dare to use that tone on me in Bossania?"

The Hollands were already as pale as ghosts as they'd never seen such a thing unfold in front of them before.


Yet, Nathan didn't even flinch at the charging men.

With their hands gone, their katanas fell to the floor with their hands.


Ahhh...!

The Hollands were also surprised by what they had just witnessed. None of them had expected that the men that Nathan brought were so strong.


The fight ended very quickly.

Nathan scoffed and focused his attention on Joe and Jade.


"I have told you back on the ship that you're welcome to take your revenge on me anytime, but I have also warned you that you'd have to face my wrath if you attempt to do so."

Joe's face twisted from pain as sweat rolled down his forehead. "You f**ker! My dad is going to kill all of you!"





"Hah! Are you afraid now?" Joe Langer laughed. "It's all too late now! You will all be dead when my dad arrives!"


"Your dad?" Nathan raised an eyebrow.

The Hollands were also dumbfounded.




Did Nathan just say he wanted the head of the langer family to come and apologize to him?


Nathan's words managed to convinced the Hollands somehow. Maurice wanted to say more but he stopped himself in the end.

Who the heck is Nathan? How did he make the head of the Langers kneel before him?





"Dad, you..." Joe's voice was shaking.


"Mr. Langer, why are you apologizing to this bastard? You even kneel before him." Klay also asked.

The Lillards and Joe couldn't believe their own ears.


Everyone including the Hollands were dumbfounded.

Surprisingly, the Hollands were rather happy with what they had seen. It was as if God was punishing those who had sinned.



The Hollands began to guess if it was because the head of the Langers was an honest person or maybe Nathan was a much more important person than he appeared to be.





Keller and Klay were startled.


Joe, too, was stunned.

Friend?


Upon hearing his words, both Klay and Keller turned to look at Candice, who was standing in the crowd, in shock.

Klay really did not know why. He recalled that his eldest son was in the North Army, and he heard that he was being valued for his abilities.


He could not help but ask, "Isn't it because my son, Joseph Lillard, is in the North Army. Isn't he a soldier you value?"

Furthermore, every time Joseph called home, he would lie to them, telling them that he was doing well in the military.




Hence, that was why Klay assumed that it was because the General valued his eldest son when the Lillard family received the plaque from the General.

to look at Candice with a complicated expression.


Candice, too, was staring back at them with a similar expression.



They could not help but feel hearty merriment to that.


They thought, Didn't the Lillards think they were fantastic? Didn't they look down on us and said that Candice was unworthy of him?

They were proud because they felt prideful for their son to have a friend like Nathan.


Birds of the same feather flock together. That also implied that their son was an excellent man too to be a friend with someone as successful as Nathan.

In the end, she said in a cold voice, "I'm sorry. From the moment you broke off our engagement and went back on our promise, it was the end of us."


A horrified expression crossed Keller's face, and he moved to grab Candice's legs to beg her again.

In a trembling voice, Klay murmured, "General, the Lillard family will accept any kind of punishment, but please, let the bloodline in our family continue."


Nathan was the General, and Bossania was under the jurisdiction of the North, which meant it was under the ruling of Nathan.
