





They could not wait to see them go against Nathan and end up defeated.


In Alberesque, at Schulz Mansion, Vance was in discussions with everyone at home.





They were Quinten and Juan from the Elite Eight, bodyguards who were secretly in charge of protecting Nathan's family.


Quinten's right hand reached into his suit, holding on to a gun with a silencer. He shot Tom twice, killing him on the spot.

Nathan's gaze seemed to turn unintentionally toward Freddie's crotch.


Ryan understood that hint instantly. At once, he raised his foot to trample on Freddie's crotch.

Penny blushed slightly, tilting her face up with her eyes closed.


At first, Nathan was puzzled. His eyes then fell on Penny's red lips and he realized she was actually asking for a kiss.
