
















In the main city of Snow Territory, heavy snowfall persisted year-round.

Sometimes, Gu Chaoyan wondered if she truly wasn't fit to be the City Lord.



Ouyang Mingjing, on the other hand, grew increasingly displeased and impatient.


He made a faint sound of agreement and refrained from further remarks.
