She possessed formidable gambling skills, making her an exceptional player in her own right. The absence of her participation would undoubtedly result in her own missed opportunities.





After their stones were opened, it was Gu Chaoyan's turn.

Mu Weiran couldn't help but breathe a sigh of relief.


Zhao Dier burst into mocking laughter.

This was a tea crystal about the size of the stone itself.













Then, she used Sword Kinesis Flight and left.
