Gu Chaoyan took out the bottles and gave one to each of them.


It was the same type of elixir that could conceal a person's spiritual energy and breath.

"Let's proceed," Gu Chaoyan said after finishing her meal and leading the way towards the cliff.




The involvement of the Grand Unity Sect crossed her mind, but she couldn't be certain of the situation that awaited her. Thus, she refrained from rushing in recklessly.

There was one demon beast at Longdi Mountain, but because the demon beast died, no one picked the Green Sun Grass.


It was very likely that there were no so-called demon beasts at all.


Gu Chaoyan let out a sigh of relief.


