They exchanged glances, indicating they felt they had provided enough guidance. If she had known, she wouldn't have dashed around aimlessly.


Considering their advice as a gesture of kindness, they left, attending to their own duties, leaving Gu Chaoyan standing alone in the wind.

Little did she know the Sky Sect had its own set of intricacies.


Hadn't obtaining the Guidance Scroll meant truly entering the Sky Sect?
