Aveline gained a lot from it.


She exhaled a sigh of relief and stood up. "Thank you, Mr. Tudor, for letting me sit in. I have work to do, so I'll go now.


Lucas pressed the remote control, and the screen slowly rose, the blinds opening to let light flood the office once more.
