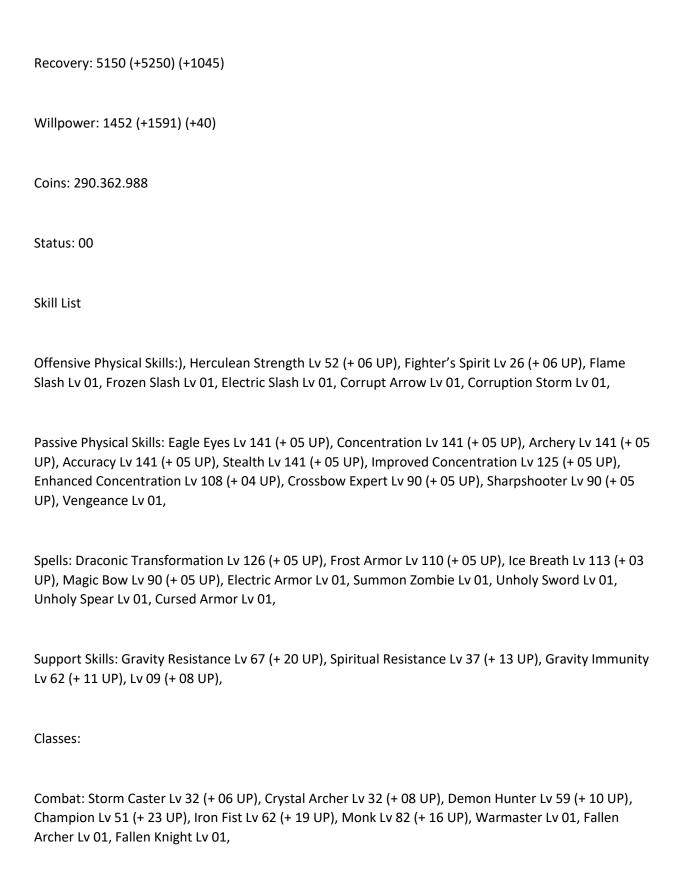

"Go to hell," Ryan said.

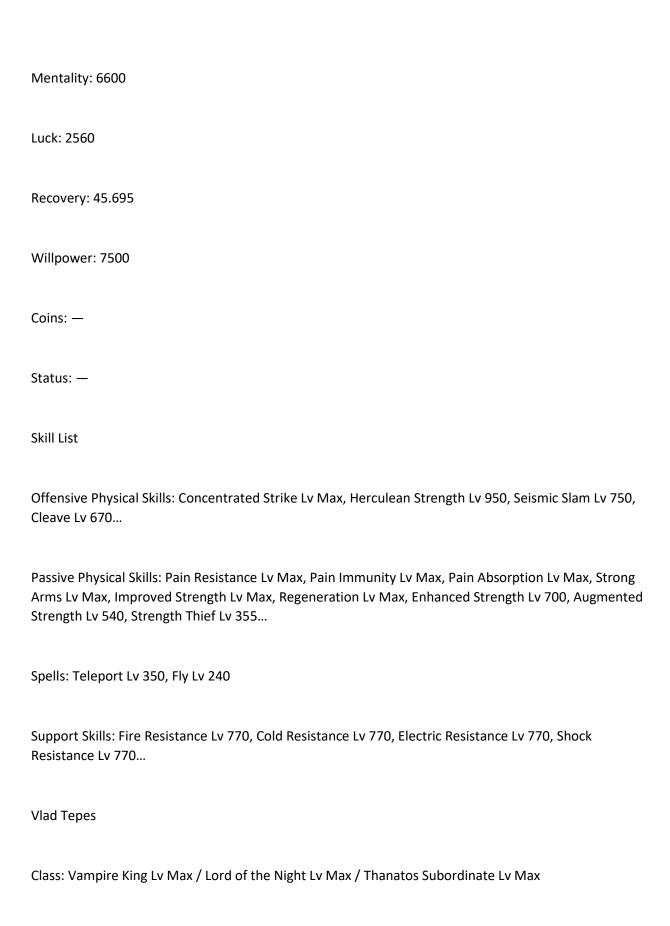


