

Principal's Office.


Like always, the first thing Wen Ruohan did every day was to bring a warm cup of bubble milk tea for Principal Ding.


"Of course it counts."

Ding Yue nodded, thinking this was a direction worthy of breakthrough.


Mist City Arts and Science University's Architecture School has won the Hop Cup Best Creative Award last year, which is a notable honor.

Also, did you know, research shows...


For every freeloader who indulges in pirated books, the author suffers a bit more. Follow my mantra: No freeloaders, no harm!

"Yes, it's too similar. Even the design concepts are the same. It's too outrageous!" Wen Ruohan was so angry that she stomped her foot.


You see, on the internet, Wen Ruohan was a battler.

"You already knew?"


Hearing this, Ding Yue looked at Huang Youjie.


It seemed that Huang had learned about the patent infringement by the library that Shuisi County intended to build on Mist City Arts and Science University's library design before he even arrived.

There are two related trending topics in the top ten.

The rise of the first trending topic was largely due to the surge in attention after the announcement of the lawsuit by Mist City Arts and Science University's official Twitter account was posted.

It has since reached the top of the trending chart.

After all, a private university sueing a county government, seems to be an unheard event.

After understanding the full situation, netizens praised Mist City Arts and Science University's determination to safeguard its design patents, and also had a good impression of Shuisi County's prompt response and apology.
