To some extent, this kind of pre-sale was similar to pre-sales of houses, since a car was also considered a large commodity.




Chief Chu Jiannan answered seriously.

But the problem now was not this, but the sudden chip shortage crisis!



They wouldn't dare!


"What do you all think?"

In his view, there were plenty of big companies in the country that wanted to make new energy vehicles. Compared to these companies, Feiyue Group still had a long way to go.


