Chapter 1463: North-South Campus Plan! _2


Upon hearing Director Chen Ping's words, Ding Yue felt a surge of excitement in his heart.

Director Xiao Wenxing has indeed achieved many accomplishments during his years at the Mist City Education Department.



"I'll find time to visit Governor Li then,"


Ding Yue thought for a moment and said.


"Alright."
