The students from Mist City Arts and Science University on-site were boiling with excitement, with every student wondering how Principal Ding and Big White flew out of the big screen.


This was simply too magical, wasn't it?

The sci-fi effects were maxed out!



As soon as Ding Yue landed, he picked up where Jia Wenbo left off and continued singing.



On the last working day before the Spring Festival, Ding Yue finally breathed a sigh of relief after Secretary Wen Ruohan reported on all the work.


"Phew."

After all, humanity's future isn't just about vast expanses of stars and seas; the virtual world also presents significant growth potential.


"Director Yang, are you saying... that your biology department has made some progress with the neuromorphic induction technology?"

Now, Ding Yue was thinking about "neuromorphic induction technology," wanting to see if opening a level-three University Treasure Chest would yield something related.


"Open one [level-three University Treasure Chest]?"
