Jian Zihao took a deep breath and said to his players.



Commentator Vale said this with an excited tone.


However, domestic audiences could basically tell that the commentator was starting to worry about the FY team.

Usually, under such circumstances, if a defeat is due to poor player form, it is very easy to be severely criticized, but this time it was different.



Chapter 850: Hanging by the Beam, Pricking the Thighs, All for Revenge


In doing anything, one must not rush—especially not with high-tech products that are basically impossible for others to fake.


Watching the logistics vehicles driving out from the medical health robot factory area, Ding Yue felt quite comfortable.
