The relevant departments would probably greenlight Feiyue Group at every turn because Feiyue becoming bigger would also be a boon for Mist City.


It could contribute to GDP, employment, and tax revenue!

Ding Yue nodded, "Then I'll see President Xiong off."


Since he hadn't received President Xiong, it was definitely necessary to see him off.
