


If we cannot secure graphene batteries for use in smartphones, computers, and other electronic devices this time, it would mean losing track of the future market.


The consequences would be severe.

Apart from imported Teslas, it was Penguin electric cars from Penguin New Energy that stood out alone.


Some time ago, Dami Technology Group had released news of entering the new energy electric car market, but up till now, it hadn't even made a splash.

"Chen Xuejun?"


When Ding Yue heard this name, it sounded familiar, but he couldn't recall who this person was associated with at the moment.


"Right, a businessman who obtained the rights to the forest farm through some special means and then proceeded to cut down the trees and burn the trunks, converting the land for grape cultivation,"


After hanging up the phone,



But Ding Yue didn't plan to act that way just yet.


You think your PR at Q Entertainment Media is very powerful, do you?

"Find out the truth, hold every responsible person accountable!"


