


| Chapter 151 Holiday [1] |

| Sam flew to Japan for a well-deserved vacation. |










| Sam didn't just rent a hotel room in Japan this time though, rather, he rented a small villa here in the city of Tokyo, Japan. |

The most recent time the world of football experienced something like that was with Lionel Messi, the little genius from Rosario, Santa Fe.




| Just like the whole world expected, on that first game, Germany set a marker to the rest of the elite teams in the tournament. |




| Portugal recorded a narrow 2-1 victory over Czechia. |



football, Manchester United.


| Playing against Manchester United in the opening game of the season was a test of nerves to see if Fulham's form from last season extended into this season. |
