The first thing he exposed would be his Intent and Fire Element before using his Array while Space Element would be the last.

If people found Space Element, the reaction would be more dramatic than the Pure Fire Element due to its uniqueness. This thought made him wonder what kind of power would a Pure Space Element bring.

"If you are thinking of a Pure Space Element, you won't find them. Pure Element is only a term for Element related to Nature such as fire, water, ice, thunder, and so on. However, if you want to classify your Space Element, then yes, it is close to Pure Element due to its uniqueness." She explained.

A glimpse was what he needed to ignore the Metal Bullet Technique, Water Tank, and Lightning Hammer. It was different for the SR Array Paper as he was planning to use it to create a few arrays for later purposes. The most important thing was the UR item, Metal Orb.

The appearance of Metal Orb caused a change of his decision in the Spear Art. After considering the pros and cons for a while, he decided to imbue the Metal Orb to his rank 6 spear. The moment the metal element was infused, the spear hardness increased several folds.

Although it did not compliment his Fire Element, it had another purpose due to a certain technique he wanted to learn.

This sword technique was not popular because it was a double-edged sword, but the negative could be ignored with Alex's Pure Fire Element, making it a perfect sword technique for him.

The third Sword Art was Blade of Conquest. After two close-range techniques, Alex certainly needed a ranged attack to replace his Seven Stars Cut. Alex noticed that the Seven Stars Cut did not have the Nature part despite being a low Heaven Tier Sword Art.

The ancestor of Heavenly Sword Sect never knew what distinguished a Heaven Tier Art, making him unable to comprehend the Nature part. It could be said that this technique was not a Heaven Tier, but a peak Earth Tier.

The second spear technique was Phantom Trust, allowing him to trust his opponent from a distance. This technique might not be as strong as the others, but it certainly had a similarity to Alex's Spear Throwing Technique. He could use spin or insane power for the absorption part.
