World Link Online was not only a game but also a job for him.

At first, he saw a game video made by a well-known live-streamer in the game area, which gave him the idea of "recording the wonderful games in the arena to make a video".

Relying on the popularity of the game, he made some entertainment-oriented dueling videos, and his results have always been passable. Although it couldn't be compared with those big names, at least it's no problem to make a living.

Yuei Vu was the nickname that he picked up when he created the account. Because after all, when playing the game of Yu-Gi-Oh, it was common (mistake) sense to include the word "Yu" at the beginning of the name.

As for "Vu", it had no other meaning, just the homonym of his real name, Yu.

Thinking about it this way, Su Yu (now Yuei Vu) was a little lucky. Fortunately, when he named his name, he didn't choose a painful name like "Crazy Dragon That Destroyed Heaven", otherwise he would have just reincarnated in place

It's just that this panel

The good news was that at least the panel data doesn't look much different from the player panel he was familiar with, and he could understand most of the attribute data.

The bad news was that his panel seems to be (too) a little bit unbalanced

All of his initial attribute points seem to be skewed to the Charisma value. In layman's terms, it's beauty.

Charisma 100 was a full score, over 80 points is considered a high-value area, and 90 points belonged to the "everyone on the street has to turn their heads" level. Like his initial score of ninety-five points, it may be close to an unparalleled level.

At this point, you may ask, it's just a card game, what was the use of a good face? Was it possible to draw the card you want if you were handsome?

Eh, you may not understand this. The NPCs in this game all have their own favorability system. The higher the favorability of a key NPC towards you, the more chance you have to trigger an event on him/her, and may even be rewarded with rare cards.

Therefore, some players could rely on their high Charisma value and try their best to lick the feet of their favorite NPC sister/brother. As long as they wait patiently until their favorability was full, then players could get their wish

played cards with NPC.

Oh, did you just have a perverted thought? World Link Online was a serious card game online, but it has passed the review, and there was absolutely no unhealthy game content.

Charisma 95 was not bad, after all, being handsome was not a bad thing. Besides, the expectance of readers was generally on the rise. Nowadays, if the protagonist was not more handsome than average, he was a shame.

However, Lucky 20 was a bit of a pain in the ass.

It's not that you couldn't draw the cards you want during a duel if your luck was low. According to this world setting, whether or not you could draw them all depends on the "Hearts of the Cards", and has little to do with the luck attribute.

The luck attribute here affects the probability of hitting when you activated those effects such as flipping a coin and guessing heads and tails.

If you were Lucky 20, it basically meant that you would lose every bet in your life, that was when you flipped a coin, and the result was always the opposite of your guessing.

In this regard, Su Yu estimated that the lucky value of Katsuya Jonouchi in Yu-Gi-Oh's animation should be more than 90. Most of this guy's decks were gambling effects. This guy's shit luck was so strong that it was like a superpower. In the original animation, by relying on his powerful shit luck, he became the runner-up in the Duelist Kingdom and reached the semi-finals of the Battle City tournament.

We generally used two words to describe this kind of person a true gambler.

Next was the Endurance and Stamina, these two were directly related.

At this point you may be asking again what did a card game have to do with endurance?

However, according to the world setting of Yu-Gi-Oh, playing cards was indeed related to endurance. Although the monsters summoned and cards activated by both sides of the duel were all three-dimensional images, according to the settings, they would still cause physical shocks to the duelist.

The Endurance value directly corresponded to the upper limit of the player's stamina. In Yuei Vu's panel, Stamina 3/3 meant that he could play three times in total when his stamina was in good condition.

If the Endurance value was between 40 and 50, you could play four games in a row. If it was between 50 and 60, five games in a row. Between 60 and 70, six games in a row, and so on.

Therefore, playing cards was actually a physical activity, and it also has certain requirements for the Endurance of the duelist.

Endurance 35 was clearly below the average line, which made Yuei Vu feel a little bit of a pain in the ass.

After all, for men, if the stamina was not enough, no matter how good the technique was, it was useless (referring to card skills).

The lack of physical strength directly affected the speed of upgrading, but this attribute may also increase as the level increases.

In World Link Online, if you wanted to level up, you must gain EXP by dueling with others or completing tasks, and leveling up would be accompanied by some rewards such as card coupons and crystal.

Card coupons could be exchanged for a very limited number of cards from the system, while crystals could be used to buy card packs.

It was precise because of the system that players even have the opportunity to obtain cards that should not have been available in the background era of Yu-Gi-Oh.

But that's all for later.

Now, Yuei Vu must think carefully about how he would continue his path as an unknown NPC passerby in the Yu-Gi-Oh! world.

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## **Chapter 2: Pure Elemental HERO Deck**

When a player logged in with an account, and after generating a game character, they would automatically gain a Duel Disk from the system. It was equivalent to the novice gift pack.

The opening of the World Link Online was set in the Battle City arc of the original Yu-Gi-Oh! animation. At this point of time, Kaiba Corp has just developed Duel Disk, a card-playing device that can project three-dimensional images of monsters anytime and anywhere. The rich and powerful Kaiba Corp has given all "recognized" duelists this new generation a Duel Disk for free.

From this detail, Yuei Vu confirmed that he was reborn earlier than the server opening.

The billboard on the side of the street in the business district said that the Kaiba Corp would host the Battle City tournament in the next month.

*Emmm*

*a month is too short, isn't it?*

*According to cliches of rebirth s, shouldn't I be given three years to develop and wait for the players to come and cut the leeks?*

*A month, in a "free to play, pay to win" game like this, God knows if I can acquire a decent deck*

It was worth mentioning that many cards that could be easily obtained with real cards may be highly rare in World Link Online, and even if you work hard, you may not be able to get them.

For example, the Blue-Eyes White Dragon.

This kind of card could never be opened in the system's card pool, and until Yuei Vu crossed over, he never heard of any player getting it through quests.

Although there was no conclusive evidence, some people even suspect that there may be only three Blue-Eyes White Dragon cards in the world in this damned game, and all of them were in the hands of the NPC Kaiba Seto

There were other rare cards such as Dark Magician, although it was not so rare that there were only a few cards in the world, it was also extremely difficult to obtain, and it was impossible to open it in the system card pool.

To put it bluntly, some rare cards and decks in World Link Online were a bit like the unique secrets in martial arts games. Whether you can get started depends not only on the player's game level but also on chance.

It was well known that the card deck was the most powerful weapon in the Yu-Gi-Oh! world, so after Yuei Vu was reborn in this world, he naturally checked his initial deck immediately

and then, unsurprisingly, the set of Elemental HERO.

Wow! Start with a set of Elemental HERO! Come on, the protagonist's deck must be very cool, right?

*WHAT THE F\*CK!*

*Okay, I can accept that there is no A Hero Lives or Mask Change, but why there is no Elemental HERO Stratos?*

*Without Stratos, who would want to play a HERO deck?*

(Note: Elemental HERO Stratos, 4 stars, ATK 1800, DEF 300

Effect: When this card is Normal or Special Summoned. You can activate 1 of these effects.

1) Destroy Spells/Traps on the field, up to the number of "HERO" monsters you control, except this card.

2) Add 1 "Hero" monster from your deck to your hand. )

Let alone such a powerful card, the initial card set given by the damned system didn't even have a Polymerization. Not to mention the powerful monsters that Elemental HERO later came out with, there didn't seem to be a single effect monster in the entire deck.

In other words, it seemed that he has to start from scratch, relying on the famous "Four (Waste) Soul Heroes" to conquer the world

"Four (Waste) Soul Heroes" refer to the first four Elemental HERO monsters used by Yuki Judai, the protagonist of Yu-Gi-Oh! GX Avian, Burstinatrix, Clayman, and Sparkman. Because all of them were normal monsters with no effect, and their attack power was not high, that's why they were given this honorable title by players

Of course, there's nothing to complain about, because this initial deck was also chosen by Yuei Vu himself when he was a trumpet player.

When players create a character, the system would give many sets of initial card groups with different themes to choose from.

It's just that players have researched and found that it didn't really matter what you choose, anyway, the initial deck would only give you a bunch of normal monsters that are useless.

This kind of monster is called "Normie" by the majority of players

So why did he choose Elemental HERO to start the game?

That's because Yuei Vu made an appointment with the audience at the end of the last video he delivered, and he will play a "pure" hero deck in the next video. As a result, who knew that the hero was not regarded as a hero, and inexplicably took the account to travel together (Giant Soldier Warning.JPG) free.c om

But Yuei Vu had another advantage.

That was he clearly knew all kinds of anecdotes since the game was launched, including some player-triggered sidelines and some hidden plots.

[Mystic Tomato, ATK 1400]

"I end my turn."

Yuei Vu announced the end of his turn, but Pandora did not rush to draw cards. He glared at him grimly.



"You kid don't you have a rare card?"

Yuei Vu spread out his hands: "I never said I have one."

Obviously, as soon as you see the Duel Disk in my hand, it's your fault to assume that I have a rare card. I can be just a poor ghost with Normie, can't I?

Pandora's face became more gloomy, and his gaze seemed to pierce Yuei Vu.

Yuei Yu could understand his current mood. It was roughly similar to that of a thief who climbed the wall and knocked on the window to invade a house, yet after searching through the boxes for a long time, he couldn't find a single penny and could only curse.

However, Yuei Vu said that I am poor, what should I do?

Do you blame me for not being able to use rare cards?

"If that's the case, don't blame me." Pandora put his finger on the next card in the deck, and said gloomily, "New rules, if you lose, I will take your entire deck of cards and your Duel Disk! My turn, draw!"

He added a new card to his hand, raised his eyes, and stared at Yuei Vu.

"Just to let you know, I have the highest-level magician in the dueling monster world, a top-level monster that a third-rate duelist like you may never see in a lifetime!"

He took out another card from his hand and inserted it into the Spell/Trap slot of the Duel Disk.

"I set an S/T card on the field, and end my turn."

Yuei Vu was half-kneeling on the ground and heard a hot and cloudy gasp from his nose.

There was a Dark Magician with an attack power of 2500 on the opposite field it didn't sound like it was very high, but for Yuei Vu, whose strongest monster was Sparkman, it was already an insurmountable peak.

In addition, his field was now empty, and he still had only 1500 LP left, while Pandora's LP was almost unscathed. Although according to the standard practice of Yu-Gi-Oh, it was not enough to meet the blood lock conditions (1), it was already unfavorable enough.

However, even in this seemingly inevitable situation, Yuei Vu couldn't help showing a smile.

At this point, his tactics have already succeeded in half.

Of course, he knew that it was almost impossible to beat Pandora with this Normie initial deck. Although he was mentally prepared to "accept even if the mission fails", it was impossible for him to rush over to feed without making any preparations.

To put it simply, there was actually a strategic analysis in the forum for the task of confronting Pandora. All the player needed to prepare in advance was one card, a crucial card that could directly turn the situation around in this duel.

This was not surprising at all. There were forty cards in a deck, and the probability of drawing a specific one of them was actually not high.

The one who could draw whatever they wanted was called Yami Yugi, not Yuei Vu.

But it didn't matter, because although players couldn't use the draw of fate (2), they have their own skills given by the system

Destiny draw.

Destiny draw, commonly known as "D draw" by World Link Online players. It could only be used once in a duel, and could only be triggered when your HP was extremely low or your situation on the field was extremely unfavorable.

After meeting the trigger conditions, in the next Draw Phase players could choose to activate the skill "Destiny draw" when drawing cards, and could draw the "fate card" that was set in advance when building a deck.

It was worth emphasizing that the only card that could be drawn by this skill was the card set by the player in advance. So when setting the fate card, players tended to prefer to choose a more general-purpose powerful card, which could turn the table with one card in most bad situations.

For example, the holy power of the Knights of Hanoi

(A slang for Mirror Force (Trap Card When an opponent's monster declares an attack: Destroy all your opponent's Attack Position monsters.))

However, cards like that must be of top rarity.

Yuei Vu definitely did not have one in his initial deck.

He set another card, a strategy card specially prepared for this mission.

"Draw!"

After Yuei Vu drew the card, he only glanced at it and added it to his hand.

"I summon Element HERO Burstinatrix!"

A ball of flame was released in the field, and the tall and hot long-haired heroine leaped out.

[Element HERO Burstinatrix, ATK 1200]

"Huh? Instead of strengthening the defense, do you take the initiative to attack?"  
Pandora began to sing.

"I can't beat the shit out of you without attacking."

Emmmwhy did this conversation seem familiar?

(Note: The voice actor of Pandora in the Yu-Gi-Oh! DM animation is Takehito Koyasu, the same as Dio Brando in "JOJO's Bizarre Adventure")

Pandora's mouth twitched, smiled contemptuously, and then pressed a button on the Duel Disk.

"Although I don't know what you want to do But at this moment, I activate the spell card- Beckon to the Dark!"

The folded card on Pandora's field stood up after swiping the ground. It was a green spell card There was no Quick-Play icon next to the word on the spell card.

Nani? Activate a Spell Card on your opponent's turn???

According to the Master Rules of Yu-Gi-Oh, spell cards could only be activated during the main phase of one's own turn, and only Quick-Play spell cards could be activated during the opponent's turn.

Oh, this was the era of Yu-Gi-Oh DMs, so sorry.

In the DM animation, Yami Yugi could also activate Brain Control, Change of Heart and Monster Reborn during the Battle Phase of the opponent's turn.

Back to the current duel: A thick black cloud began to appear over the field, accompanied by scarlet lightning. The giant claws of the devil protruded from the depths of the clouds, and could not help but grabbed Burstinatrix on Yuei Vu's field and dragged her into the depths of darkness.

"I set an S/T card on the field, and end my turn."

"That's all you can do? Sure enough, you are just an inexperienced duelist. Well, it's only natural. Facing my Dark Magician, ordinary duelists would never have won."

"My turn! This is your last turn too!"

After he drew the card, the whole person became more and more floating.

The total attack power of the two Dark Magicians was five thousand, and there was not a single monster on the Yuei Vu's field that can only act as a wall.

But instead of panicking, he showed a successful smile at this time and even wanted to say "I'm not so sure as you" to show off But considering that he was not the protagonist, forget it.

"Don't worry," Yuei Vu raised his head and smiled strangely at Pandora, "Before your Dark Magicians attack, I have to activate this card"

"Open the set card: Spell Card Last Day of Witch! "

TL's note:

1. "Blood lock" is slang for YGO's main character's ability to draw/gain the right card in desperate conditions (usually having less than 1000 LP). Famous examples are Yusaku's "Storm Access" or Yuma's Number C39: Utopia Ray.

2. Although they're basically the same, to make the translation less confused, I'll use "draw of fate" for NPC's skill and "destiny draw" for player's skill.

And when I use "Destiny Draw" (capital letters), it refers to this card:
