### Chapter 1161: Riding Duel

Speed Spell, a type of Spell Card dedicated to Riding Duel, was also the only type of Spell Card allowed to be used in Riding Duel.

Normal Spell Cards, Quick-Play Spell Cards, Equip Spell Cards, Continuous Spell Cards, and Field Spell Cards used in ordinary duels, all were prohibited under the rules of Riding Duel.

Speed Spells were anime-original cards, and none of them were real cards. Its main feature was that it must be used in conjunction with the "Speed Counter" held by the player.

In the Riding Duel, both riders would automatically gain 1 "Speed Counter" during the Standby Phase. This counter was actually similar to what was called "mana" in other card games. Players must have the corresponding mana to activate the corresponding Speed Spell.

In the current "Speed World", each time a player took damage, their Speed Counters would be reduced by 1 for every 1000 points of damage they took.

The Speed Counter would also directly affect the speed of the D-Wheel in the Riding Duel, which was why the law enforcement officers would also use the "Riding Duel" method to capture criminals.

As long as the fugitive was damaged and their Speed Counter was reduced, the D-Wheel would be forced to slow down. And if the LP value of one party in the duel reached zero, the perpetual motion machine of the D-Wheel would be forced to stop, and the D-Wheel would automatically be braked.

In the world of 5DS, of course, it was necessary to participate in the Riding Duel. But if Spell Cards couldn't be used, most of the decks that Yusei Vu has held so far may be scrapped.

Let's not talk about anything else, just his iconic "HERO" deck. The lack of cards such as Polymerization, Miracle Fusion, Vision Fusion, and even Mask Change was undoubtedly epic weakening for heroes, making this deck have no combat effectiveness.

The same was true for other fusion decks, ritual decks, etc. If ordinary Spell Cards couldn't be used, these decks would all lose their combat effectiveness.

In this new era of 5DS, the preferred deck naturally should be based on Synchro.

From this point of view, it was not unreasonable that everyone in the 5DS animation played Synchro.

Yusei Vu did have a Synchro deck, that was the "Six Samurai" series, but was actually not very good. Because the core of the deck, "Gateway of the Six", was a Continuous Spell, thus it was also banned under the rules of Riding Duel. Without it, the Six Samurai was equivalent to having one of their legs cut off.

However, he unexpectedly discovered that his system interface seemed to have access rights to Yusei's Duel Disk and the deck it carried.

It seemed that they were now in a certain team-up state. As a teammate, he could also adjust Yusei's deck through the system, and even give Yusei some things in his card pool.

Yuei Vu thought quickly, and then suddenly said: "By the way, Yusei, how about showing me your deck? Maybe I can help you adjust it?"

"Okay, then I'll leave it to you, Mr. Yuei Vu."

At this time, being famous had its benefits. After all, his reputation as the first-generation Duel King was well-known to everyone. Any duelist who could get a little advice from him would benefit a lot, and almost no one could refuse.

Originally, Yuei Vu, who was in this ghost-like state, could not touch any physical objects. However, after selecting the "Edit companion's deck" option in the system, he seemed to be able to touch Yusei's deck.

While Yusei was riding his bike, Yuei Vu roughly browsed his deck.

As expected, there were a lot of unclear-meaning things stuffed in it...

But it's not strange, there were always some unclear-meaning things in the decks of the protagonists of all generations.

Some cards had very stringent activation conditions or could only work in specific situations. Some cards not only worked in specific situations only, but the effect was also weak...

Yusei had a famous saying: Every card has its value, and a true duelist should be able to show his strength no matter what kind of card he uses.

This was very cool, and Yuei Vu really wanted to agree. But as a card player who has been beaten by all kinds of meta decks in the real card environment, Yuei Vu couldn't agree with this point of view even with his little conscience.

As the saying goes "a good cook cannot cook without rice". No matter how powerful a duelist was, he would never win the top position with a whole deck of Normies. This was an iron rule.

Oh, if you reached the "let there be effect" level, that's another matter.

Unfortunately, it was obvious that Yusei Fudo, who was still in the novice village stage, was far from reaching that level.

Moreover, although Yusei, as the protagonist, had a basic skill in divine drawing, it may be because the producer was afraid that too many elements of the protagonist template would cause the audience to fatigue. Therefore, as the third-generation protagonist, Yusei's skill in divine drawing was actually not as good as Yugi and Judai.

So it was still necessary for Brother Crabhead to change the deck construction honestly.

Yuei Vu was adjusting the deck while continuing to communicate with Brother Crabhead about the situation of this era. At this time, a shrill siren suddenly caught up from behind.

Followed by the hum of the D-Wheel engine... was a rough and powerful voice.

"Hey, scum of the Satellite area, don't be so anxious to leave!"

Ushio rode the police D-Wheel to catch up, and the uncle with a shoe horn-like face had a sinister and hideous smile.

"It's this guy again." Yusei frowned.

"The Field Spell 'Speed World' is activated!"

The high-speed field unfolded with Ushio's D-Wheel as the center, and locked onto Yusei's speeding D-Wheel from a distance. The sky instantly turned into a deep dark color, and the surrounding streets and buildings seemed to be frozen, and the whole world was dragged into the high-speed world.

Speed World, a Field Spell for Riding Duels. Once activated, it cannot leave the field, the effect cannot be negated, and new Field Spells cannot be activated.

Yusei's D-Wheel was also forcibly slowed down, and the speed dropped significantly.

"This is troublesome, Mr. Yuei Vu." Yusei said seriously, "We are forced to enter a Riding Duel. The speed of the D-Wheel will be limited by the 'Speed Counter'.

If we don't win the duel, we can't speed up to get rid of the pursuit."

"Then just win it."

Yuei Vu said easily, and at the same time, he had completed the deck adjustment and stuffed this deck back into the duel disk on Yusei's D-Wheel.

"Okay, although time is a bit rushed, let's do it this way for now." Yuei Vu clapped his hands, "Come on, let this police guy experience the so-called strength gap again."

Chapter 1163: Crabhead, You Have Changed

[Gate Blocker, DEF 2000] x2

Two walls appeared in front of him again, and the way ahead was still blocked. And with two more barriers, Raiden couldn't continue to attack.

Yusei drew two more cards: "Set two cards, I end my turn."

"Hahahaha, you're at a loss when facing the blockade of the Gate Blocker, right? I don't know where you got some weird cards from, but garbage is just garbage after all, just surrender!"

Ushio had a standard villain face, and the mocking smile was almost like "I'm a bad guy" was written on his face.

Ignoring Ushio's taunt, Yuei Vu reminded: "When a 'Lightsworn' monster is on the field, you must send cards from your deck to the graveyard at the end of the turn."

Yusei understood: "The effect of 'Raiden, Hand of the Lightsworn' – during my End Phase, send two cards from the top of my deck to the graveyard."

In this way, just with Raiden, four cards were thrown to the graveyard in one turn.

At this moment, Yusei suddenly felt that he had understood why senior Yuei Vu would add this system to his deck.

Yusei's "Junk" and "Synchron" series had a common feature, that was, they were extremely dependent on graveyard resources. In the early stages of a duel when the graveyard was empty, his deck often couldn't do anything because of a lack of resources.

However, the "Lightsworn" system that Yuei Vu gave him has the highest speed of mass graveyard accumulation, which can accumulate a large amount of resources for his graveyard in the shortest time.

Not only that, the Lightsworn system itself had good stats among low-level monsters and also had a good field-clearing ability, which was indeed a good match with Yusei's deck.

"Then it's my turn, draw!" Ushio said.

[Ushio, SPC 2 → 3]

[Yusei, SPC 1]

It's already the third turn, but because of the blockade of "Gate Blocker", Yusei's Speed Counter was still 1. With only one Speed Counter, no Speed Spell could be activated.

Not only that, but the more serious problem was that the Speed Counter would also affect the speed of the D-Wheel from a physical level.

Because the Speed Counter gap has been gradually widened, Ushio, who was originally chasing behind, has caught up little by little. If this continued, it would not be long before he would catch up with Yusei's D-Wheel.

For the pursued, this was undoubtedly very bad.

"Activate the trap card 'Reckless Greed!'" Ushio turned over the backfield card, "In exchange for skipping the next two Draw Phases, draw two cards!"

Ushio glanced at the backfield card of Yusei and smiled contemptuously.

The set card in his backfield... it's probably that "Scrap-Iron Scarecrow" again, right?

After the previous two encounters, Ushio thought he had read through the duel of this Satellite Zone bastard.

This guy always plays the same tricks. He summons "Speed Warrior" at the beginning, and then summons "Junk Synchron" to tune with "Speed Warrior" in the next turn, and Synchro Summons the Synchro Monster "Junk Warrior".

The set card in his backfield is either a trap to revive "Speed Warrior" from the graveyard, or a "Scrap-Iron Scarecrow" that can negate the opponent's attack.

Although I don't know why the opponent's starting monster has become a meaningless Lightsworn or something, it doesn't matter.

Ushio believed in his instincts, the card in the backfield must be Scrap-Iron Scarecrow!

"The effect of the 'Montage Dragon' in the hand!" Ushio raised a card in his hand, "Montage Dragon must be Special Summoned from my hand by sending 3 other monsters from my hand to the Graveyard!

I send one Level 8 'Masked Beast Des Gardius' and two Level 5 'Handcuff Dragons' to the graveyard! Show up—

—Montage Dragon!!!"

The three monster cards rotated around Ushio's D-Wheel, and then turned into golden rays and flew up. A beam of light fell from the sky, and a three-headed dragon with bared fangs and claws fell with it!

Montage Dragon was summoned!

It appeared in the first episode of "Yu-Gi-Oh! 5DS", also used by Ushio Tetsu. At that time, Ushio did not have a Synchro Monster in his hand, and this "Montage Dragon" was his trump card!

"It appears, the Montage Dragon." Yusei said seriously, "When I first met Ushio, he used this trump card. It is a monster with very terrible power, and it should not be underestimated!"

Yuei Vu: "..."

Four for one, a high-attack Normie. Well, in terms of card disadvantage, it really deserves to be called an "ace monster".

If you work harder, you may surpass the Elemental HERO Ultraman...

"The attack power of the Montage Dragon becomes the combined original Levels of the sent monsters x 300. The monsters I used to summon the Montage Dragon have a total level of 18!

So the attack power of the Montage Dragon is..."

**[Montage Dragon, ATK ? → ATK 5400]**

"Attack power 5400!" Ushio laughed, "Hahahaha, how about it? I have become stronger after the previous duel!

This time, even if you summon that Junk Warrior again, it will be useless. Even that Synchro Monster is no match for the current 'Montage Dragon!'"

Indeed, in the first episode of 5DS, Yusei defeated Ushio's Montage Dragon with Junk Warrior. At that time, the attack power of Montage Dragon was only 3000. The effect of Junk Warrior allowed it to add the total attack power of Level 2 or lower monsters on the field to its own attack power, so it easily surpassed the dragon.

But this time, with more than 5000 ATK, it was obviously unlikely to have another classic re-engraving and rely on Junk Warrior to punch it.

However...

Yuei Vu had a blank expression: "Yusei, send it to hell."

"Got it, Senior Yuei Vu!"

Although he didn't quite get what this "hell" was, Yusei also understood what he meant, and immediately waved his hand: "Open the set card: Trap Card – Floodgate Trap Hole!"

When the opponent Summons a monster: Change that monster to face-down Defense Position. Monsters changed to face-down Defense Position by this effect cannot change their battle positions!"

"Puff!"

Senior Ushio spat out a mouthful of blood.

Fuck, what the hell is this?

Where is your Scrap-Iron Scarecrow? How did the card in the backfield become such a disgusting thing?

Senior Ushio was dumbfounded when he saw that his ace dragon, which made a luxurious appearance in a four-for-one exchange, was turned over before it even had time to stand firmly on its heels.

He stared blankly at the Montage Dragon that was covered. His lost eyes seemed to say–

"Then I activate the Speed Spell 'Angel Baton'!" Ushio shouted, "It can only be activated when I have 2 or more Speed Counters. Draw 2 cards, then discard 1 card!"

The hand cards were changed, and Ushio glanced at Yusei with a cold face.

"Do you think you can stop me at this level? Now, I have already taken the duel a step further! Watch out!"

I summon the Tuner Monster 'Jutte Fighter'!"

[Jutte Fighter, ATK 700]

"Tuner Monster..." Yusei thought, "Is it coming?"

"Level 2, Tuner Monster 'Jutte Fighter'! Level 4, 'Gate Blocker'! Tuning!"

[2+4=6]

"Synchro Summoning is not your specialty, Satellite bastard!" Ushio Tetsu shouted loudly, "Come, Level 6–

–Goyo Guardian!!!"

Chapter 1164: OTK!

The "Goyo" deck was a police deck in the 5DS setting, a hunting deck used exclusively by the police officers of the Public Security Bureau.

Goyo Guardian was the trump card in this deck. It was even banned in the early days of Synchro, and was not released until its summoning conditions were modified many years later.

[Goyo Guardian, ATK 2800]

"It's that Synchro monster again," Yusei said.

"Heh, let's review the power of this force again!" Ushio shouted, "Battle! 'Goyo Guardian', attack 'Raideen, Hand of the Lightsworn'!"

The Goyo Guardian swung the chain in his hand and pierced Raideen's body with a "chi" sound. The latter groaned miserably, and his body exploded like glass.

[Yusei, LP 4000 → LP 3100]

The virtual touch of the Riding Duel rushed through the entire D-Wheel. Yusei groaned, and the D-Wheel shook violently. Ushio took this opportunity to catch up from behind.

"Hahaha, it's not over yet!" Ushio shouted, "Next is the effect of 'Goyo Guardian'! When this card destroys an opponent's monster by battle and sends it to the GY: I can Special Summon that monster to my field in Defense Position!"

Goyo Guardian swung the chain in his hand, and with a wave of his arm, the chain immediately shot out through the air and pierced into the dark vortex that opened on the ground.

After a moment, the chain tied up the dusty Raideen and dragged him back to the side of Ushio's D-Wheel.

[Raideen, Hand of the Lightsworn, DEF 1000]

Goyo Guardian, although it was a Level 6 Synchro Monster, had a high attack power of 2800 points that did not match its star level. In addition, its summoning conditions were simple and it was highly versatile in the early Synchro environment, so it has won a place for itself in the ban list with honor.

"Heh, in front of the powerful monster 'Goyo Guardian' exclusive for police, a little thief like you has no room to fight back! I end my turn."

"My turn!" Yusei drew a card.

At the same time, the Field Spell "Speed World" would place a Speed Counter for each player. But because "Gate Blocker" was on the field, Yusei's Speed Counter should not be increased.

However...

[Ushio, SPC 3 → 4]

[Yusei, SPC 1 → 4]

Ushio: "???"

What? Are you cheating?

You secretly increased the Speed Counter and thought I didn't see it?

Then he looked at the field information displayed on the screen on the D-Wheel and found that Yusei's backcourt had an extra trap.

"That card..."

Yusei explained: "Trap Card 'Slip Stream'. This card can only be activated when the opponent activates a Speed Spell while I have fewer Speed Counters than the opponent. During the Standby Phase of my next turn, the amount of my Speed Counters becomes equal to that of the opponent's!" (Animation card)

"When a Speed Spell is activated..." Ushio's face changed slightly, "Could it be that it was the moment I activated the 'Angel Wand' just now?"

"That's right," Yusei said, "At that moment, the trap was already activated. Therefore, in the preparation phase of this round, our Speed Counters became the same!"

Yuei Vu: "..."

It appeared, Crab Brother's secret technique of "digging a trap without talking".

Compared with the protagonists of the previous two generations, Yusei was obviously a relatively taciturn type, even when playing cards. In the animation, he had secretly activated a trap more than once at a certain point, but he did not say anything or explain it after it was activated.

The opponent may be too immersed in his duel, or just blocked by the special effects of the stereoscopic projection, and was often surprised when the trap took effect, saying, "Fuck, when did you dig the trap?"

Then Brother Crab would explain confidently: I had already activated it when you did something before, but you just didn't notice it.

So despite Brother Crab's honest appearance, in fact, this person was very black-bellied, and he was simply a natural trap master.

When other people were playing the game, they would at least shout "You have activated my trap card!" when digging a trap, and then patiently explain to you with a smile how you made a mistake.

But Brother Crab would not do that. Brother Crab was the typical "make a fortune in silence", he had to wait until you fell into the trap before telling you that there was a trap here.

The Speed Counter increased, and the D-Wheel speeded up accordingly. Yusei stepped on the accelerator, and the D-Wheel accelerated with a pleasant roar, once again leaving Ushio who was about to catch up behind.

Ushio gritted his teeth unwillingly: "You are a nagging trash..."

"You are the one who is nagging." Yusei said, "But that's it!"

"Yusei, use 'Rush Warrior'." Yuei Vu said.

"Understand." Yusei said, "I will activate the effect of 'Rush Warrior' in the graveyard! Banish this card from my GY, then target 1 'Synchron' monster in my GY; add it to my hand.

The card I want to add to my hand is 'Nitro Synchron!'"

Yusei drew a card that popped out of the GY.



"I Normal Summon 'Nitro Synchron!'"

[Nitro Synchron, ATK 300]

"Then, when there is a Tuner monster on my field, this card can be Special Summoned directly from my hand." Yusei showed another card in his hand, "Come, Boost Warrior!"

[Boost Warrior, DEF 200]

"Level 2, Tuner monster 'Nitro Synchron'! Level 1, 'Boost Warrior'! Level 4, 'Wulf, Lightsworn Beast'! Tuning!"

Ushio's face changed slightly: "Three monsters!?"

As he spoke, Nitro Synchron had turned into a green halo, and Boost Warrior and Lightsworn Beast turned into five shining stars under the halo, arranged in a straight line, and the light curtain poured down.

"Gathering thoughts become a new power! Become the path that lights the way!"

[2+1+4=7]

"Synchro Summon!" Yusei shouted, "Burn up, Level 7–

–Nitro Warrior!!!"

The synchro starlight was blasted away, and the green armored warrior flew out from the light curtain, and the engine in the armor roared like a beast!

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 2800]

Ushio scowled: "Did you summon another Synchro Monster with attack power equivalent to Goyo Guardian?"

"When 'Nitro Synchron' is sent to the Graveyard for the Synchro Summon of a 'Nitro' monster, I draw a card."

Looking at the card Yusei drew, Yuei Vu couldn't help but smile slightly.

Although Yusei hadn't left the novice village yet, he was the protagonist with the Yu- prefix after all. He was not ambiguous about the cards he should draw at the critical moment.

Yusei directly played the card he drew: "Activate the Speed Spell 'Speed Energy' from my hand! It can only be activated when I have 2 or more Speed Counters.

Select 1 face-up monster on the field. It gains 200 ATK for each Speed Counter I have until the End Phase!

I have 4 Speed Counters, so the attack power of Nitro Warrior increases by 800 points this turn!"

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 2800 → ATK 3600]

"Then, there is the effect of Nitro Warrior itself!" Yusei continued, "Once during each of my turns, if I activate a Spell Card, this card gains 1000 ATK during the next attack this turn!"

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 3600 → ATK 4600]

"Attack power 4600!?"

"Battle!" Yusei waved his hand, "Use 'Nitro Warrior' to attack 'Goyo Guardian!'"

The engine roared from behind the Nitro Warrior, and the green Warrior flew out of the air, punching down at the trump card that Ushio was proud of.

"And at this moment, the effect of the 'Rush Warrior' in my hand is activated!" Yusei continued, "If a 'Warrior' Synchro Monster I control battles an opponent's monster: I can send this card from my hand to the GY; my battling monster's ATK becomes double its current ATK during that damage calculation!"

"What!?" Ushio was stunned.

The attack power is doubled?

Doesn't that mean...

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 4600 → ATK 9200]

"Attack power 9200!?"

As a small law enforcement officer, how could Ushio have seen such a spectacular scene? Facing the Nitro Warrior's punch, which was like a tidal wave, the whole person was petrified on the spot.

"Uhhhhhh!!!"

[Ushio, LP 4000 → LP 0]

The Nitro Warrior's punch landed, adding another streak of defeats to Ushio's challenge to Yusei. The police D-Wheel stopped with a sharp brake sound and was left far behind by Yusei, along with Ushio's unwilling roar.

After finding a shabby old classroom and sitting down, Yusei finally breathed a sigh of relief at this time.

For him, today may indeed be a long night. In this short night, he first experienced a thrilling chase with the sheriff and then rushed out of the Satellite area along the garbage disposal pipe at the critical moment.

It's exactly the same as the traditional Shadow Game.

Now he began to think that maybe Z-ONE's technology in this area was borrowed from the Duel Link developed by President Kaiba in his early years.

"Mr. Yuei Vu?" Yusei asked tentatively.

"Oh, nothing, I'm just doing some tests."

Yuei Vu smiled, then glanced at the duel domain unfolding around him, and his mind moved.

"By the way, since the duel domain has been activated, why not let me give it a try, Yusei... your current strength as a duelist."

"Okay, then come on." Yuei Vu said, "It's a good opportunity to see how well you master the new deck."

"Duel!" x2

[Yuei Vu, LP 4000]

[Yusei, LP 4000]

"I'm the first to go, draw!"

Yusei didn't hesitate and took the first move directly.

He quickly scanned the six cards in his hand, and then quickly drew three of them in one breath, sweeping his arms.

"I set a monster on the field!" He said, "Then set two S/T cards, and my turn is over!"

A set monster and two set S/T cards...

Although Yusei hasn't trained Brother Crabhead, he was really more talented than Judai in terms of using traps.

After all, even the untrained Brother Crabhead in the original animation was a trap master and was very good at using layers of traps to clearly arrange the opponent.

Many duelists who claimed to be veterans thought that they had seen through Brother Crabhead's tactics, but they didn't know that Brother Crabhead had already seen through their thoughts, and in the end, he could always trap these people.

Compared with the protagonists of the previous two generations, Brother Crabhead was an honest man who didn't use BISS, and his divine drawing skill was not so outstanding, but he was quite good at understanding the game and adapting to it.

"Then it's my turn, draw."

Yusei directly showed two cards in one breath.

"Activate the Ritual Spell 'Chaos Form!'" Yusei said, "Tribute the Level 7 'Dark Magician' in my hand! Ritual Summon!"

The highest-level magician is baptized by chaos and descends with a brand new attitude——  
—— Magician of Chaos!"

The chaotic light column burst out, the magic array opened, and the magician who merged the power of light and darkness slowly rose from it. He had dark blue skin, blond hair, and a light blue magic array slowly rotated at the end of the staff.

[Magician of Chaos, ATK 2500]

"Is it the long-lost 'Dark Magic' deck?" Yusei became more alert.

The Dark Magic deck, the soul deck that Yugi Muto, who was also the first generation of Duel King, used to conquer the world, was once a legend worshipped by countless duelists.

But later, as time went by and the versions changed, it was gradually lost in the 5DS era and only existed in legends.

"Then I activate the Spell Card 'Bond Between Teacher and Student!'" Yusei continued, "When there is a 'Dark Magician' on the field, I can special summon a 'Dark Magician Girl' from the deck!"

And when 'Magician of Chaos' is on the field, its name can be treated as 'Dark Magician'."

A card popped out of the deck and was directly slapped on the duel disk by Yusei.

"According to the effect of 'Bond Between Teacher and Student', special summon 'Dark Magician Girl' from the deck!"

The pink magic circle opened, and the innocent magical girl rushed out with a "Heya", happily waving to Yusei.

Yusei was stunned for a moment and seemed to think it was a bit rude to ignore it, so he also waved in return.

[Dark Magician Girl, ATK 2000]

"The subsequent effect of 'Bond Between Teacher and Student'! I set the Spell Card 'Dark Magic Attack' from the deck on the field." Yusei waved his hand, and a face-up card immediately appeared on the field.

Then he pointed at the black-clad magician on the field.

"At this moment, the effect of Magician of Chaos is activated!" He continued, "When Magician of Chaos is on the field and a Spell/Trap Card or effect is activated, once per turn, I can target 1 card on the field and destroy it.

I will destroy the face-down monster on your field!"

The black-robed magician raised his staff slowly and chanted a spell in his mouth, like a spell to erase. The surging power of dark magic condensed into a ball of light, as if a cannonball hit the face-down card, and the dark flames immediately burned and destroyed it.

The set monster was "Ryko, Lightsworn Hunter".

When flipped face up, Ryko could select a card on the field and destroy it, and send three cards from the top of your deck to the graveyard.

This effect was really powerful in the early stage. Even if you looked at the entire Yu-Gi-Oh card pool at that time, this was a card with excellent performance.

You should know that the effect description of Ryko was "FLIP: Apply these effects: You can destroy 1 card on the field. Send the top 3 cards of your Deck to the GY". In this description, the text of "destroy 1 card" came after "apply the effect", which meant that this card's effect did not target.

In other words, big monsters who had the resistance "cannot be targeted by card effects" could also be easily solved by this dog.

And on this basis, it could also send three cards on its own to the graveyard. For a deck that relied on graveyard resources, such as Yusei's, this was also a very useful effect.

Because the effect of the dog could be triggered as long as it was "flipped", it meant that whether the controller actively flipped it or it was passively flipped by the opponent's attack, the effect would always be triggered, which was very useful.

Unfortunately, Yusei didn't attack but used the effect of Magician of Chaos to blow up Ryko in the Set state, without giving it a chance to use its ability.

"Nice try." Yusei smiled, "But I helped you adjust the deck, do you think I would not be on guard against the Lightsworn?"

Yusei: "..."

The Lightsworn Hunter was indeed a monster with a good defensive performance at the beginning, but Brother Crabhead's defense line was obviously more than this. The two set cards in the backcourt were also worth noting.

Of course, they would be unusable soon.

Yuei Vu snapped his fingers: "Then activate the card that is just set onto the field! Spell Card – Dark Magic Attack!"

The backcourt flipped, the Spell Card stood up, the dark electric current jumped, the storm of magic surged, and the dark magic was gathered into the raised staff of the Chaos Mage as if being pulled.

"'Dark Magic Attack' can only be activated when there is a 'Dark Magician' on the field – as I just said, when 'Dark Magician of Chaos' is on the field, the card name is treated as 'Dark Magician'."

Yuei Vu raised his hand.

"Destroy all Spells and Traps on the opponent's field!"

Yusei: "!"

After destroying the front field, the back field is next?

It's only the first turn, is Mr. Yuei Vu ready for an OTK?

Chapter 1167: No Working Overtime Today

In fact, from the duel structure in the early stage of Yu-Gi-Oh 5DS, it could be seen that although this part has been separated from the previous two generations in terms of timeline for a long time, and while the duel monsters had officially entered the Synchro Era, the strength of the duelists had not actually made a qualitative leap.

Although the overall level of the passerby duelists in 5DS was definitely stronger than the previous two generations, it was just a bit.

For operations like Yuei Vu that directly cleared the front and back fields in the first turn and depleted a full 4000 LP in one wave, it was rare even in this era.

Of course, Yusei Fudo was not an ordinary duelist.

The torrent of Dark Magic Attack pushed across Yusei's field, and the two set cards in the backfield were opened at the same time. One of them was Yusei's iconic life-saving card "Scrap-Iron Scarecrow".

But the other one was "Limiter Overload".

"Trap Card 'Limiter Overload', when sent to the Graveyard, will Special Summon a 'Speed Warrior' from the hand, deck, and graveyard!"

Yusei drew a card that popped out automatically from the deck.

"Show up, Speed Warrior!"

[Speed Warrior, DEF 400]



"Then I enter the Battle Phase." Yuei Vu said, "First, Dark Magician Girl, attack the 'Speed Warrior!'"

The Dark Magician Girl flew up lightly on the pink magic circle, and waved her little hand, and the magic wave broke through the air and blew the Speed Warrior into pieces.

Poor overworked warrior, although he had to work overtime every day in Yusei's hands, he could at least survive one more turn every time he appeared. Today he didn't even have a chance to attack and was killed before he could even stand firmly.

"Magician of Chaos," Yuei Vu continued, "Attack directly."

The black magician in a vest flexibly turned the staff in his hand, and the dark magic hit the enemy in the face. The power of the black magic of chaos exploded on Yusei's face, and the virtual impact made him stagger back half a step.

[Yusei, LP 4000 → LP 1500]

Yusei steadied his feet and took a deep breath.

I lost most of my LP in an instant, but at least I avoided a killing combo.

As expected of a legendary duelist, he really didn't leave any gaps...

"You blocked well." Yuei Vu smiled slightly.

"Set two cards, I end my turn."

Unlike the situation of Jellyfish Head back then, when he first met Jellyfish Head from the future, he left a deep impression on Yuei Vu on the first night. It was for this reason that Yuei Vu later made up his mind to cultivate Jellyfish Head well and vowed to teach him the evil of the human heart and the cruelty of society.

But Yusei's first impression of him was quite good. Brother Crabhead was not only very polite at the beginning but also brought a gift. Yuei Vu was very optimistic about Brother Crabhead at that time and thought that this child was a good talent.

So now he was also happy to give Brother Crabhead room to play.

"My turn!"

Yusei's comprehension was indeed good, and he quickly understood the role of this new system that Yuei Vu added to his deck.

"Activate the Spell Card 'Charge of the Light Brigade'. Send the top 3 cards of my Deck to the GY; add 1 Level 4 or lower 'Lightsworn' monster from my Deck to my hand."

Yusei drew the top three cards from his deck in one go, discarded them all to the graveyard, and then drew a card that popped out of his deck.

"I add 'Raiden, Hand of the Lightsworn' to my hand."

He then showed Raiden and another card in his hand.

"Spell Card 'Solar Recharge'. Discard 1 'Lightsworn' monster; draw 2 cards, then send the top 2 cards of my Deck to the GY!"

Raiden, who had just been retrieved, was immediately discarded, and two new cards were drawn into his hand.

"And, after that, send two more cards from the deck to the graveyard."

With only two cards, Yusei drew cards crazily, greatly compressed the deck's thickness, and accumulated a considerable amount of resources in the graveyard.

This was the role of the Lightsworn – compressing the deck, accumulating graveyard resources, and helping Yusei's deck to speed up.

"And the card just sent to the graveyard is 'Makyura the Destructor'. During the turn this card is sent to the Graveyard, I can activate Trap Cards from my hand!"

Makyura the Destructor had been Yusei's favorite since the earliest days and later became Judai's favorite.

Needless to say, for a Lightsworn deck whose main feature was to feed the graveyard en masse, Yusei certainly couldn't forget to give this card to Brother Crabhead.

And Brother Crabhead himself was a duelist who was good at using a variety of traps to fight, so Yusei believed he would definitely like this card soon.

"Activate the Trap Card 'Hope for Escape' from my hand!" A Trap Card flipped over next to Yusei, "This card can only be activated by paying 1000 Life Points when my Life Points are lower than the opponent's.

For every 1000 life points difference between both parties, I can draw a card from the deck!" (anime effect)

[Yusei, LP 1500 → LP 500]

"In this way, the difference in our life points is 3500!" Yusei said, "Therefore, I draw three cards from the deck!"

With the new three cards in hand, Yusei has already played the next card: "Activate the Continuous Trap 'Thousand Crisscross' from my hand!" (anime card)

The trap card flipped over next to Yusei, and a shining white cross appeared above his head.

"This card can only be activated when my LP drops below 1000." Yusei said, "After activation, I have up to three chances to restore my LP to 1000 when my LP changes!"

[Yusei, LP 500 → LP 1000]

"Then I Normal Summon 'Junk Synchron'!"

The short warrior in orange armor shouted and jumped onto the field again.

"Junk Synchron's effect – When this card is Normal Summoned: I can target 1 Level 2 or lower monster in my GY; Special Summon that target in Defense Position, but negate its effects.

Come on, Speed Warrior!"

The hardworking duo, as expected, have a role in every game of Brother Crabhead.

[Speed Warrior, DEF 400]

"Next, the effect of 'Quillbolt Hedgehog' in the Graveyard is activated." Yusei said, "If Quillbolt Hedgehog is in the Graveyard and there is a Tuner monster on my field, I can Special Summon it directly from the Graveyard.

Come on, Quillbolt Hedgehog!"

[Quillbolt Hedgehog, DEF 800]

"Level 3 Tuner 'Junk Synchron', plus Level 2 'Quillbolt Hedgehog', tuning!

Gathering stars call forth a new power! Become the path that lights the way!"

[3+2=5]

"Synchro Summon! Show up—

—Level 5, Junk Warrior!"

The shining starlight turned into an open road, and Brother Crabhead's early model worker No. 3, Junk Warrior, made a grand appearance!

Yuei Vu was not surprised by this.

After all, Stardust Dragon was in Jack's hand in the early stage of the animation, thus Junk Warrior was basically equivalent to Yusei's trump card, and he would definitely appear in every duel.

"Junk Warrior's attack power will increase the total attack power of monsters below level 2 on the field." Yusei said, "Accept the power from the Speed Warrior! Power of Fellows!"

[Junk Warrior, ATK 2300 → ATK 3200]

"As expected, Junk Warrior appeared."

Yuei Vu smiled lightly and then paused for a moment.

"But although I feel sorry for him, he must leave early today."

He snapped his fingers.

"Open the set card: Trap Card – Magician Navigation!" Yuei Vu said, "Special Summon 1 'Dark Magician' from my hand, then Special Summon 1 Level 7 or lower DARK Spellcaster monster from my Deck!

I Special Summon the 'Dark Magician' in my hand and the 'Magician of Dark Illusion' in my deck!"

Yusei's eyes moved slightly: "Summon two magicians at once... no, Senior Yuei Vu's purpose is not there."

"That's right."

Yuei Vu smiled and expressed his satisfaction with Yusei's comprehension.

"At the moment when 'Magician Navigation' was activated, the effect of Magician of Chaos was also triggered." Yuei Vu said, "Once per turn, a Spell/Trap Card or effect is activated, I can destroy a card on the field."

He pointed to Yusei's field.

"So get off work early today, Junk Warrior!"

Chapter 1168: Burn Up, Nitro Warrior!

The magic array was activated, and two magicians leaped out one after another, occupying a piece of open space on Yusei Vu's field.

[Dark Magician, ATK 2500]

[Magician of Dark Illusion, DEF 2500]

At the same time, the Magician of Chaos' ability was triggered, and the dark magic power shot out from the tip of his staff, blowing through the thick armor of the Junk Warrior.

Poor Junk Warrior didn't even stand firm today, and he was turned into pieces with the explosion.

On the other hand, Yusei Vu's field lineup became more and more luxurious. At this moment, four magicians had already appeared, almost filling up his field.

Yusei looked a little solemn.

Indeed, Junk Warrior was basically his trump card in the early stage, helping him win victory after victory. The fact that Junk Warrior was pitted as soon as it appeared was a bit hurtful to Yusei now.

But he didn't give up yet.

"Then the effect of 'Quickdraw Synchron' in my hand is activated." Yusei showed another card, "This card can be Special Summoned directly from the hand by sending 1 monster from my hand to the GY!"

[Quickdraw Synchron, DEF 1400]

"Quickdraw Synchron can be used as a substitute material for any 'Synchron' monster when performing a Synchro Summon." Yusei said, "I'm going to use 'Quickdraw Synchron' to replace 'Nitro Synchro' for a Synchro Summon!"

Level 5 Tuner 'Quickdraw Synchron', Level 2 'Speed Warrior', tuning!"

The Quickdraw Synchron, dressed like a mechanical cowboy, fired two shots, and then transformed into five green rings, trapping Speed Warrior in the center.

**【5+2=7】**

"Gathering thoughts become a new power! Become the path that lights the way!"

Fudo Yusei raised his right arm.

"Synchro Summon! Burn up—

Level 7, Nitro Warrior!!!"

The warrior wrapped in green armor flew out, and the fists he swung seemed to be wrapped in green flames.

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 2800]

"Then activate the Equip Spell 'Junk Barrage' and equip it to 'Nitro Warrior!'" Yusei swept his arm, and an equipment card appeared beside him, "When the equipped monster destroys a monster by

battle and sends it to the Graveyard: Inflict damage to the opponent equal to half the destroyed monster's ATK in the Graveyard!"

"Wow." Yusei Vu raised his eyebrows, "And because 'Junk Barrage' is a Spell Card, it will also trigger Nitro Warrior's burst ability, right?"

"That's right!" Yusei nodded, "Once during each of my turns, if I activate a Spell Card, this card gains 1000 ATK during the next attack this turn!"

The combination of Junk Barrage and Nitro Warrior, which had high ATK burst, multiple attacks, and additional finishing damage, was one of Yusei's favorite killing combos in the anime.

Nitro Warrior was the most popular ace monster in Yusei's hand in the entire animation, except for the overworked "Junk Warrior" and the iconic trump card "Stardust Dragon".

Unlike the Junk Warrior, whose defeat rate has skyrocketed since the second appearance, Nitro Warrior has always been the trump card of Brother Crabhead in the early stage. According to statistics, until the 90th episode, Yusei could win the duel immediately whenever he summoned Nitro Warrior.

At the peak of his glory, Nitro Warrior even helped Yusei complete the "One Turn Three Kills", which was a very rare feat in the entire Yu-Gi-Oh series.

It was not until more than 90 episodes later that Nitro Warrior gradually began to be defeated as the animation duel environment accelerated and the enemies became stronger and stronger.

At least at this stage, without Stardust Dragon in his hand, this card should be said to be the strongest monster in Yusei's hand.

"Battle!" Yusei waved his hand, "Nitro Warrior, attack 'Magician of Chaos!'"

Magician of Chaos, not only could be used as a Dark Magician on the field but also could explode a card every turn as long as a Spell or Trap was activated. Whether for clearing the field or interfering, this effect was first-class.

Therefore, he should be the primary target of attack.

"At this moment, the effect of Nitro Warrior is activated." Yusei said, "Because a Spell Card has been activated in this round, the attack power of Nitro Warrior will increase by 1000 when calculating the damage of the first battle!"

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 2800 → ATK 3800]

Magician of Chaos swept across and tried his best to release the black magic circle defense. But the iron fist wrapped in blue flames easily smashed the magic circle with one punch, and the round shield broke like a mirror. The magician also groaned and turned into ashes in the fist force.

This attack would cause 1300 combat damage, plus the additional 1250 effect damage from "Junk Barrage", a total of 2550 damage!

Then, the Nitro Warrior could also turn the defensive Magician of Dark Illusion into Attack Position and hit him again. If it passed, the Nitro Warrior alone could complete an OTK!

This was Yusei's reversal move!

But Yuei Vu was still calm: "Open the set card: Continuous Trap – Spirit Barrier! As long as there is a monster on my field, I take no battle damage."

"But the effect damage must still be effective. The effect of the Equip Spell 'Junk Barrage'!" Yusei waved his hand, "Inflict damage equal to half the destroyed monster's ATK!"

The equipment card glowed, and a scorching shock penetrated Yuei Vu.

[Yuei Vu, LP 4000 → LP 2750]

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 3800 → ATK 2800]

The burst effect of Nitro Warrior only applied to the first battle. When the damage calculation was over, the attack power would return to the original state.

"Nitro Warrior's follow-up effect!" Yusei continued, "If this attacking card destroys an opponent's monster by battle, after damage calculation: I can target 1 face-up Defense Position monster the opponent controls; change that target to Attack Position, then this card can make a second attack in a row on that monster!"

The Magician of Dark Illusion stood up uncontrollably and forcibly released the defensive posture.

[Magician of Dark Illusion, DEF 2500 → ATK 2100]

"Go, Nitro Warrior, additional attack!" Yusei waved his hand.

The green armored warrior rushed out again, with a burning roar behind him. The fist with blue flames smashed the defense of the magic formation, and then burned the Magician of Dark Illusion into ashes.

But the aftershock of the green flame was still blocked by the trap's defense wall.

"Then the effect of 'Junk Barrage' is activated again!" Yusei said, "Deal half the attack power of the destroyed monster as damage!"

The equipment card flipped again, and another ball of hot flame rushed out, hitting Yuei Vu's body, making him retreat half a step.

[Yuei Vu, LP 2750 → LP 1700]

As expected of Mr. Yuei Vu, he even blocked this move...

"Then I activate the Spell Card 'Card of Heaven and Earth' from my hand." Yusei said, "In the turn I summoned a Level 7 or 8 monster, I can draw two cards.

But the drawn cards cannot be used during this turn, and at least one card must be set to the field."  
(manga card)

He drew two cards, and then waved his hand.

"Set two cards, I end my turn."

Chapter 1169: Junk Barrage

"It's my turn, draw."

Yuei Vu calmly showed the card he drew: "Activate the Equip Spell 'Wonder Wand', equip it to 'Dark Magician Girl', and increase the attack power of the equipped monster by 500 points."

[Dark Magician Girl, ATK 2000 → ATK 2500]

The Dark Magician Girl got the new staff, and her face was full of joy at the increase in attack power. But then the girl who saw the staff suddenly seemed to think of something bad, and her smile froze on her face

"Wonder Wand's second effect!" Yuei Vu said, "Send the equipped monster and this card to the graveyard together, and I draw two cards!"

The magic power of the Wonder Wand was released, and the body of the Dark Magician Girl gradually turned into golden light spots and dissipated. The girl pouted her lips, a little unhappy.

I know that every time I get this Wonder Wand, it's not good.

"Spell Card 'Graceful Charity'! Draw 3 cards, then discard 2 cards."

"Then activate the Spell Card 'Card of Burial Magic'!" Yuei Vu continued, "Banish the three Spell Cards 'Wonder Wand', 'Graceful Charity', and 'Bond Between Teacher and Student' from the graveyard, and draw two cards from the deck!"

The hand was replenished again, and Yuei Vu immediately played one of them: "Spell Card 'Preparation of Rites'! Add 1 Level 7 or lower Ritual Monster from my Deck to my hand, then add 1 Ritual Spell from my GY to my hand."

A card popped out from Yuei Vu's deck and graveyard respectively.

"I add the Ritual Monster 'Magician of Chaos' to my hand from the deck." Yuei Vu said, "and return the Ritual Spell 'Chaos Form' from the graveyard to the hand!"

Yusei's heart tightened.

That tricky magician again...

"Spell Card 'Chaos Form'!" Yuei Vu said, "Ritual Summon any 'Chaos' or 'Black Luster Soldier' Ritual Monster by Tributing monsters from my hand or field and/or banish 'Blue-Eyes White Dragon' or 'Dark Magician' from my GY, whose total Levels exactly equal the Level of that monster!"

I banish the level 7 'Dark Magician' in the graveyard as a material! Ritual Summon!

Magician of Chaos, come again!"

The shadow of the Dark Magician disappeared in the vortex of the other dimension, the chaotic magic array opened, and the black-robed wizard flew out of the vortex of the underworld!

[Magician of Chaos, ATK 2500]

"Quick-Play Spell 'Dedication through Light and Darkness'! Use a 'Dark Magician' on the field as a sacrifice to special summon this card from the hand, deck, or graveyard..."

The ultimate form of black magic, transcending the shackles of time and space—

—Dark Magician of Chaos!"

The Spell Card emerged, and a magical claw stretched out from it, grabbing the Dark Magician on the field and swallowing it into the Spell Card.

The surging black magic burst out, carrying the chaotic power of light and darkness. The magician in black tights slowly rose from the ritual magic circle, and the magic circle was surrounded by strange purple-black flames, reflecting the magician's blue-green face slightly strangely.

[Dark Magician of Chaos, ATK 2800]

"Dark Magician of Chaos's effect is activated!" Yuei Vu said, "When this card is successfully summoned, add a Spell Card from my graveyard to my hand."

A card popped out from the Graveyard Zone of the Duel Disk.

"I return this card from the graveyard to my hand—

—Spell Card 'Dark Magic Attack!'"

"The Spell Card that destroys all Spells and Traps?"

Yusei thought about it and seemed to think that Yuei Vu couldn't recover it smoothly, so he waved his hand: "Then open the set card: Trap Card – Memory Loss!

When an effect of an Attack Position monster the opponent controls is activated: Negate that effect and change that monster to face-up Defense Position!"

"You do have some tricks." Yuei Vu smiled and snapped his fingers, "But I'm sorry that won't happen. At this moment, activate the Trap Card 'Magician Navigation' from the graveyard!"

Yusei's eyelids twitched slightly.

A trap activated from the graveyard?

"Magician Navigation can be activated from the GY when there is a Dark Magician on my field." Yuei Vu said, "Banish this card from my GY, then target 1 face-up Spell/Trap the opponent controls; negate its effects until the end of this turn!"

"You still have a Dark Magician on the field.." Yusei quickly realized it.

"That's right," Yuei Vu said, "When the 'Magician of Chaos' is on the field, his name is treated as the 'Dark Magician'.

So the activation of Magician Navigation has become possible!"

He pointed to Yusei's field.

"According to the effect of 'Magician Navigation', the effect of the trap card 'Memory Loss' is negated!"

A black magic circle appeared around the trap next to Yusei, and the invisible magic power bound the power of the trap like a chain until the trap card turned into golden powder and dissipated.

"Therefore, the effect of 'Dark Magician of Chaos' becomes effective." Yuei Vu said, "I add 'Dark Magic Attack' to my hand.

Then the Spell Card 'Dark Magic Attack' is activated!"

Yuei Vu waved his hand, and the Spell Card appeared beside him with golden ripples.



"When there is a 'Dark Magician' on my field, all Spells and Traps on the opponent's field are destroyed!" Yuei Vu smiled, "Of course, because 'Magician of Chaos' is treated as 'Dark Magician', the activation of 'Dark Magic Attack' is also possible."

The magic power surged, and the powerful energy impact surged out, sweeping toward Yusei's field.

But Yusei still had a countermeasure!

"Open the set card: Trap Card – Starlight Road!"

"Oh?" Yuei Vu was very interested. "Is it actually Starlight Road?"

Starlight Road was also one of Yusei's personal iconic cards. In the real card environment of the year when the "Heavy Storm" was rampant, Starlight Road could also be regarded as a must-have staple card.

"Starlight Road can only be activated when the opponent activates a card or effect that destroys two or more cards I control!" Yusei said, "Negate the effect and destroy that card!"

Starlight fell, and the incandescent light smashed the black magic torrent into pieces with one blow.

In fact, after this effect was successfully activated, the user could directly fly a "Stardust Dragon" from the Extra Deck. But the Stardust Dragon was still in Jack's hand at this point in time, so Yusei could not activate this part of the effect.

Of course, for Yuei Vu's next battle, one more or one less Stardust Dragon would not make a difference to the result.

"But you do not forget the effect of 'Magician of Chaos', do you?" Yuei Vu reminded.

Yusei: "..."

"Magician of Chaos' effect – Once per turn, when a Spell/Trap Card or effect is activated, I can target 1 card on the field and destroy it."

The traps on Yusei's field have been completely consumed, and his only remaining wall was the Nitro Warrior. If the Nitro Warrior was destroyed, and the attack of any of the two magicians on Yusei's field passed, Yusei would lose.

But even at this point, Brother Crabhead was still not panicking.

Because Brother Crabhead, who was as steady as an old dog, even had a layer of insurance.

The monster card he discarded from the hand when special summoning "Quickdraw Synchron" just now is the live-saving artifact "Kiteroid" given by Yusei. When the opponent attacks directly, the battle damage can be reduced to 0.

No, to be precise, there should be two layers of insurance.

The Continuous Trap "Cross Thousand" was still on the field. Yusei still had two chances to restore the LP value to 1000 points when his LP changed.

In other words, if Yuei Vu wanted to defeat Yusei, he must cause more than 1000 points of damage to Yusei in one go.

And the way to cause damage must not be a direct attack, otherwise, it would trigger the blocking ability of "Kiteroid".

So Brother Crab was still calm as always.

"The effect of Magician of Chaos is activated. The card I want to destroy is..." Yuei Vu waved his hand, "Equip Spell 'Junk Barrage'!"

Yusei: "!"

Seeing the equipment card on his field being blown into pieces, Yusei had to admit that this was finally beyond his calculation.

Why destroy the equipment card instead of my monster?

Obviously, if Nitro Warrior was blown up, the "Junk Barrage" equipped on him would also be destroyed.

"Then activate the Spell Card 'Arms Regeneration' from my hand." Yuei Vu said, "Target 1 Equip Spell in either GY; equip it to 1 appropriate monster on the field." (manga effect)

This was also a classic Spell in the comics. It appeared in almost every manga from the first generation to 5DS. It was equivalent to a version of "Monster Reborn" that dedicated to Equip Spell.

He pointed to Brother Crabhead's graveyard.

"Of course, the card I chose is "Junk Barrage." Yuei Vu said, "I will equip the 'Junk Barrage' in your graveyard to your 'Nitro Warrior' on the field again!"

Yusei: "???"

Looking at the "Junk Barrage" that was re-equipped to the Nitro Warrior, Yusei was stunned.

Deliberately blow up my Equip Spell and then equip it back to my monster?

What kind of operation is this? Isn't this the same as the previous scene?

No, there is still a change.

Although it was still equipped on Yusei's "Nitro Warrior", the Equip Spell "Junk Barrage" has now been moved from Yusei's field to Yuei Vu's field. Strictly speaking, this card was now Yuei Vu's Equip Spell.

Wait, could it be that...

Yusei thought of the effect text description on "Junk Barrage", and suddenly his pupils shrank and a bold idea came up.

Junk Barrage: "When the equipped monster destroys a monster by battle and sends it to the Graveyard: Inflict damage to your opponent equal to half the destroyed monster's ATK in the Graveyard."

Inflict damage equal to half the destroyed monster's ATK to the "opponent".

This "opponent" may refer to the opponent from the perspective of the Equip Spell's controller?!

Doesn't that mean...

"Battle!" Yusei ordered, "Magician of Chaos, attack 'Nitro Warrior'."

[Magician of Chaos, ATK 2500]

[Nitro Warrior, ATK 2800]

Yusei's monster had a higher attack power, so this was obviously a suicide attack.

But Yusei's expression changed slightly.

Oops!

It seemed that Brother Crabhead was really good at dueling. He came to his senses so quickly.

Of course, it's useless to figure it out at this point.

Nitro Warrior swung his fist to counterattack and smashed the explosion wave of the black magic with one punch without any suspense. The Magician of Chaos was smashed to pieces under the force of the punch.

"Because of the effect of the Continuous Trap 'Spirit Barrier', I won't receive any battle damage." Yusei said, "But at this moment, the effect of 'Junk Barrage' is activated."

The Equip Spell 'Junk Barrage', when the equipped monster, 'Nitro Warrior', destroys a monster in battle, inflicts damage to the opponent equal to half the attack power of the destroyed monster.

In other words, you will receive half the attack power of the destroyed 'Magician of Chaos', which is 1250 damage."

"Take the damage from your own Equip Spell, 'Junk Barrage'."

Yusei's eyes widened.

Is there such an operation???

Life Points reached Zero, which meant losing the Duel. Yusei had been prepared for this outcome, and before the fight, he had not really expected to win against the legendary boss in front of him.

However, he predicted the result, but not the process.

Until his life points reached zero, he was still digesting the last moment of the duel.

The Equip Spell "Junk Barrage" had a specific description on the card: "When the equipped monster destroys a monster by battle and sends it to the Graveyard: Inflict damage to your opponent equal to half the destroyed monster's ATK in the Graveyard."
