To be honest, even Yusei Vu was a little confused this time.

[Yusei, SPC 0 → 1]

[Man In Black, SPC 0 → 1]

Yusei swept his arm, and a monster that seemed to be made of rocks appeared on the field, holding a huge black rock in both hands and blocking it like a shield.

"Set a card, I end my turn."

"Then it's my turn." The man in black said in a hoarse voice, "Draw."

[Yusei, SPC 1 → 2]

[Yusei, SPC 1 → 2]

"Activate the Speed Spell 'Angel Baton'!" The man in black directly played a divine card of the Speed Spell series, "It can only be activated when I have 2 or more Speed Counters. Draw 2 cards, then discard 1 card."

After passing two cards and discarding one card, the man glanced at Yusei's backcourt, and then said indifferently: "Special summon 'Psychic Megacyber' from my hand!"

The giant robot with golden lightning leaping all over his body jumped onto the field, light blue starlight splashed from his body, and his waving fists shone with golden flashes.

[Psychic Megacyber, ATK 2200]

Yusei: "Did you summon a Level 6 monster directly?"

"Psychic Megacyber, when the opponent controls more Spells/Traps than me, can be Special Summoned directly from the hand."

The man in black played another card: "Then I Normal Summon 'Jinzo – Jector'!"

The strange cyborg came to his field immediately, wearing round goggles on his face, and countless long black tentacles were flying behind him, each with a metal plug at the tip.

[Jinzo – Jector, DEF 2000]

"It's the 'Jinzo' deck." Yusei said, "I see, using the 'Jinzo' deck in Riding Duel...it may indeed have a miraculous effect."

"Why?" Yusei asked.

"The 'Jinzo' series is a deck based on the classic monster 'Jinzo'. The core tactic of the deck is 'Trap Blockade'."

"Trap Blockade?" Yusei came back to his senses, "I see. Because Riding Duel restricts Spell Cards, the strength of Spells has been weakened a lot, so Traps will occupy a more important position than ordinary duels..."

"That's right." Yusei nodded, "Under such conditions, the restrictive effect of 'Jinzo' will appear even more powerful."

At this time, the man in black continued: "Jinzo – Jector's effect is activated! Tribute this card, and add a 'Jinzo' monster other than 'Jinzo – Jector' from the deck to my hand.

I add this card to my hand..."

He pulled out a card that was automatically ejected from the deck.

"Jinzo the Machine Menace!"

The man in black then pointed to Yusei's backcourt.

"Then, the subsequent effect of 'Jinzo – Jector'!" said the man in black, "Reveal all Set cards in the opponent's Spell & Trap Zones!

If there are Traps among them, then I can Special Summon 'Jinzo' monsters from my hand up to the number of Traps revealed!

Okay, turn over the cards in your backfield and let me confirm them!"

Yusei's backfield card automatically flipped over, and it was the trap card "Iron Resolve".

During the battle phase, by paying half of the LP value, the battle damage received became 0 and the battle phase was forced to end. This was a trap card used by Yusei in the animation.

"Ha, it's a trap after all." The man in black sneered, "So according to this effect, I Special Summon 'Jinzo the Machine Menace' from my hand!"

Another vortex of starlight opened, and the alloy-made cyborg flew out of the vortex into this high-speed field. The red head, round eyepiece, and slender body look exactly like the classic "Jinzo".

[Jinzo the Machine Menace, ATK 2400]

"Then Jinzo the Machine Menace's effect is activated!" The man in black continued to operate, "During the Main Phase, I can Tribute this card; Special Summon 1 'Jinzo' from my hand or GY!

I tribute 'Jinzo the Machine Menace' and special summon the card that I just discarded to the graveyard..."

The "Jinzo the Machine Menace" on the field turned into golden powder and dissipated. At the same time, a card popped out from the graveyard area and was held high above the head by the man in black.

"Show up! The ultimate secret of psychic power, the immortal creation——

——Jinzo!"

The robot-man made of special alloy, wearing a green robe, changed into a vest and landed with a bang. The sight shot out from behind the eyepiece was cold and without temperature, and the invisible telekinesis enveloped the whole field.

[Jinzo, ATK 2400]

"Not only that," he continued, "after this effect is activated, all trap cards on the opponent's field are destroyed!"

The impact of telekinesis was released like a tide, sweeping over. The traps in Yusei's backfield were flipped under the transparent wave and soon broke into pieces.

Yusei: "Is it really a trap blockade..."

"If the opponent uses Jinzo, the trap tactics will be useless." Yuei Vu said, "Next, we have to try not to rely on traps to fight."

A very typical monster with Yusei's characteristics – battle destruction resistance plus battle damage reduction. A lot of Yusei's lower-level monsters had this kind of effect.

Although they looked weak, they were all very good at stalling.

But it was not so useful against today's opponent.

"Then the effect of 'Psychic Megacyber' is activated." The man in black said, "While I control 'Jinzo', I can Tribute 'Psychic Megacyber' when this card declares an attack on an opponent's Effect Monster!

Place that opponent's monster face-up in their Spell & Trap Zone as a Continuous Trap!"

"What?" Yusei was a little surprised.

Turning a monster into a Continuous Trap?

What kind of effect is this? It's simply unheard of.

"Psychic Megacyber, clear the 'Fortress Warrior'!"

The man in black shouted, and the entire body of the Electronic Giant had been decomposed into an energy body, turning into a surging golden electric light Fortress Warrior rushed forward.

The Fortress Warrior tried his best to block the stone shield in front of him, but his ability could only block the battle damage, and he was powerless against this weird effect. Soon he was hit by the electric current, and unwillingly turned into a trap and was placed in Yusei's backcourt.

"The battle continues." The man in black continued, "Jinzo, attack directly!"

The android crossed his palms, and a telekinetic sphere condensed in his palms. The purple-black ball of light blasted out and hit Yusei's D-Wheel head-on.

Yusei was unprepared for this impact, and the unprecedented strong touch blasted his D-Wheel. The front of the motorbike shook violently, and it felt like the speeding D-Wheel hit him directly, and the pain was like tearing his flesh apart.

[Yusei, LP 4000 → LP 1600]

Fortunately, Yusei's driving skills were strong enough. After shaking violently on the street for a while, he managed to stabilize the D-Wheel.

Due to the effect of "Speed World", for each 1000 LP you lose, your Speed Counter must be reduced by one. In the last turn, Yusei suffered a direct attack from "Jinzo" and lost 2400 LP. Now the two Speed Counters accumulated by him had been cleared.

[Yusei, SPC 0 → 1]

[Man In Black, SPC 2 → 3]

At the same time, Yusei's D-Wheel speed also slowed down slightly, and the silver-gray D-Wheel ridden by the man in black pulled away from him a little more.

"The effect of 'Quickdraw Synchron' in my hand!" Yusei said, "Quickdraw Synchron can be directly special summoned by sending a monster card in my hand to the GY.

I discard a card in my hand and special summon 'Quickdraw Synchron!'"

A cowboy-shaped robot popped out, with a cowboy-exclusive wide-brimmed hat on his head, and a revolver spun flexibly in his hand.

[Quickdraw Synchron, DEF 1400]

"The effect of 'Quillbolt Hedgehog' which I just discarded to the graveyard is activated!" Yusei shouted, "If Quillbolt Hedgehog is in the Graveyard and there is a Tuner monster on my field, I can Special Summon it directly from the Graveyard.

Come on, Quillbolt Hedgehog!"

The little yellow hedgehog popped out onto the field, and it looked even cute.

[Quillbolt Hedgehog, DEF 800]

"But the Quillbolt Hedgehog Special Summoned by this effect must be removed from the game directly when it leaves the field." Yusei said, "Then I Normal Summon 'Tuningware' from my hand!"

[Tuningware, DEF 300]

"Level 5 Tuner 'Quickdraw Synchron', Level 2 'Quillbolt Hedgehog', Level 1 'Tuningware', tuning!"

The Quickdraw Synchron's revolver spun, and he fired two shots, and his body turned into five halos that guided the synchro. The two monsters turned into starlight and connected in a row in the halos, falling to the ground with the roar of the demon god!

[5+1+2=8]

"Gathering fighting souls will awaken the raging wicked god! Become the path that lights the way! Synchro Summon! Obliterate, Junk Destroyer!"

The light curtain was torn apart, and a steel mecha rushed out of the synchro halo! It was a giant mecha with a shape similar to that of the "Dragon Warrior". It had four arms and a handsome and technological look, as if it was a mobile suit rushing out along the track of a ship.

This monster was not originally available to Yusei in the early days. It was one of the most practical Synchro Monsters in the Synchro deck system at that time, but did not debut until episode 101 of the anime.

For Yusei at this stage, it was undoubtedly a powerful trump card!

[Junk Destroyer, ATK 2600]

"The effect of 'Tuningware' – If this card is sent to the Graveyard for a Synchro Summon: Draw 1 card."

Yusei drew a card and then waved his hand.

"Junk Destroyer's effect is activated! When this card is Synchro Summoned, I can destroy cards on the field up to the number of non-Tuner monsters used for the Synchro Summon of this card!

"Trap card 'Psychic Shockwave'?" You Yu folded his arms and nodded slightly, "When the opponent activates a trap card, you can discard 1 Spell/Trap to Special Summon 1 Level 6 DARK Machine monster from your Deck."

"Level 6 DARK Machine monster... that is, 'Jinzo'." Yusei understood.

Obviously, the deck used by the man in black on the opposite side was a "Jinzo" deck. The trump card of his deck was Jinzo, and the tactics were mainly based on trap blockade. There were numerous ways to call Jinzo to the field.

"Because he expected that 'Jinzo' might be solved by us, he covered this trap in advance to prepare for the next turn," Yusei said.

But what he didn't expect was that this trap was also dismantled by Yusei.

"Enter the Battle Phase!" Yusei shouted, "Junk Destroyer, attack directly! Destroy Knuckle!"

Junk Destroyer's eyes flashed red, and he blasted out with four fists. The fist's force turned into four balls of incandescent light, like a heavy artillery bombardment. The transparent energy shock exploded violently around the D-Wheel of the man in black, and the scorching storm almost overturned the D-Wheel.

"Uh ah ah..."

[Man In Black, LP 4000 → LP 1400]

Can my attack also cause corresponding real damage to the opponent? Yusei thought.

"Set a card, I end my turn," Yusei said.

The man in black rushed in front and glanced at him sideways.

"So that's it, this is Fudo Yusei... You seem to be a little different from others." The man in black said, "No wonder you are a 'special person'."

During the Riding Duel, the D-Wheels of both sides were so far apart that it was impossible to hear normal conversations. But during the duel, both sides needed to constantly explain to each other,

and it was obviously not possible to not hear the sound, so the D-Wheels defaulted to open the voice communication during the Riding Duel.

Therefore, Yusei heard the man's muttering clearly.

Yusei immediately became alert: "What do you mean? Why do you say I'm a 'special person'? Do you recognize me?"

"Hehe, who knows?"

After muttering something without any context, the man in black stopped answering him.

"My turn, draw!"

[Yusei, SPC 1 → 2]

[Man In Black, SPC 3 → 4]

Seeing the card he drew, the man in black grinned.

"Hey, although you ruined my pre-arranged backhand, I can launch a counterattack immediately with this card."

Yusei didn't say anything, but he glanced at his own set card out of the corner of his eye.

His set card was the trap card "Floodgate Trap Hole", which could flip any monster face-down when it was summoned, making it unable to actively change its form.

Traps could not be activated when Jinzo was on the field, so this card was obviously useless against the Psycho Shocker. But the Psycho Shocker is a six-star monster and could not be played directly.

As long as the opponent tried to summon any monster as tribute fodder, Yusei could immediately use "Floodgate Trap Hole" to crush it.

The man in black smiled slightly: "I Normal Summon 'Scrap Recycler'."

[Scrap Recycler, ATK 900]

Scrap Recycler? A card I have never seen before...

Just as Yusei was hesitating whether this card was worth his trap, Yusei said: "Activate it. Although it may not be very useful, if you don't use it now, you will never have the chance to use it again."

Yusei did not yet understand Yusei's meaning, but he still did it without hesitation: "Open the set card: Trap Card – Floodgate Trap Hole! Flip 'Scrap Recycler' to face-down defense position!"

"It's meaningless." The man in black sneered, "The effect of Scrap Recycler has been activated the moment it is summoned! When this card is Normal or Special Summoned: I can send 1 Machine monster from my Deck to the GY."

The man in black said, "I will send 'Jinzo – Returner' to the graveyard from the deck!"

A card popped out of the deck and was sent directly to the graveyard by him.

"Next, activate the effect of the 'Jinzo – Returner' that is just sent to the graveyard!" the man in black shouted, "When this card is sent to the GY: I can target 1 'Jinzo' in my GY; Special Summon it!"

Come back to the field again, the ultimate secret of psychic power——

——Jinzo!"

Chapter 1178: New Trump Card

Jizo was summoned again!

[Jinzo, ATK 2400]

"He actually summoned Jinzo again..." Yusei said, "But Jinzo's attack power is only 2400, which is not enough to defeat the Junk Destroyer."

"Not only that, the monsters special summoned by the effect of 'Jinzo – Returner' must self-destruct at the end of the turn." Yueli Vu said, pausing, "But since the opponent has acted like this, the next move must have been prepared long ago."

Sure enough, the man in black raised his voice: "Then I will send the 'Jinzo' on the field to the graveyard to release its true power!

King of Psychic Power, now release the true power hidden in your body and come again as a king! Show up here——

——Jinzo – Lord!!!"

The body of the cyborg was covered by a burst of light, and countless metal arms began to transform his body.

A huge telekinetic power burst out, and the invisible field swept across the streets. The cyborg with a new look appeared on the field of the man in black, standing like a giant, and his aura was completely different from before.

[Jinzo – Lord, ATK 2600]

"This is the final form of Jinzo, the strongest power that has untied all restraints!" The man in black shouted, "Jinzo – Lord, of course, has inherited the effect of Jinzo! As long as he is on the field, both players cannot activate trap cards, and the effects of all trap cards on the field are negated.

In addition, once per turn, I can look at all cards in the opponent's hand and Spell & Trap Card Zones, and if there are any Trap Cards among them, I can destroy those Trap Cards. Inflict 300 damage to the opponent for each card destroyed by this effect!" (Animation effect)

"Can you confirm hand cards and set S/T cards?" Yusei was a little surprised.

Even in today's Yu-Gi-Oh card pool, there were very few effects that allowed people to see the opponent's cards.

There were no set cards on Yusei's field, and two hand cards also emerged and were displayed in front of the man in black.

Very unlucky, there happened to be a trap in it.

Trap Card "Graceful Revival", which could be used to special summon a Level 2 or lower monster from the Graveyard.

In addition, there was the "Fortress Warrior" that was previously placed in their Spell & Trap Zone as a Continuous Trap.

"Just destroy the trap." The man in black shouted.

Red-hot laser beams shot out of the eyes of the cyborg, cutting a charred crack along the ground, and burned the trap in Yusei's hand to ashes with one blow.

"Also deal 600 points of damage!"

[Yusei, LP 1600 → LP 1000]

"Then activate the Speed Spell 'Speed Energy' from my hand!" The man in black waved his hand and flipped out another Spell at his side, "It can only be activated when I have 2 or more Speed Counters.

Select 1 face-up monster on the field. It gains 200 ATK for each Speed Counter I have until the End Phase!"

[Man in Black, SPC 4]

"Jinzo – Lord's attack power increased by 800!"

[Jinzo – Lord, ATK 2600 → ATK 3400]

"Go, Jinzo – Lord!" The man in black shouted, "Attack the 'Junk Destroyer'!"
