[Krebons, ATK 1200]

"I Special Summon 'Mind Protector'!"

[Mind Protector, DEF 2200]

Good boy, I almost forgot that "Emergency Teleport" was actually your card.

It could unconditionally call any level 3 or lower Psychic monster out of the deck. Just looking at the effect, you could understand how awesome this card was. Even in the real card environment after countless versions, this card was still a limited card, and it could be very powerful in a specific deck.

"Level 2 Tuner 'Krebons', plus level 3 'Mind Protector', tuning!"

[2+3=5]

"My flames of hatred, blazing within the abyss of my heart, become the black raging waves that will overrun this world!

Synchro Summon! Appear now, Magical Android!"

The two monsters transformed into stars, and a mechanical being descended under the magic light curtain, holding a telekinetic wand, his face as calm as still water.

[Magical Android, ATK 2400]

"He performed a Synchro Summon in the first turn. Sure enough, this person is not a weakling." Brother Crabhead thought to himself.

Even among the prominent characters in 5DS, there were not many who could summon Synchro Monsters in the first turn. If you have this level, you can at least be considered a master.

Of course, if Divine didn't even have this level, he wouldn't be the leader of the Arcadia Movement.

"Set two cards, I end my turn." Divine said, "I can't attack on the first turn, but the effect of Magical Android can still be activated!

During each of my End Phases, I gain 600 LP for each Psychic-Type monster I currently control."

[Divine, LP 4000 → LP 4600]

"Foolish fellows." Divine sneered, "I don't know what kind of people you claim to be. Seeking the truth? Wating to play a hero of justice?

But the fact is, you are just two more obstacles that will be cleared on my road to success, that's all."

"Are all obstacles except for the chess pieces that can be used?" Yuei Vu said calmly, "Just like you murdered an innocent person and framed Aki with the intention of turning her into your own doll?"

Divine's pupils shrank, revealing a look of astonishment.

In the original work, Izayoi Aki was called the Black Rose Witch, and was hated and slandered as a murderer by countless people. In fact, it was not completely groundless. The fact was that there were often corpses wherever she passed.

"The system's deck registration information shows that your deck seems to have just reached 40 cards." Yuei Vu smiled, "You start with six cards, plus the one retrieved using 'Emergency Teleport', you should have 33 cards left.

My deck is 60 cards, minus the six cards in my hand, the remaining deck is 54 cards."

At this time, the duel disk has automatically ejected a large number of cards, all of which were taken by Yuei Vu.

"Therefore, I sent all the extra 21 cards to the graveyard!"

Yusei was surprised: "Just one card, accumulated so many resources?"

Of course, this tactic worked well in the real card environment, but it was not so good in the complex and changeable animation environment that Yuei Vu was facing.

Because in the real card environment, it was based on the premise that 90% of the players' decks were at the limit of 40 cards. If you a large deck with 60 cards, and you started with a That Grass Looks Greener, 20 cards were directly piled into the graveyard as resources.

However, this was not the case in the animation. Especially for masters like Yugi Muto and Judai Yuki, the number of cards in their decks often depended on their mood. If you play cards with such masters and expect to use up 20 resources for one card, you are probably dreaming.

But Divine was obviously not such a master. His deck was a standard 40-card one.

He even mocked Yuei Vu for "lacking basic common sense".

"60-card deck? Please, do you really know how to duel?" Divine laughed, "Such a bloated deck is just a pile of cards, right?

40 cards? Who would only bring 40 cards as a true duelist?

The more cards you bring, the more emergencies you can deal with. Shouldn't this be common sense for duelists?

What? Afraid of not being able to draw the cards you want?

Then why do you still play cards?

"Activate the Spell Card 'Solar Recharge'," Yuei Vu said, "Discard 1 'Lightsworn' monster; draw 2 cards, then send the top 2 cards of my Deck to the GY."

He showed a card in his hand: "I discard 'Raiden, Hand of the Lightsworn' from my hand to the graveyard and draw two cards."

Watching him draw cards and discard cards to the graveyard, Divine became more and more suspicious.

What's the point of piling more cards in the graveyard?

"Activate the Spell Card 'Charge of the Light Brigade'. Send the top 3 cards of my Deck to the GY; add 1 Level 4 or lower 'Lightsworn' monster from my Deck to my hand.

I add 'Ryko, Lightsworn Hunter' to my hand."

Seeing Yuei Vu swiping three cards into the graveyard again, Divine was alert: "So much trouble, just to retrieve that 'Lightsworn Hunter'?"

But then he found out that he was wrong again. Yuei Vu continued: "Activate the second 'Solar Recharge'. I discard 'Ryko, Lightsworn Hunter', and draw two cards.

Then throw two cards from the top of the deck to the graveyard."

Seeing Yuei Vu throw away the monster he just retrieved without blinking, and then draw cards to the graveyard, he couldn't help but feel more confused.

So he didn't want the card he retrieved?

What is he doing?

And soon, he knew the answer.

Yuei Vu raised a card in his hand and said, "This card can only be Special Summoned when there are four or more 'Lightsworn' monsters with different names in my GY.

The incarnation of light that judges everything has descended here—

–Judgment Dragon!!!"

The huge wings that cover the sky and the sun cover the huge body of light. The aquamarine sky in the domain seemed to be torn apart, and a huge dragon emerged from the broken gap, looking down from a high place, with a sharp vision like a hawk, but as cold as a pool of stagnant water.

[Judgment Dragon, ATK 3000]

The transparent storm, just like the flying sand and rocks when Izayoi's "Black Rose Dragon" appeared, but it was more violent and more terrifying.

Not only the destructive power, but also the pressure like a god, like a huge rock pressing on the heart, making people in this domain almost frozen.

Divine was also somewhat shocked by the dragon: "What is this!?"

"Judgment Dragon's effect" Yuei Vu snapped his fingers, "Pay 1000 life points, and all cards on the field except this card are destroyed!"

Divine: "!?"

Damn? So fierce?

[Yuei Vu, LP 4000 → LP 3000]

The dragon slowly spread its wings and exhaled scorchingly. The strong light was like a tidal wave, rolling up and swallowing all the cards on the field, annihilating them into slag.

The Magical Android he was proud of had no power to fight back under the judgment of the Judgment Dragon, and were soon melted and decomposed in the dragon's breath until they turned into a pool of molten iron.

It could be seen that in the backfield where Divine was swept, there was a Counter Trap "Negate Attack", which has the best survival performance among defensive offensive traps.

Everything was annihilated, and everything was melting.

Until the entire field was empty, leaving only the majestic and huge Judgment Dragon.

"What a terrible monster." Divine looked at his field that had been cleared out, narrowed his eyes and snorted, then sneered, "If it weren't for me setting this card..."

Divine laughed: "When you cleared my backfield, you also destroyed this set card!"

A trap flew out of the vortex in the graveyard, spinning twice to reveal its true face.

That was the trap card "Waking the Dragon"!

Chapter 1194: A Name

Waking the Dragon had been a professional nuking prevention for 30 years. The purpose of this card was to let the opponent blow it away, so that the controller would be able to pull out almost any trump card unconditionally!

"If this Set card in its owner's control has left the field because of an opponent's effect, and is now in the GY or banished, I can Special Summon 1 monster from my Deck or Extra Deck!" Divine shouted, "Thanks to your help in destroying my backfield, my strongest trump card can be easily put on the field.

Show up, the strongest firepower of my deck-

-Thought Ruler Archfiend!!!"

It was a demon whose body seemed to be wrapped in a layer of skeleton armor, dark green bone wings, and golden lightning wrapped around his body.

Divine's trump card, Level 8 Synchro Mónter, Thought Ruler Archfiend!

[Thought Ruler Archfiend, ATK 2700]

Thought Ruler Archfiend, when destroying an opponent's monster in battle, could restore LP equal to the destroyed monster's original attack power. In addition, whenever a Spell or Trap targeting a Psychic monster was activated, you could pay 1000 life points to negate and destroy that card.

By the way, this thing was also a Psychic monster.

It was still very useful in the early Synchro environment, and even became a staple card in many Synchro decks. Having it was equivalent to all Psychic on the field gaining resistance to target effects.

With this kind of monster, it was no wonder that Divine dared to be so arrogant in the early 5DS. Ordinary people may not be his opponent.

However...

Yuei Vu kept looking at Divine as if he was looking at a dead person, expressionless: "Then I activate the effect of Judgment Dragon again. Pay 1000 life points, and destroy the 'Thought Ruler Archfiend'."

Divine: "!!?"

What?

Such a poweful effect is not limited to once per turn?!

Yes, the effect of Judgment Dragon was not said to be once per round. As long as your LP was enough, it could clean up the entire field as many times as you wanted.

This is Judgment Dragon, the strongest terminal of Lightsworn that judges everything!

[Yuei Vu, LP 3000 → LP 2000]

At the cost of one thousand life points, Judgment Dragon's ability was activated again, easily crushing Divine's so-called "strongest firepower" into slag, as easy as slapping a mosquito to death.

"How is it possible?" Divine swallowed his saliva.

"Normal Summon 'Lumina, Lightsworn Summoner'."

[Lumina, Lightsworn Summoner, ATK 1000]

"Lumina's effect – Once per turn: I can discard 1 card, then target 1 Level 4 or lower 'Lightsworn' monster in my GY; Special Summon it." Yuei Vu said, "Return to the field, Raiden!"

[Raiden, Hand of the Lightsworn, ATK 1700]

"Raiden's effect – During my Main Phase, I can send the top 2 cards of my Deck to the GY. If any 'Lightsworn' monsters were sent to the GY by this effect, this card gains 200 ATK until the end of the opponent's next turn."

After throwing two more cards, Yuei Vu raised his eyebrows.

"One of the two sent cards is 'Wulf, Lightsworn Beast'. When it is sent from the deck to the Graveyard by the effect of a card, it can be directly Special Summoned.

Come on, Wulf, Lightsworn Beast."

[Wulf, Lightsworn Beast, ATK 2100]

"Raiden's ATK increases by 200."

[Raiden, Hand of the Lightsworn, ATK 1700 → ATK 1900]

In fact, Raiden himself was a Tuner Monster. Now he has a Level 4 Tuner Raiden, a Level 4 Wulf, and a Level 3 Lumina on the field. If he performed Synchro Summons, he could continue to swarm the field.

Of course, it was no longer necessary.

Why continue to operate to a dead person who is already a corpse?

Based on the principle of compassion of "I am not a devil either", Yuei Vu smiled.

"Then 'Wulf, Lightsworn Beast' and 'Judgment Dragon' will deal with this pathetic person."

With the final blow, the Judgment Dragon spewed out a scorching breath! The devastating flames hit Divine's body, and the pain, which was a hundred times and a thousand times stronger than telekinesis, almost crushed his nerves.

"Ahhhhhhh!!!"

[Divine, LP $4600 \rightarrow LP 0$]

Divine's body was overwhelmed and was finally blown away in the scorching torrent of destruction. His back hit the boundary of the duel field heavily, and the invisible wall was covered with aquablue ripples.

Divine fell back to the ground heavily, and felt that his breathing was almost cut off.
