"Last Day of Witch is a card that can destroy all face-up Spellcaster-Type monsters on the field.." Yuei Vu chuckled, "Even your so-called most advanced Dark magician is no exception!"

## **Chapter 7: What Have I Done?**

Dark Renewal (Normal Trap Card): When your opponent Normal or Special Summons a monster(s): Target 1 of those monsters and 1 Spellcaster monster you control; send both monsters to the GY, then you can Special Summon 1 DARK Spellcaster monster from your Deck or GY.

(the above are all anime effects)

Yuei Vu put the cards seized from Pandora into the Duel Disk and tried them out. He was pleasantly surprised to find that these cards seemed to work!

According to the rule of World Link Online, players can only use the cards obtained from the system card library or quest rewards. If a player grabbed the NPC's deck directly placing it on the Duel Disk like Yuei Vu just did, the Duel Disk would have no response.

Yuei Vu speculated that maybe it was because he became an NPC after his rebirth, so now he could use cards produced locally like other NPCs.

At the same time, he also comes with the player's game panel, which can also obtain cards from the system card pool just like the player.

In other words, he has become a kind of existence mixed between the player and the NPC, and can use the game's native and system-produced cards at the same time.
