"I activate the Spell Card Merciful Machine Angel'!" She played the first card, "Tribute 1 Cyber Angel' Ritual Monster from my hand or field; draw 2 cards, then place 1 card from my hand on the bottom of the Deck."

This move was completely unlike what an animated character should have, and it was completely inconsistent with everyones impression.

Shouldnt the common characteristic of all characters in GX animation be losing cards?

"Sure, Sister Sprite!" She offered her a bargain and said, "You're good at teaching!"

Coke Sprite puffed up her chest and said, "That's a given!"

Don't you see how much money our guild and its president have spent?!

"Summon the Senju of the Thousand Hands' in defense position!"

The golden statue appeared on Asuka's field, with countless arms behind him spread out in different directions, like a peacock spreading its tail.

[Senju of the Thousand Hands, DEF 1000]

"The effect of Senju of the Thousand Hands'! When this card is Normal or Flip Summoned: I can add 1 Ritual Monster from my Deck to my hand." Asuka drew another card from the deck, "I added Cyber Angel Idaten' to my hand."

Another search brought Asuka a new key component.

"Set two cards, I end my turn."

Asuka let out a long breath, causing a wave on her chest.

She was a little worried about her performance and glanced nervously in the direction of her mentor. She saw Coke Sprite giving her a thumbs up, with approval written all over her face.

"Then it's my turn, draw!" Entering Nightshroud's turn, "Activate Spell Card Graceful Charity', draw 3 cards, then discard 2 cards."

His starting hand was not surprising this guy was also a 502-type player. He had played a few card games in the animation, and every time he had a fixed number of cards stuck to his hand.

"I summon the Black Dragon's Chick'!"

A beam of lava fire rose into the sky, leaving an oval dragon egg that was burned red on the ground. The eggshell cracked open, and the little black dragon broke out.

[Black Dragon's Chick, ATK 800]

"The effect of Black Dragon's Chick'! Send this card from the field to the graveyard, and special summon from my hand"

Nightshroud exaggeratedly raised a card. In an instant, lava rolled in the crater, heat waves swept across, his black windbreaker kept rising and falling, and the jet-black dragon wrapped in lava rose into the sky!

"Show yourself, the legendary black dragon

Red-Eyes Black Dragon!!!"

"The follow-up effect of Offensive Guard', I draw a card from the deck," she said.

"Set two cards, I end my turn." Nightshroud chuckled, "At this level, you will be torn to pieces by my Red-Eyes' very quickly.

Shadow Game is not a child's play, it is a death game that only the strongest can adapt to. A hesitation, a hint of cowardice, any detail may lead to destruction! "

Asuka glanced at him, but only smiled softly.

"Really? Then let me return these words to you intact."

Chapter 806: Result of Training

"My turn, draw! Activate the second Merciful Machine Angel'!" Asuka said, "Tribute 1 Cyber Angel' Ritual Monster from my hand or field; draw 2 cards, then place 1 card from my hand on the bottom of the Deck.

I Tribute the Cyber Angel Benten' that was retrieved from the deck in the last turn and draw two cards! "

She replaced two cards in her hand and returned one of them to the deck. The effect of the monster sent to the graveyard was also activated.

"The effect of Cyber Angel Benten'." She said, "If this card is Tributed: I can add 1 LIGHT Fairy monster from my Deck to my hand.

I added the Manju of the Ten Thousand Hands from the deck to my hand. "

Searching the deck again, after the "Manju of the Ten Thousand Hands" was taken out of her hand, the deck was quickly shuffled.

"Then I normal summon Manju of the Ten Thousand Hands'!"

[Manju of the Ten Thousand Hands, ATK 1400]

"The effect of Manju of the Ten Thousand Hands'! When this card is Normal or Flip Summoned: I can add 1 Ritual Monster or 1 Ritual Spell from my Deck to my hand." Asuka accurately retrieved it from the deck again, "I added the Ritual Monster Cyber Angel Dakini' from the deck to the hand!"

In this way, the preparations were almost complete.

Asuka showed two cards in her hand at once: "Ritual Spell Machine Angel Absolute Ritual! Ritual Summon a Cyber Angel' Ritual Monster by Tributing monsters from my hand or field and/or shuffling Fairy or Warrior-Type monsters from my Graveyard into the Deck, whose total Levels exactly equal the Level of the Ritual Monster!

I used the Level 6 Cyber Angel Benten in my hand as a sacrifice to Ritual Summon! Appear here Cyber Angel Idaten!!!"

Idaten was a Buddhist protector, but the image here was that of a graceful female angel, with a graceful and seductive figure, and her soft body curves are like undulating waves.

[Cyber Angel Idaten, ATK 1600]

Nightshroud sneered: "Huh, after all this hard work, you only summoned this"

Before he could finish his words, Asuka interrupted him: "The effect of the Cyber Angel Benten'! If this card is Tributed: I can add 1 LIGHT Fairy monster from my Deck to my hand!

What follows is the effect of the Cyber Angel Idaten! If this card is Ritual Summoned: I can add 1 Ritual Spell from my Deck or GY to my hand. "

Asuka took out the two cards that automatically popped up from the deck in one breath.

"I added Senju of the Thousand Hands', and the Ritual Spell Machine Angel Ritual' to my hand!"

By now, many players have been a little surprised, and many have turned their attention to Asuka's mentor, Coke Sprite.

Not to mention anything else, just in terms of retrieval, card earning, and deck operation capabilities, Asuka's deck already had the flavor of a high-end deck!

Being in the spotlight, Coke Sprite couldn't help but hold her head high, feeling a little proud.

Strong, right? Now you know who taught her!

Even President Sandbag nodded slightly and was very satisfied. For a moment, he felt that all the money spent these days and the combined effort of all the brothers in the guild were worth it.

"Spell Card Machine Angel Ritual!" Asuka continued her combo, "Ritual Summon a Cyber Angel' Ritual Monster by Tributing monsters from my hand or field whose total Levels equal or exceed the Level of the Ritual Monster!

Use the Level 4 Senju of the Thousand Hands in my hand and the Level 6 Cyber Angel Idaten on the field as sacrifices! Ritual Summon!

The strongest angel comes here

Cyber Angel Dakini!!!"

A mechanical altar emerged, and a ritual circle opened below. Strange flames were ignited in the brazier, and the two sacrifices turned into beams and disappeared into the altar, and majestic energy exploded outward.

Stepping out of the whirlpool of the ritual was a mechanical ghost. She has four strong arms, two of which hold a shining sword, and the other two hold a long gold-encrusted staff.

Damn, you actually used our guild's holy power to trick our guild's disciples?

"When an opponent's monster declares an attack: Destroy all the opponent's Attack Position monsters." Nightshroud sneered, "It's hard for you to reach this step, but this is the end!

All your monsters will be destroyed by the light of the Mirror Force'! "

The hemispherical shield released the divine light, and the dazzling light came back! The blue light was like an overwhelming rain curtain, covering the entire venue on Asuka's side, making it impossible for the monsters to avoid it.

But Asuka looked calm and withdrew a card from the graveyard.

Seeing the card that was negated by "Solemn Judgment" return to Asuka's hand again, Nightshroud could almost foresee what was going to happen next

"Activate the Spell Card Preparation of Rites'!" Asuka said, "Add 1 Level 7 or lower Ritual Monster from my Deck to my hand, then I can add 1 Ritual Spell from my GY to my hand."

A card automatically popped up in her deck again.

I added Cyber Angel Benten, which was just shuffled back into the deck through the effect of Machine Angel Absolute Ritual, into my hand.

Then I returned the Machine Angel Absolute Ritual' from the graveyard to my hand again."
