Myles Swayer frowned, clearly a bit displeased.


He very much hoped these matters were related to Wyatt Barnes, so that his father would be furious and go to any lengths to eliminate Wyatt Barnes.

Chapter 1623: Betrayal


Before coming here, Hunter Swayer considered many possibilities.

"What did he say?"


Wyatt asked.

Soon, similar comments spread widely with the encouragement of interested parties.


For a time, King Honorston's Manor couldn't sit still and began to exert pressure on the Swayer Family.


"Mr. Barnes, even if you're leaving, there's no need to cut ties with our Swayer Family."

As the public opinion in the Capital City shifted over these days, he guessed Hunter Swayer's intentions, which greatly displeased him.


