"You sure," Maria confirmed.

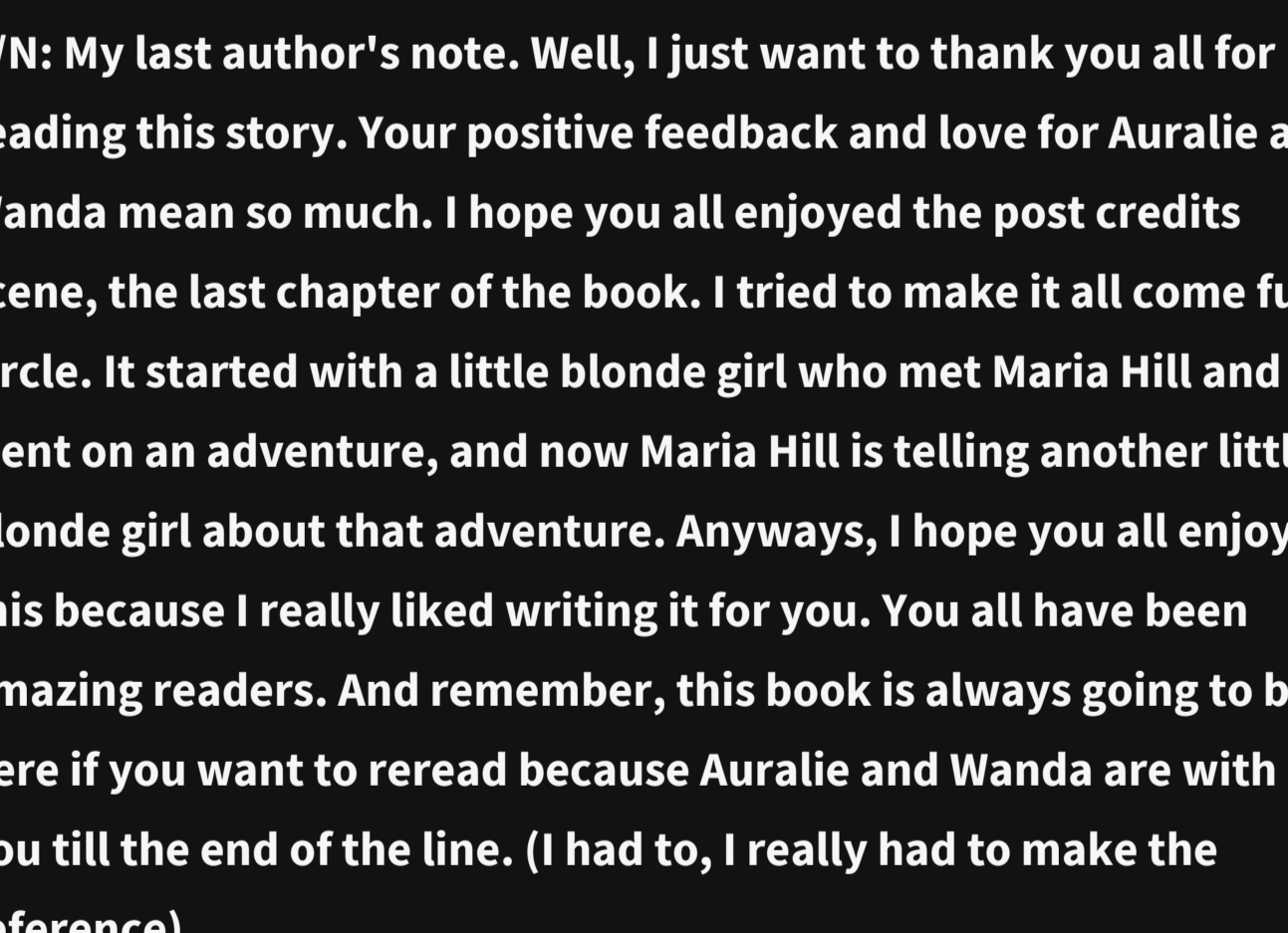
Eileen smiled, "I'm sure."
