Some powerful factions mostly had Class 4 Creation Masters presiding over.

Those without Class 4 Creation Masters presiding over were a lot worse than those that had. These factions with Class 4 Creation Masters also lacked Bronze/Epic feys.

If a Class 4 Creation Master wanted to enhance a Bronze/Epic fey, they would have to use many resources and a period to nurture it.

At present, no faction in the Radiance Federation offered a service of custom-selling Bronze/Epic feys based on the Willpower Rune one comprehended.

Most of the services like this that could customize the Bronze/Epic fey based on the comprehended Willpower Rune would require booking some Class 4 or even pinnacle Class 4 Creation Masters through some connections.

They might even have to rely on favors and wait for a few years even if they could afford the price.

The waiting time of several years was undoubtedly akin to the comprehended Willpower Rune not being able to be used for a few years.

However, this was unavoidable as advanced, or pinnacle Class 4 Creation Masters had this status and reputation.

This was why when Lin Yuan's Purchase With No Loss Fey Store had released the news of exchanging with any Bronze/Epic feys, even if there were three source-type items in the things Lin Yuan wanted to exchange for, plenty of people had still madly exchanged and even caused so much attention.

Lin Yuan was dumbfounded. Although she had good strategic talents in deploying resources and reviewing the situation, she was still a young girl and needed to be honed.

This was when Lin Yuan realized that her contracted source-type Earth Rush Golden Lotus was shaking the huge golden lotus flower, looking a little aggrieved.

It was as if it did not understand why its contractor had left it there and run away suddenly.

Upon seeing that, Lin Yuan took over Wen Yu's position to accompany it to sunbathe and regularly irrigated it with the spray bottle's concocted spirit fluid.

When Lin Yuan saw he was almost done with the spirit fluid, he placed the spray bottle on the flower bed's side.

At that moment, he decided that, besides the Dragon's Mouth Orchid, Wood Weaving House Centipede, and the three Dragon-Phoenix Landscape Carp, the sixth fey he was going to enhance would be the Oath Lily of the Valley.

### **Chapter 333: Faction Territory**

If Lin Yuan wanted to create his private faction—apart from the wait for the Floating Island Whale to hatch—he would have to build a sky city on the back of the majestic giant beast.

At the same time, Lin Yuan had to establish his faction's territory on Star Web.

To a certain extent, Star Web was already considered a second world in the Radiance Federation. In fact, more things could be accomplished on Star Web than in reality.

It was due to the massive size of the Radiance Federation's map. Even with a Diamond fey, it was difficult to travel between two major cities. If it was to travel between the southernmost city and the northernmost city, it would need at least two months of journey.

Therefore, it was actually the most convenient for matters that weren't very important to have the negotiation and trade on Star Web. Matters like the application to set up a guild club could be easily done at the Guild Alliance.

However, to be officially recognized as a guild club by the Guild Alliance in the list and to participate in the S Tournament, one would need to establish the home base first, and there would be plenty of inspections.

However, it was different when establishing a private faction, and it wouldn't be as troublesome. In order to establish a private faction, one would need to prove to the Radiance Federation that they had a sufficient foundation.

The foundation didn't mean wealth, but actually martial strength.

Once the faction possessed the combat standard of a pinnacle king-class faction, one would be able to submit the application to establish a private faction.

Establishing a private faction on Star Web was different from establishing a Star Web store.

For Star Web stores, the store's grade would be increased gradually, allowing for the store's space to increase. At the same time, all decorations on the Star Web store could be purchased in furnishing stores on Star Web. It didn't have to be items that existed in reality and were scanned into the Star Web through the Star Web Card.

However, to establish a private faction on Star Web was the same as establishing a private faction in reality.

Firstly, a territory had to be purchased on Star Web.

The territory space on Star Web that was specifically used for factions would be as big as a B-level guild club from the Guild Alliance.

The territory bought from Star Web could be freely used for construction. However, all of the decorations inside the faction territory must be items from the real world and scanned by the Star Web Card.

It was precisely because of this reason that the foundation of a private faction could be seen by the territory's construction.

Moreover, there was always this restriction for items scanned into the Star Web with the Star Web Card. For any fey or spiritual ingredient, they could only be scanned once by the Star Web Card.

It was also because of this reason, many of the newly established factions on Star Web would look for the veteran factions and spend huge amounts of Radiance dollars to scan in some items that would be good enough to uphold their reputation.

Some examples would be jade-textured wooden decorations or furniture. As for completely jade-textured wooden decorations and furniture, those veteran factions wouldn't lend them no matter how much money was offered.

After all, completely jade-textured wooden items that represented one's foundation weren't enough for even veteran factions.

Some of the newly established factions might already have martial strength that was at the standard of veteran factions, however, most of the veteran factions wouldn't even view these rising factions at their own level. After all, the rising factions were lacking in foundations when compared with the veteran factions.

Some of the veteran factions with a deep foundation would actually despise those rising factions. It was a kind of cycle of despise as the veteran factions with deep foundations would feel that the rising factions were just a group of upstarts without years of experience to settle as their foundation.

Nevertheless, one had to admit that these veteran factions were indeed stronger than the rising factions. After all, there were times when resources could indeed be used to represent strength.

As compared to those rising factions, veteran factions would have an easier time obtaining the king-class experts' loyalty.

King-class experts didn't just need resources to nurture their contracted feys. They also had to accumulate resources to trade for a Bronze fey with high quality after comprehending a Willpower Rune.

It could be said to be a constant requirement for a huge amount of resources.

The prestigious families' descendants didn't have to worry about such resources' requirements but instead the spirit qi professionals from ordinary families who relied on themselves. If they wished to improve further after reaching king-class, they would normally have an easier time just joining a veteran faction than striving for themselves.

Take the king-class group that had hosted the auction which had Lin Yuan participated in. That king-class group didn't have any veteran faction as a backer, and they were just a group of pinnacle king-class experts that were gathered together.

That's why when two of the members had comprehended their Willpower Runes, they had to sort out their resources to trade for Bronze/Epic feys.

It was enough to see that the resources king-class experts required were always more than what they could actually earn.

This was already prominent in a group of king-class experts. What about those king-class experts that worked alone?

Therefore, the best choice for those lone king-class experts was to join a veteran faction. It was the reason why veteran factions had plenty of power that would always be hidden in the dark.

It was unlike those rising factions that always liked to place their power in the light in order to attract more people to join them.

However, the strength difference between rising factions and veteran factions would never be absolute. The factor that could cause a change would be high-class Creation Masters.

If a rising faction that didn't have much foundation had a Class 4 Creation Master's assistance, then the rising faction would be able to promote into a veteran faction quickly and would be gradually recognized by other veteran factions.

In short, no matter what, if Lin Yuan wanted to establish his own private faction on Star Web, his first step would be to purchase territory.

As for the application to establish a private faction on Star Web, Lin Yuan wasn't worried at all. If pinnacle king-class combat strength were enough to apply for a private faction's establishment, it wouldn't be considered a problem for the current Lin Yuan.

Endless Summer was Lin Yuan's Protector and was naturally considered his martial strength. As a Suzerain/Myth III fey, Endless Summer already had an emperor-class expert's strength.

As long as he made the application, he would immediately reach the standard and pass. Thus, Lin Yuan wasn't thinking of how he should apply for the establishment of his private faction. Instead, he was thinking of how he should decorate his private faction's territory.

### **Chapter 334: Fate Letter**

Lin Yuan had plenty of valuable items. If he was willing to bring them out, it wouldn't be difficult for him to decorate his private faction's territory.

However, Lin Yuan wasn't planning to spend his efforts to decorate the private faction's outside environment. It was the same as wasting time.

The Floating Island Whale had yet to hatch, and if Lin Yuan used large amounts of feys and spiritual ingredients to decorate the territory, it would be the same as wasting the resources and smashing his own hand.

If these scanned items were sold, then they would vanish from the private faction's Star Web territory. After each transaction, it would refresh those items' scan count.

Furthermore, since Lin Yuan wanted to create a low-profile and secretive faction, then he didn't have to spend any effort to create an exterior environment. However, the territory's interior was something that Lin Yuan still had to put some effort into.



Regarding his private faction's interior construction, Lin Yuan was going to fully exhibit his foundation.

Lin Yuan might already have the interior design, but he only had the designs and not the spirit craftsmanship.

Therefore, Lin Yuan required Hu Quan and his brilliant spirit craftsmanship to make his designs a reality.

Hu Quan already had the standard of a Class 5 Spirit Craftsman and could undertake Lin Yuan's arrangements.

Lin Yuan's private faction's operation model would be entirely reliant on Fate Letters.

Fate Letters was a method for Lin Yuan to choose spirit qi professionals who comprehended Willpower Runes and for them to order a Bronze/Epic fey that was suitable for their respective Willpower Rune.

Lin Yuan planned for his private faction to sell 100 Fate Letters every three days in an auction. These Fate Letters would be contested for with Radiance dollars by experts, prestigious families, and various major factions.

Furthermore, this was a contest for merely a chance to obtain a Bronze/Epic fey according to the comprehended Willpower Rune.

All of the experts, prestigious families, and major factions that participated in the Fate Letters auction would only be able to auction for one Fate Letter.

Once the 100 Fate Letters were sold by auction, 100 participants would be able to go through the Star Web's automatic ballot function and randomly deliver 100 Fate Letters to the 100 participants that purchased the Fate Letters.

Among the 100 Fate Letters, there were 99 Fate Letters drawn with black wings, signifying that it was an Ash Letter. Those who obtained the Ash Letters meant that they didn't obtain the chance to order a Bronze/Epic fey based on their comprehended Willpower Rune.

There would only be one Fate Letter that was drawn with white wings, signifying that it was the Angel Letter.

The one who drew the Angel Letter would have the chance to order a Bronze/Epic fey that was suitable for their comprehended Willpower Rune.

The faction or individual who obtained the Angel Letter would need to pay three pieces of source-type items and also make an oath of exchange.

Three days later, once it was time for the next Fate Letters to be sent, the winner could come to redeem the ordered Bronze/Epic fey.

As for the oath of exchange, when it was time for Lin Yuan to trade for the specific fey or spiritual ingredient—as long as Lin Yuan was able to provide a resource of similar value—then the faction or individual that obtained the Angel Letter would need to unconditionally agree to Lin Yuan's trade terms.

The trade terms could be a fey or a spiritual ingredient.

The oath of exchange was the reason Lin Yuan had to enhance the fey, Oath Lily of the Valley.

The Oath Lily of the Valley was a kind of plant that was around 30 centimeters in height, and the leaves would bloom with bell-shaped white flowers.

The ability of the Oath Lily of the Valley was to use each bell-shaped white flower as a medium for the world oath.

Spirit qi professionals who possessed Willpower Runes could swear an oath to the Oath Lily of the Valley.

Once the oath of exchange was agreed upon by the Oath Lily of the Valley and the spirit qi professional, then the white bell-shaped flower would turn golden.

This golden flower would then fall off from the Oath Lily of the Valley, bearing the oath of exchange.

At the same time, once the flower dropped, a new white flower would bloom at the same location.

The golden oath flower would be proof of the oath. Once the oath of exchange was fulfilled, the golden flower would wither.

However, if any party unilaterally broke the oath that was borne by the golden oath flower, then the Oath Lily of the Valley would produce a unique curse effect.

The curse's effect would seal the Willpower Rune that was used to make the oath. In other words, the violator would waste a Willpower Rune for nothing.

The punishment was significant. The punishment for breaking the oath was serious, but it was extremely fair if the oath was fulfilled.

Otherwise, whenever a person who comprehended a Willpower Rune was here to make an order, they would have to issue the oath of exchange with the private faction's owner, making it truly troublesome.

Moreover, Lin Yuan didn't have the time to stand and wait in his private faction's territory every three days to receive the oath of exchange from the buyer with the Angel Letter.

Otherwise, Lin Yuan would become a letterbox for the oath of exchange.

The Oath Lily of the Valley could simply take up the role of this job.

After all, to a certain level of significance, the Oath Lily of the Valley was the monopoly of Class 4 Creation Masters. Only a Legend Oath Lily of the Valley could receive the effects of an oath.

The Oath Lily of the Valley didn't need to be at Bronze/Legend. Even if it was at Gold/Legend, Platinum/Legend, or Diamond/Legend, it would have the same effects.

Therefore, for some Class 4 Creation Masters, upgrading a Gold or Platinum Oath Lily of the Valley to the Legend quality wasn't difficult.

However, that wasn't Lin Yuan's plan.

He planned to nurture a Bronze/Legend Oath Lily of the Valley. It would be enough to represent Lin Yuan's private faction's foundation.

It could be said that a single Bronze/Legend Oath Lily of the Valley was enough to shock everyone more than placing tons of exquisite items outside the private faction's territory.

When Lin Yuan logged onto Star Web in the morning, he found that not long after he had just gotten off Star Web, Listen had immediately replied to him.
