"Why does the environment protection department suddenly want to check our cosmetics factory? Our company always respects the rules and standards of environmental safety!"


Trevor was confused and decided to go talk with the members of the environment protection department.

This old classmate of his worked in the environment protection department, and Jonah was certain the man would help him deal with the matter easily.


Jonah was down to bitter disappointment as he was refused.

"What the hell is this? Wasn't the vice general manager supposed to deal with this matter?"


"Isn't it a bit too much to close the factory while waiting for an inspection?"

After a few seconds, the others walked out, leaving only Trevor and Lawson in the huge meeting room.


Lawson crossed his arms and smiled humorlessly.

"Here. Do you recognize this?"


Trevor put his ID from Klein on the table indifferently.
