Jonah sounded very righteous. It was as if Trevor had really made a huge mistake.


His confident look could make people think he could foresee the future.

Jonah stared blankly at the closed door of the conference room.


He began to have some fantasies in his heart. Dragon was kicked out of Severich, and he became the general manager.

"The general manager has solved the problem. The misunderstanding has been cleared up. It was just a false alarm."


It was not until then that Jonah recovered his senses. He jumped up as if he had been electrocuted and his eyes widened in disbelief.
