
Both Curtis and Hurley ignored Trevor, who was standing aside.

Trevor chuckled and glanced at Hurley with a faint smile. Then he took Luisa's hand and walked into the venue unhurriedly.


Curtis stood up, still clutching his chest. He took a few deep breaths to calm down. But at this moment, he could only see Trevor's and Luisa's backs.


Trevor gritted his teeth and clenched his fists. He was so angry that he wanted to smash Curtis' smiling face.
