Luisa let out a light cough and replied weakly, "I'm fine. I just have a slight headache and I'm a little dizzy. Maybe... Maybe I still need some rest."


Trevor's heart ached and he held Luisa's hand tightly. He was completely preoccupied with her condition, and couldn't think of the mysterious cargo right now.
