## Chapter 14: Rabbit Killer

The experience gained from killing the boss had increased by almost one and a half levels, saving a lot of time. "Let's split into two teams. Little Secretary and I will be in on team. The three of you will continue to form a team. In the New World, no experience will be gained from forming a team. It is actually less efficient to form a team with more people."

Zhang Shan thought for a while and said, "You guys go ahead. I will go and farm the rabbits alone. Most of the people should be level 3 or 4 by now. There won't be too many people farming level 2 rabbits. I will go and try to see if I can get the passive skill."

If you want to get the passive skill out of the rabbits, it'll take at least a few days. It might be 10 days to half a month. And you can't stay in the novice village for so long, right? Moreover, we should be able to find the passive skill of the rabbits in the future. The passive skill of the rabbits was described as the power granted by the Demon God, so it can't only be given to the rabbits. There should be other monsters too. "Let's go. You guys go farm the goats while I farm the rabbits. It won't be that easy to level up to level 10. Leveling up from Level 9 to Level 10 is also a hurdle. Taming: level 1, there is a chance to tame an animal that has not been demonized and become a player's pet; after taming, the pet's attributes will be strengthened by 10%; cooldown time: 30 seconds; magic point consumption:30 points; class requirement: Hunter.

Zhang Shan did not know the value of this skill book. It should be said that he did not know what the drop rate was. Although this skill was very useful to Hunter.

However, in the game, the value of an item was never just based on its practicality. It was based on the combination of practicality and the drop rate. Only items that were rarely dropped were truly valuable.

Luck 9 (randomly generated within a range of 1-10, luck is a hidden attribute and will never change.)

Talent: Passive King (every time a monster is killed, there is a chance to randomly obtain a passive skill from the monster with the probability of one in a million.)

Skill 1, Headshot (passive); level: level 9; every attack of the Hunter has a chance to trigger the headshot effect, causing an additional 50 damage and stunning for 0.05 seconds; the chance of triggering is 4.5%.

Skill 2, Heavy Strike (passive); level: level 1 (obtained through talent, cannot be upgraded); every attack has a chance of having a Heavy Strike effect causing five times the damage with a chance of triggering at 1%.

Skill 3, Taming; level: level 1; has a chance of taming an undemonized animal to become a player's pet; after taming, the pet's attributes will be strengthened by 10%; cooldown time: 30 seconds; magic point consumption: 30 points; class requirement: Hunter.

Equipment: Novice Musket, Elven Leather Boots, Black Iron Ring, Rough Leather armor, Rough Leather Helmet.

After reaching level 8, he had gained 21 points of agility. His attack power could be considered acceptable. However, although two pieces of equipment had been upgraded, they were not of much

use. Two pieces of white-tier equipment would only increase a few points of defense. It was not helpful for him to farm monsters.

As for the accessories that increased attack power, he still lacked a necklace and a ring. The bracers were not used by the agility class. It was too difficult for him to farm equipment for his class. He still had to buy or exchange them with others, however, Zhang Shan did not want to waste time now. He would think about it in the future. In any case, it would not affect him much. He could not afford good equipment, and trash equipment was useless.

"Brother, how are you doing? Did you get any passive skills? I'm already level 9, but leveling up to level 10 from level 9 is too crazy. You actually need 100,000 EXP. I'm going to die," Thousand Miles Riding Alone said to him.
