Looking at his character's attributes, Zhang Shan was very satisfied. He was really too strong.

Because of the king's Cape, his HP had reached a terrifying 336000. It was simply too much.

His attack power had also officially broken through 15000, and this was just pure attack power.

When he was farming monsters, he also had the title of nemesis of the demons, which could increase his damage by an additional 10%.

In addition, whether it was farming monsters, fighting bosses, or fighting other people.

Boss Wu would always give him an attack blessing, which would increase his attack power by 20%.

In this way, when he was killing monsters or fighting bosses, his theoretical damage output could reach nearly 20000.
