This passive was not too bad. It was similar to the special effect of an accessory. However, he did not know what his critical hit rate would be if he got this skill. It would probably be 1%.

If there was only a 1% chance, it would not be worth his effort.

forget it, don't think too much about it. just treat it as a normal way of leveling up and killing monsters.

looking at the map, zhang shan closed the forum and ran towards the wild wolf hill.

At first, he could still see some players along the way, but as he ran further and further, he could not see a single player.
