Then, even Master Xuanyao showed his intentions to win her over, although he knew the chances were slim, but shouldn't he at least try?


What if the lady of the Great Sky Pride simply loves Sword Intent? His Kaishan Sword Intent was indeed unsurpassed...

Alongside the "Magma Pond," there is an open secret chamber with a pile of discarded Artifact Refining parts, each one surrounding the Artifact Refining Platform in the center.

The Artifact Refining Platform is an essential tool for an Artifact Refiner, similar to an Alchemist's Tripod Furnace; it is capable of drawing earth fire aided by the ley lines and channeling it into itself, making the melting of materials and the firing of infant spiritual artifacts and Magical Treasures extremely convenient.

Standing next to the Artifact Refining Platform is a golden puppet that is more than a meter tall and looks majestic. It presents an overall dark red tone, and its structure has been damaged in many places due to numerous battles.

Behind the Artifact Refining Platform is the cultivation platform left by the Heavenly Craftsman. The key positions are made out of heat-resistant red metal that can draw Fire Spiritual Energy from the Fire Spirit Vein below for cultivating Profound Martial techniques of the Fire Attribute.

In addition, the materials left by the Heavenly Craftsman include "Heavenly Craftsman's Refining Device Understanding," "Heavenly Craftsman Teaches You How To Learn Artifact Refining From Scratch," "Nameless Miscellaneous Records (Heavenly Craftsman's Posthumous Manuscript)", "Smelting Heaven Scripture" (including Qi Refining Chapter, Spirit Platform chapter, Sky Human Chapter), "Celestial Fire True Verses (Purple Abode Chapter)", and "Wanbao Complete Book" (consisting of three sections that include thirty-five Spiritual Artifacts, five Magical Treasures, three kinds of Puppets, two kinds of special Spiritual Treasures, one type of Divine Artifact, and a collection of artifact refining formulas and experience of refining elementary cultivation platforms for Gold, Fire, and Water attributes).

It's noteworthy that the "Wanbao Complete Book" is a classic book on Artifact Refining collected by the Tianhuo Sect. Each entry has been carefully selected before being preserved, and they all possess certain advantages and unique features compared to their counterparts.

Furthermore, the Heavenly Craftsman left behind a "Heavenly Craftsman Box."

It is a type of spatial treasure similar to a storage ring, but its storage capacity greatly surpasses that of an ordinary storage ring. It can hold all the items in this room, with plenty of space left.

The only problem is that once the Heavenly Craftsman Box is refined, it becomes challenging to move.

This is not to say that it is impossible to move it, but it is extremely difficult. If you try to move the Heavenly Craftsman Box frivolously, it may cause turbulence within, scattering all the items at best and destroying all the stored goods at worst.

Moreover, you cannot take it with you inside a storage ring, as it would cause a collision of folded spaces, leading to perturbation in the storage space that may even destroy the storage ring.

Simply put, it is like a large, multifunctional personal storage cabinet with excellent performance that is handy when you use it but very inconvenient if you want to take it with you on the run.

Therefore, most Heavenly Craftsman Boxes are left in place once their folded spaces are opened.
