He grinned. "Who said I don't have a naming sense?"

Muttering this, he finally left the secluded corner where he previously hid with his character. By now, some time already passed, meaning most players already took beginner quests to start leveling up.

The congestion of players was no longer as severe as before, it was easier to take a beginner quest now.

Noah did just that, taking a series of beginner quests.

Beginner quests were simple quests to get new players up and running in Warstar. They help new players level up and acclimatize with the game controls. Simple missions like running errands for the beginner village NPCs, finding a missing cat, and all sorts of missions.

Noah did not just want to level up, he took on the beginner quests because just like a novice, he wanted to try out the controls of the game.

After 2 hours of taking Beginner Quests, this was how Noah's character now looked having leveled up to level 5 already.

Leveling up during the early levels was easy as it required less experience points, but after level 5, the required XP to level up increases and it got even higher as game avatars kept on leveling up.

Before the general class change at level 20, for low-leveled characters, every level up gives 1 attribute point to anyone of the 4 main attributes.

After level 20, the distribution of attribute points change depending on the specific main class that a character chooses.

Of the 4 attributes, strength affects physical attack and defense. Intelligence affects magic attacks, defense, and MP. Vitality affects HP as well as stamina. While spirit affects the resistance to and duration of status effects.

The HP and MP of characters in Warstar always appear at 100/100, but the capacity is different.

Based on different factors like main class and equipment, 100 for 1 character may mean 1000 for another character but both will appear as 100/100. The same rule applies for in-game bosses.

The reasons why Noah stopped taking more quests after getting to level 5 was because, one, a level 5 player finally gets access to in-game dungeons.

And two, it was because he finally understood how to control his new Warstar body and character without a keyboard and mouse.

After extensive research to confirm, Noah was surprised by his results.

Unlike what he feared, he didn't need to turn into Jackie Chan and start training his body just to use the different powerful skills in Warstar. Reincarnating into the game as an avatar was far more convenient to him than he expected.

Inside the game, all Noah needed was to have knowledge about the specific combinations to activate a skill, and to use it he just needed to think about it.

To a veteran Warstar player with 11 years' worth of experience like Noah who had extensive knowledge about all the main classes and all their skill combinations, this was a match made in heaven.

Perhaps, this was why he was called a warmonger?

This was even faster than using a keyboard or mouse. Before a player could tap on his keyboard and move his mouse, Noah already thought of the skill he wanted to use and thinking was definitely faster.

Skill points in Warstar are limited though which meant players needed to be wise in how they spent their skill points on their in-game avatars.

1 avatar could not learn all the skills available in the game, this was one reason why Noah's potential 10x skill points SSS-Rank Unique Skill was so OP.

Before going to a dungeon, Noah visited the Hunter guild in this beginner village where he was able to spend all his skill points to learn more beginner skills.

Different low-level skills require from 10 to 80 skill points. Noah's 232 skill points was only able to help him learn 6 beginner skills.

Apart from being rewarded with skill points and XP, players also get rewarded with coins from beginner quests.

Noah didn't have much coin yet, but he had just enough from completing the quests to buy a miserly D-rank weapon from a merchant NPC.

He spent 70 out of his 88 coins to buy a basic Combat Mage spear, and with this he finally proceeded towards the only level 5 dungeon in the beginner village, Pork Labyrinth.

Most players don't go to dungeons immediately after getting to the dungeon's level, this was because then, the difficulty would be high.

Most players farm level 5 dungeons only after getting to at least level 7 or 8, some even getting as high as level 10.

But then, the other Blademaster coughed violently, subtly gesturing at the new player that just joined them. 'Do you want to expose me, woman?!' He thought exasperatedly.

"Ah!" The Cleric exclaimed, chuckling slightly. "My bad, but we can right, boss?"

The Blademaster straightened. "Of course, I think we can".

'Maybe they're experts'. Noah thought as he observed them from the side.

From this little exchange, he could already tell that this was a close-knit group, they were probably all friends from outside the game.

"Hey, I'm Deadly Musician".

Noah looked at the player I.D hovering above the Blademaster, confirming his gaming name. "Hey, I'm Lord Doom". He answered.

"Ah, right". The stunned Blademaster could only say this.

'Such a tyrannical name'. He thought. 'This guy must be really arrogant'.

"I will be the party leader". Deadly Musician, the Blademaster who was called Nightingale and boss said and the others didn't object, including Noah.

But before the dungeon started, Noah had a question. "How will we share the drops from inside the dungeon?"

"Ah, that," Deadly Musician hesitated for only a moment before answering. "If we get drops from the dungeon bosses, if it is an equipment, the player whose class is compatible with the equipment gets it".

"And if there are 2 players of the same class vying for it, it'll be decided by a coin toss. Is that ok with you?"

Noah nodded, that was ok.

And so, the dungeon raid started.

Pork Labyrinth is a small dungeon in a shallow forest with regular monsters, Pigs. Apparently, they were infected by some virus, turning them into rabid and human-eating monsters.

There are 3 stages to completing the dungeon with corresponding 3 game bosses. The 3 bosses of Pork Labyrinth are the Pork Master, the Pork King, and the Pork Emperor, all evolved Pigs.

Due to the class composition of this raid party, Noah's Lord Doom, the Elementalist (Death Note) and the other Blademaster (Silky Strings) were the main DPS of this party.

The party leader, Deadly Musician was the tank, his Blademaster wielded a tower shield and a long sword.

Noah guessed that both were C-ranked equipment. 'This guy must be really skilled or is a big money spender to have C-ranked equipment already'.

And of course, the Cleric was the only girl in the raid party (Healing Melody).

As soon as the raid started, the party showcased their skill, thoroughly enjoying themselves as they killed the monsters for fun.

{Boss, have you noticed that this guy is unnaturally calm? It feels as if he's not giving his best, besides, he didn't react to hearing your name at all.}

{Focus on the game!!! Do you want our raid party to be wiped out a second time? Besides, this time there's even a hidden boss so we need to be at alert.}

{Who cares? We got wiped out because of that bum anyways, but this guy is good so I say we'll clear the dungeon this time.}

{About him not knowing me, let's keep it that way. Besides, not everyone knows about Nightingale.}

{Rubbish! I bet he's just feigning ignorance, maybe he thought it was another Nightingale, an imposter maybe.}

{Can you please focus on the game?}

{Too easy boss, too easy.}

It really did feel easy.

With the 3 DPS players doing such a good job at dealing damage with the tank, Deadly Musician also doing a good job to bundle the monsters together, they bulldozed their way through the dungeon until they got to the first checkpoint.

[You have entered the slumbering place of the Pork Master!]

The Pork Master was a gigantic Pig 3 times bigger than the regular monsters.

As soon as the players entered its domain, the giant monster rose up, glaring at the players with blood-red eyes.

"Newbie, calm down". The party leader spoke to Noah. "It just looks menacing, it's not really that dangerous, we killed it during our first raid".

"Just let me collect aggro, I'll focus on containing it while you focus on dealing as much damage as you can".

"Yes boss".

Noah sent a thumbs up in the party group chat to show that he understood.

And when the boss charged towards them, attacking the nearest player with its head, this Blademaster showed his skill as he used a low level Blademaster skill, Parry to counter the attack, negating the damage and opening the boss up for a counterattack.

{Frost Strike=}

Frost strike is a Blademaster skill that enchants the sword with ice, slowing enemies with each hit and increasing critical hit chance.

After activating frost strike, Deadly Musician quickly chained a few attacks with his sword before completing it with a Whirlwind Slash, a spinning attack with his sword that threw the boss off-balance.

Thud!

Collapsing to the ground, blood flew as the boss' HP dropped.

Before the Pig could rise up, Deadly Musician circled it, dealing damage after damage as the aggro quickly became fully established on him.

And just as the angry Pig was about to narrow its full focus on him which would prove dangerous, he screamed. "Now!"

Immediately, the DPS classes started attacking, Noah being part of them.

Killing the Pork Master was far harder than all the monsters they've been fighting since but with Deadly Musician doing such a good job, they were able to finish the monster off with minimal damage to any of them.

After that relatively straightforward boss kill, the party became emboldened as they went to the 2nd phase of the dungeon, sweeping through its monsters.

A few more minutes later, they encountered the second boss, the Pork King.

Unlike the gigantic Pork Master, the Pork King was much smaller, but this guy was an evolved humanoid Pig who wielded a heavy club as a weapon.

"Meddling humans!" Growling, the Pig attacked.

The attack variations of the Pork King were more than those of the Pork Master's, giving the group some trouble as the Cleric had to save Deadly Musician's life 2 different times but, in the end, they also killed the boss.

Congratulating themselves, they entered the 3rd phase of the dungeon. More experienced now, they quickly dispatched all the monsters and met the final boss.

[You have encountered the wandering Pork Emperor!]

The Pork Emperor was a boss made from a combination of the Pork Master and Pork King; it was a gigantic humanoid Pig with ferocious might.

It was as big as the Pork Master while also holding a heavy club to attack like the Pork King.

While the excited group got ready to attack, Deadly Musician already rushing up to meet it and establish the aggro, Noah paid attention to his surroundings, thinking of something else. 'Where is the hidden boss?'

At that moment, he felt sudden movement.

"Stop!" Noah said loudly. "The hidden boss is here!"

[NOTE: DPS stands for damage per second. It is a term to describe characters in video games who specialize in dealing a large amount of damage to enemies.]

Chapter 7: Hidden Boss- Slumbering Bandit [1]

In Warstar, unlike normal bosses that were always at fixed points, checkpoints in a dungeon, hidden bosses were much more random.

They could appear at almost any point inside a dungeon.

This was why from the very beginning, Noah paid attention to their surroundings, looking out for the hidden boss.

Since, he didn't see any signs of the hidden boss but just as they finally entered the checkpoint of the last and strongest boss of the Pork Labyrinth, Noah just had to find the slippery hidden boss then.

"Stop!" He called loudly. "The hidden boss is here!"

For a moment, this party of players were stunned. 'A hidden boss? Where?'

Before they could react, the taciturn Combat Mage who barely spoke since the beginning of this dungeon raid, never taking the initiative suddenly moved.

{Arcane Strike=}

Brandishing his battle lance, Noah's character used a common Combat Mage skill as his lance stabbed forward.

Arcane Strike is a common combat mage melee attack skill imbued with magic, dealing bonus arcane damage and briefly knocking back the target.

Compared to other main classes, the Combat mage is a hybrid fighter who blends melee combat with arcane magic, excelling in versatility, battlefield control, and burst damage.

They wield both battle lances and spells, seamlessly switching between close-range combat and powerful magical attacks.

As Lord Doom moved, to his party members, it almost seemed like he was stabbing empty air till his battle lance actually hit something.

As soon as Noah's attack hit, the enemy was knocked back out of his hiding spot and in this case, the enemy was the hidden boss.

Knocked back, the hidden boss could no longer remain hidden as it materialized into existence even as blood blossomed from its tiny body.

"Stealth!" Deadly Musician, the party leader called the next moment, astonished.

Stealth was a skill that could be learned by assassins and thieves, a variant class of the Blademaster main class.

And with this skill, it confirmed the identity of this tiny pig.

"It's the Slumbering Bandit!" Healing Melody, the Cleric shrieked.

Unlike the towering Pork Emperor who looked so imposing and powerful, the Slumbering Bandit didn't look like a hidden boss at all.

Rather, it looked like an intelligent Pig thief instead who scuttered around, looking for victims to rob not just of their belongings but of their lives too.

It wore black tattered robes and it had a dirty brown bag slung across it's back, the bag seemed to be holding a lot of things that it stole.

As soon as Healing Melody shrieked, this party of players could not help but panic as their gazes alternated between the tiny hidden boss and the towering Pork Emperor who already set its sight on them.

They cursed, the timing could not have been more worse.

The Pork Emperor alone was already a formidable adversary for a raid party that they were not 100% sure in defeating since it was the strongest boss in the Pork Labyrinth.

Adding the hidden boss to the equation was just overkill.

Looks could deceive. The Slumbering Bandit may look weak compared to the Pork Emperor, but having made a bit of research after being wiped out in the dungeon the first time, they knew that it was even stronger than the Pork Emperor.

"We're screwed!" Not bothering to hide her panic, Healing Melody said and her fear was infecting the others. Not all of them though.

Bam! Bam!

From the moment that the outsider in their raid party, Lord Doom found the hidden boss first and attacked it, he never stopped attacking.

Immediately after knocking back the hidden boss with the Arcane Strike skill, he quickly followed it up with 3 more rapid attacks; 2 normal attacks and a skill move.

{Empowered Slash=}

The Empowered Slash is a combat mage skill that charges the weapon with raw magic, delivering a devastating cleave that creates an energy shockwave.

By actively controlling the direction of the slash, the Empowered Slash skill can be used as a knock-up skill, knocking up a target into the sky through the energy shockwave generated by the skill.

Noah did just that, launching the Slumbering Bandit into the sky.

With that sudden rapid combo, Noah managed to establish aggro over the hidden boss even as he finally turned to pay attention to the others.

Seeing that they were stunned, watching him, he was surprised at first but noticing the gigantic Pork Emperor slugging over, he finally understood. 'They're scared'.

He still asked though. "Why are you guys just standing?"

Hearing that question, the party leader went red in embarrassment but thickening his skin up, he still explained. "We can't kill 2 bosses at the same time". Deadly Musician said.

Noah felt cold sweat fill up in his forehead. 'So honest'.

In the end, he chuckled. "Actually, we can, just let me lead".

"Huh?"

Noah was about to explain when he heard a sound, a sound so subtle he would have struggled to hear if he was not actually inside the game at this moment.

Staring at the explosion, Noah was surprised. 'This is a Mechanic skill'.

'I don't remember the Slumbering Bandit having this kind of attack skill'.

Besides, dealing with the Slumbering Bandit back then gave new Warstar players a lot of trouble till they finally figured the hidden boss out. So, he did have a big impression of this specific hidden boss but still, he didn't remember this.

Landing from the sky with a thud finally, the Slumbering Bandit rose back up to its feet, looking at them with a resentful expression even as it supported its sling bag with one hand but it didn't rush to attack.

The Pork Emperor didn't rush either despite the fact that the players already entered its radar, instead taunting them.

"Time to squeal your doom!" He said in his loud rumbling voice.

This was the catchphrase of the Pork Emperor.

At this moment, the other members in this raid party paid attention to Noah after what he just did.

In truth, Deadly Musician and his companions were new to Warstar, the 11th server was their first time actively playing the video game but still, they already watched enough videos online to know a bit about the game.

This was why they could tell that what Noah just did was not normal.

The Slumbering Bandit was tiny for a reason, and it was a hidden boss to booth, making it extremely nimble and fast. It was extremely hard to land a single attack on this hidden boss, but this Combat Mage actually managed to not just land an attack but string together a combo, he was no ordinary player.

Chapter 8: Hidden Boss- Slumbering Bandit [2]

"Boss, we thought you were some hidden expert, what the heck!"

"You don't even know the 2 classes of the Slumbering Bandit? Then how on earth are we supposed to beat it and the Pork Emperor combined?"

Deadly Musician felt like crying, he felt that this player just took advantage of him and messed with his emotions.

Noah chuckled. "It's been so long since I played the Pork Labyrinth, so I've forgotten. We don't have much time, either tell me now or we die".

In the end, Deadly Musician explained.

To not make the game too hard for new players, bosses in beginner village dungeons are made very basic with predictable attack patterns and combat styles.

But the same thing could not be said for hidden bosses. Even in the beginner village, hidden bosses are made to already have specific main classes that they specialize on, drawing their strength pool from it.

The Slumbering Bandit was no different, rather, it was even more special among beginner village hidden bosses.

Afterall, the bandit had more than 1 main class, it had 2.

BAM!

The Pork Emperor's heavy club hit the ground, creating a mighty shockwave even as the players dodged, still retreating.

While they conversed, the Pork Emperor did not wait for them, already attacking. But due to the towering size of this boss, it was too heavy to match their speed, only lumbering after them.

As for the nimbler hidden boss though, they were lucky that after its stealth was discovered, the Slumbering Bandit was not a fan of attacking head-on.

It preferred players hunting it down instead, being pursued and running was where it could display its true strength. Afterall, it was a thief.

And just like the Pork Emperor, the Slumbering Bandit also had a catchphrase to taunt challengers into attacking it.

"Think you can hog-tie me? Bring home the bacon if you dare!"

Deadly Musician felt like crying. 'The game developers must be sick!'

With the hidden boss not pursuing them and the Pork Emperor too slow to catch them, Deadly Musician explained about the hidden boss.

Apparently, the Slumbering Bandit belonged to the thief and Summoner class. It was mainly a thief; its summoning abilities are only displayed after it was damaged enough to red blood state.

Red blood state is a special state after Warstar boss monsters' HP go below 10%, and most boss monsters have special effects attached to it.

As soon as Deadly Musician was done explaining, Noah furrowed his brows. "If you're right, then I was right, this is not just any Slumbering Bandit".

"What do you mean?" Silky Strings, the other Blademaster of this raid party who was already impatient due to the presence of the 2 boss monsters asked.

"When I attacked the hidden boss, I dodged a landmine and that is a Mechanic skill. There's no way a level 5 dungeon specialized boss already with abilities from 2 main classes has access to it".

"Which means?"

"Which means this is likely a challenge".

"A challenge?" Deadly Musician asked.

Noah nodded, paying keen attention to the approaching Pork Emperor.

"Warstar is a fair game. There's no way the game algorithm will make the mistake of spamming 2 boss monsters on a raid party at the same time unless it was premeditated with a certain motive and reward in mind".

Now that Noah was calmly analyzing the situation, the others no longer panicked in the presence of the 2 boss monsters.

Of course, this was also because the Slumbering Bandit was not attacking them.

"Now that you say it, you're right". Deadly Musician nodded. "2 bosses don't attack at the same time in a dungeon, even if it's a hidden boss".

Noah nodded again. "And not just that, this Slumbering Bandit is different. The bulge in his sling bag is bigger than normal, and that mechanic skill, it implies that it is also a Mechanic, meaning it has 3 main classes!"

The others were stunned.

3 main classes, was that even beatable?

But then, the more Noah explained, the more excited his voice seemed to become. "Which made me to arrive at the conclusion that this is a Unique Skill Challenge, I am 99% sure".

"A Unique Skill Challenge?" The other members of this raid party felt breathless as they let that word sink in.

They may be new to Warstar, but they watched the recent final of the Warstar RPG champions league, and they've also been following the game for some time so they definitely knew about the unique skill challenge.

Unique skill challenges are the only ways for in-game characters to receive unique skills from the game algorithm, and they are extremely hard to come by and they're even harder to complete.

"To think that we would stumble upon a unique skill challenge in just our 2nd dungeon run in the new server!" They were excited.

"But still, these circumstances, is this not too hard?"

"I've never heard of a unique skill challenge that is this hard".

As soon as Noah became the leader, he explained. "The Slumbering Bandit is the most dangerous of the 2 boss monsters. Besides, it most likely has abilities from 3 different classes. He won't let us isolate and kill the Pork Emperor while watching, so we have to kill it first".

"This is why we'll all attack the Pork Emperor until the hidden boss is forced to intervene. From there on, we'll have to improvise".

"Yeah, there's no specific strategy to this. Even I have never fought against 2 bosses at once inside a dungeon, we'll just have to improvise, do our best and hope we don't make any mistake".

"Not hope, don't make any mistake, we only have one shot at this".

Hearing him, the other party members could not help but feel a little nervous. Could they play a perfect game?

Noah didn't let them overthink though. "Before we start, I need to know all your skill combinations".

They answered him, telling him all the skills in their beginner skill tree.

Once they were done, Noah nodded, about to start. "I'll pull aggro, the rest of you, attack with your strongest skills on my signal".

Deadly Musician wanted to say something but, in the end, he held himself back as he watched the Combat Mage charge towards the hidden boss.

The Slumbering Bandit's eyes flashed on noticing this and then, revealing a humanoid grin, this hidden boss shamelessly turned around and ran.

Noticing this, having expected it, Noah's Lord Doom turned immediately, nonchalantly ignoring the running hidden boss as he charged in the direction of the Pork Emperor.

The hidden boss was stunned when it noticed this.

"Time to squeal your doom!" The Pork Emperor just said its catchphrase again when it was caught by a swift attack.

{Mana Burst=}

Mana Burst is a combat mage skill that is activated by jumping. When landing, it releases a shockwave of raw mana energy, damaging and staggering enemies in a radius.

The Pork Emperor was too big to be knocked up by Empowered Slash, this was why Noah settled for the mana burst.

Before the towering final boss could react, Noah already landed beside it as a shockwave erupted with him as the center.

The gigantic Pig staggered, and Noah's battle lance stung.

Chapter 9: Hidden Boss- Slumbering Bandit [3]

'This guy... is good!'

They already saw his skill once against the Slumbering Bandit but seeing it again in full flow against the Pork Emperor that was supposed to be an extremely difficult opponent, they were stunned.

This Lord Doom didn't seem to know how to miss a single attack.

From the moment that he used Mana Burst to make the Pork Emperor stagger; the final boss endured an unrelenting combo of rapid attacks.

At just level 5, Warstar RPG characters have very few skills but with the little skills that he had, Noah played like a level 20 player, mixing normal attacks in his barrage to keep up the combo as blood flew like rain.

But in Warstar, skills cannot be used endlessly. Every skill has a cooldown, calculating cooldowns and using it to your advantage is one of the big differences between a casual player and a pro player.

"Now, attack!"

After his rapid barrage of attacks, as Noah said this, he disengaged from the final boss who just collapsed to the ground, about to rise back up.

Death Note and Silky Strings didn't let the final boss rise back up though as charging in, the Blademaster hit the stationary final boss with a Whirlwind Slash, knocking it back down with the skill's sweeping effect.

Just before Death Note could attack, he heard Noah's order.

"Flame Wave!"

The Elementalist froze for a brief moment, but then he guickly executed it.

Flame Wave is an Elementalist spell that sends out a wave of fire that engulfs enemies in a cone, causing extended burn damage over time.

With the boss still knocked down due to Silky String's Whirlwind Slash and with Death Note's Flame Wave active, Lord Grim and Deadly Musician joined the party, spamming attacks against the final boss.

But that was the problem, compared to the more technical Slumbering Bandit with normal HP, the Pork Emperor had a truly despairing amount of HP.

Afterall, it was the brute type of final boss.

In exchange for that, its attacks were pretty predictable.

The Pork Emperor had no magic attacks, it had only its size and its club going for it. But one hit from that club had the capability to one-shot a cloth-armored class like Death Note's Elementalist, so they had to be careful.

Their flurry of attacks took a chunk of HP from the final boss but again, it tried to stand up to attack.

But predicting its movements perfectly, Noah ordered again.

"Musical, Whirlwind Slash!"

"M-m-musical...?" The Blademaster was stunned. "It's Deadly Musician!"

Even as he complained, this Blademaster already activated the skill as sweeping with his sword, the Pork Emperor was forced to the ground again.

And with that, they resumed spamming attacks on the boss.

Just like that, the Pork Emperor that was supposed to be a formidable adversary was tamed, reduced to a predictable punching bag.

The other members of this raid party were amazed. They knew that the attacks of the Pork Emperor were pretty predictable, but taking advantage of its predictable attack patterns was a whole other thing. It was incredibly hard.

They knew that this elite performance was all because of one player, Lord Doom.

He seemed to always know the next move of the Pork Emperor before it made the move, reading it like a book and warning them ahead of time. This way, with the 2 Blademasters rotating between their knock-down skills and the Elementalist's own skills, the threat of the Pork Emperor was neutralized.

The Pork Emperor's HP was steadily dropping but this was a risky maneuver. A single mistake from one of them could spell their death.

It didn't take too long before one of them made a mistake though. It was Silky Strings, the other Blademaster who mistimed his usage of Whirlwind Slash, enabling the final boss to rise up again.

"Ahh..., sorry!"

Before the mistake could prove devastating, in a blur, Noah's Lord Doom already rolled in front of Silky Strings' Blademaster.

As the gigantic Pork Emperor's club descended, about to cause devastating damage, Noah used a skill.

{Arcane Riposte=}

It was a combat mage skill that parries an enemy attack and counters with a burst of arcane energy, stunning the attacker.

Silky Strings failed to knock down the Pork Emperor but with Noah's timely Arcane Riposte to save the day, the final boss was stunned, achieving the same effect as the others kept on spamming attacks on it.

"Don't make another mistake". Noah warned.

"Yes boss". Silky Strings hastily said.

After that, there was no more mistakes and just like that, it seemed that they would easily kill the Pork Labyrinth's final boss till something changed.

...they forgot that the Pork Emperor was not their only enemy.

Bzzz!

By the time that they heard the sound of shadows stirring, the Slumbering Bandit who had been quiet since already made its move, using the thief skill, Shadow Step to ambush one of the players.

The Shadow Step skill teleports the Thief to a nearby enemy, delivering a quick attack upon arrival but the hidden boss didn't stop at that.

Having retrieved a dagger from its sling bag at some point, it turned the attack into a combo, using the thief skill Back Stab as blood blossomed.

During the past few seconds, Death Note, the Elementalist's high DPS class led the damage stats and was why he was first on the hidden boss' radar.

Not only did the attack of the hidden boss have unnecessarily high damage, Back Stab also had side effects of leaving its culprit stunned and weakened, reducing all its attributes, including HP and MP by half.

In that one attack, Death Note's HP dropped by 1/3rd!

"...!" The other party members froze.

If the Slumbering Bandit was allowed to chain a few more attacks, Death Note would be insta-killed.

Alas, they never had any chances of winning, but then...

Bzzz!

The blood from the Back Stab was still blossoming when the sound of space shrinking reverberated.

{Blink Step:}

Blink Step is a battle mage short distance teleportation skill.

In an instant, Lord Doom appeared behind the Slumbering Bandit and before it could attack the Elementalist again, Lord Grim's battle lance already struck, launching the hidden boss into the sky again with another Empowered Slash.

"...!" The others were stunned.

Lord Doom was thinking and playing at a level that their mundane minds could not keep up with at all, they were always lagging a step behind.

Thankfully, Noah did give them orders.

"Death Note, use your strongest attacks!"

The Elementalist snapped back to life.

"Strings, Musical, focus on stalling the Pork Emperor. Melody, support them". Even as Noah instructed, his Lord Doom never stopped attacking as chaining one attack with another, he juggled the tiny Slumbering Bandit.

From the very beginning, this was the scenario that Noah played out in his head, the only scenario he saw of winning this extreme challenge.

He always knew that pursuing the Slumbering Bandit was not optimal, the bastard was just too slippery. And he also knew that the hidden bandit was too intelligent to just watch them as they kill the Pork Emperor.

This meant that it would attack when they least expected it, and its target would definitely be the highest damage threat.

Elementalists specialize in manipulating the elements, fire, water, earth, and air for powerful offensive and utility abilities. They excel in dealing high elemental damage and controlling the battlefield.

From the beginning, Noah knew that after some time, Death Note would quickly climb above him in the damage stats but he predicted that before the Elementalist's overall damage could eclipse his own, making the final boss' aggro to OT, the impatient bandit would have made its move by then.

And he was right.

Unlike the Pork Emperor that had a mountain of HP, the Slumbering Bandit's HP was much more normal.

What went for this hidden boss was its nimbleness and cunning which always confounded lower-skilled players but for an elite player of Noah's caliber, the Slumbering Bandit was the perfect fit for him.

Noah was confident in one-shotting the Slumbering Bandit alone with time, the question was could he do it fast enough before the Pork Emperor would kill his teammates?

This was why since Death Note was close by, he instructed the Elementalist to help him get rid of the Slumbering Bandit.

In that moment, Deadly Musician finally understood Noah's masterplan from the beginning, this player could not help but be impressed.

'What is he? A God?'

He didn't hesitate though; he had a lumbering final boss to stall.

While he and Silky Strings focused on stalling the final boss with Healing Melody providing them support, Death Note and Lord Doom focused on the Slumbering Bandit.

No other 2 players could one-shot this hidden boss but at this moment, the other members thought if anyone could do it, this Lord Doom definitely could.

Bam! Bam!

Lord Doom's battle lance never stopped moving, attacking non-stop, coordinating with Death Note's powerful attacks.

As he attacked, the game algorithm counted above the hidden boss' head.

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'What the f*ck!' Death Note felt like he was seeing ghosts.

This was not a random log of wood, this was a level 5 hidden boss, the Slumbering Bandit and yet Noah juggled this poor hidden boss like a stationary object. It already tried to no avail to escape the attack combo.

In the end, the Slumbering Boss' HP finally went below 10% and immediately, it entered red blood state.

"Move back!" Noah warned.

Chapter 10: Hidden Boss first kill

The Slumbering Bandit originally had 2 main classes but since this was a unique skill challenge, the hidden boss was upgraded to have 3 main classes.

Apart from its normal thief class, it was also a Mechanic today but from the moment that Noah's Lord Doom ambushed the hidden boss, he never let it use any of its Mechanic skills.

The Mechanic class are tactical and tech-savvy fighters who specialize in deploying gadgets, constructs, and explosive devices to control the battlefield and deal consistent damage.

They blend ingenuity with mechanical prowess, making them versatile and unpredictable.

But from the moment that Noah knew that this hidden boss had the Mechanic class too, he warned his teammates and they actively looked out for the landmines, avoiding them.

Of course, a Mechanic had other attack skills.

In that sling bag of his, Noah was sure that the Slumbering Bandit carried shock grenades and maybe even a Drone Companion but he never once gave the bandit the opportunity to make use of these skills, till red blood.

In it's red-blood state, the Slumbering Bandit gains Super Armor, making it immune to all knock up, knock back and knock down skill effects.

"Move back!"

Death Note obeyed without a moment's hesitation, jumping back just in time to avoid a Mechanic skill, sticky bomb.

Sticky bomb is a skill that attaches an explosive to an enemy within a 5-meter radius, detonating after a delay but since no target was in its radius when it was deployed, the bomb failed to detonate.

But the Slumbering Bandit quickly used another skill.

{EMP Blast=}

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EMP blast disables enemy electronics and constructs while dealing damage and reducing movement speed in an area.

Noah's raid party had no Mechanic nor electronic constructs, but he and Death Note received the damage even as their movement speed became reduced.

"Use Lightning Strike". Noah ordered even as he already rushed back in to attack but a boss in red blood mode was dangerous.

If he had the leverage, he would have retreated, allowing Death Note to bombard the hidden boss from a distance but then, the Slumbering Bandit was just too nimble and fast. He would not allow them retreat.

This was why instead of retreating, Noah went all in.

"Strings, Musical, switch your attention here!"

And that was their advantage. Since the Pork Emperor was so slow, it was not fast enough to pursue them and catch up immediately.

As they charged in, Noah gave a final order. "Melody, use Blessing of Fortitude and Inspiration".

The Cleric did not hesitate, using both skills immediately even as in reality, her hands tapping her keyboard and moving her mouse were covered in sweat.

{Blessing of Fortitude=}

{Inspiration=}

Both were low level Cleric skills.

Blessing of Fortitude temporarily increases an ally's defense and resistance to physical attacks. This was the base level of the skill but having put in some skill points to level it up, Healing Melody could use its AOE effect on her full party.

As for Inspiration, it bolsters the party's morale, temporarily enhancing their attack power and mana regeneration.

The reason why Noah called all of them back was simple, it was in reality a gamble to deal with the predictable next move of the Slumbering Bandit in its last throes of death.

And he was right as after uttering a silent scream, portals materialized around them from which normal Pork Labyrinth Pigs emerged from.

The Slumbering Bandit was also a Summoner!

"Attack!"

Urging his teammates, with his battle lance, Noah's speed exploded as he pounced on all the spawning low-level Pigs.

If Noah was using a keyboard and mouse at this moment, his APM would have absolutely blown through the roof but all he had to do this time was think and thinking? It was far better than hand speed.

Bam! Bam! Bam!

This boss battle reached its climax as with him rapidly hunting down all the spawns before they could attack his teammates, he allowed them to focus on the rampaging red blood Slumbering Bandit.

Super Armor only granted the hidden boss resistance to knock effects, it didn't increase its defense, it's HP kept on draining rapidly.

In those few seconds, this raid party felt a thrill unlike anything that they've experienced before now.

They forgot about everything, including all their anxiety and tension.

The only thing on their mind was hitting the keys of the keyboard, moving their mouse, and activating skill after skill, attack after attack.

{Your party member, Death Note have been killed!}

In the end, the Slumbering Bandit ended up taking the first life but it also spelled its end as Death Note's Lightning Strike skill finished the job.

The Elementalist did his job before dying.

In a choreographed manner, the Slumbering Bandit staggered, life draining out of its eyes before it collapsed the next moment.

Immediately, the game system announced.

{Congratulations to the players Deadly Musician, Death Note, Silky Strings, Healing Melody, and Lord Doom for claiming the first kill of the Pork Labyrinth Hidden boss: Slumbering Bandit!}

For a brief moment, the others were stunned.

They were about to jump for joy when Noah's words doused them in cold water. "The final boss is still here!"

BOOM!

Slamming its club to the ground in the middle of the players, this final boss generated a massive shockwave, causing a lot of damage and knocking the players down as another one also ate the dust.

{Your party member, Healing Melody has been killed!}

The Cleric had the most health among the remaining members of this raid party before but due to unfortunately being in the direct path of that attack, more than 50% of her HP was wiped out in one attack!

With their Cleric gone, it suddenly became much harder but unlike the others, Noah was not knocked down by that attack.

This was because just before the club hit down, he jumped up, escaping the range of the attack.

As he landed, his battle lance slashed at the final boss with an Empowered slash even as his 2 teammates scrambled back up to their feet.

{Your party member, Silky Strings has been killed!}

All his fingers felt numb and sweaty.

But in the end, after what felt like forever, only when he heard the sound of the game system notification did he freeze.

{Congratulations! Your raid party has killed the final boss of the Pork Labyrinth, Pork Emperor!}

{You have been rewarded with XP each!}

{You have been rewarded with 80 Skill Points each!}

. . .

{Congratulations! You have completed Unique Skill Challenge...!}

Thud!

The Pork Emperor collapsed to the ground, dead.

Deadly Musician stared with wide eyes. "W-we actually won". He stammered.
